



# Olivia - Sweater

## Materials

4 (5, 6) skeins Friends Extra Fine Merino, col 83

3 (4, 4) skeins Friends Kid Silk, col 02

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Circular needles 80 cm/ 9 mm

Straight and double-pointed needles 9 mm

## Yarns

 **Friends Extra Fine Merino**, Hobbii

100% wool/ 50 g = 165 meters

 **Friends Kid Silk**, Hobbii

72% kid mohair, 25% silk, 3% wool

25 g = 200 meters

## Gauge

11 sts and 14 rounds for 10x10 cm

Using 3 strands on 9 mm needles

## Sizes

S (M, L)

## Measurements

Width: 55 (60, 65) cm

Length: 49 (50, 51) cm

## Pattern information

The sweater is worked with 1 strand of each color Kid Silk and 1 strand of Friends Extra Fine Merino = 3 strands.

The sweater is knit from the bottom and up. Stitches are bound off for the armscyes and neckline. The shoulders are sewn together and lastly, stitches are picked up and worked along the armscyes. The sleeves are worked top down.

**TS, turning stitch:** The neckline is shaped with German short rows

## Body

Cast on 110 (121, 132) sts with 3 strands on a n 80 cm circular needle and knit 1 round.

### Increase round

Work \*k11, pick up bar between sts and k tbl\*, repeat between \*\* until end of round = 10 (11, 12) sts increased = 120 (132, 144) sts.

Knit in the round in stockinette stitch until the work measures 30 cm.

Place a marker at each side = side seams = 60 (66, 72) sts each for the front and back pieces.

Here, the work is divided for armscyes. Put the front piece sts to rest and place the back piece sts on straight needles.

## Back

Work stockinette stitch flat on the straight needles.

Work straight up until the armscye measures 19 (20, 21) cm. End on a wrong side row.

### Right shoulder (when sweater is worn)

Shape the shoulder with short rows:

Knit 26 (28, 30) sts, turn, make a TS.

\*knit until 6 sts left at shoulder, turn, make a TS.

Knit until 3 sts left at the neck, turn, make a TS.

Knit until 13 sts left at the shoulder, turn, make a TS.

Knit until 6 sts left at the neck, turn, make a TS

Knit until end of row, working the TS's as one st, turn.

Bind off the 26 (28, 30) sts, working TS's as one st\*.

Place a marker 20 (22, 24) sts from the armscye, these sts are for the shoulder seam. The remaining 6 sts are for the neck.

### Neck

Bind off 8 (10, 12) sts and knit until end of row.

### Left shoulder

Work the left shoulder as the right, from \* to \*.

Place a marker 20 (22, 24) sts from the armscye, these sts are for the shoulder seam. The remaining 6 sts are for the neck.



## Front

Work the front piece flat in stockinette stitch until the armscye measures 10 cm. End on a wrong side row.

Knit 22 (25, 28) sts, bind off 16 sts for the neckline, knit until end of row.

The right and left sides of the front piece are finished separately.

### Right front piece (when sweater is worn)

Decrease at the neckline like so:

**Row 1:** purl.

**Row 2:** ssk, knit until end of row.

Repeat these 2 rows until there are 20 (22, 24) sts left for the shoulder.

Work straight up until the armscye measures 19 (20, 21) cm. End on a wrong side row.

Bind off.

### Left front piece (when sweater is worn)

Using new yarn, begin at the neckline and decrease like so:

**Row 1:** purl.

**Row 2:** knit until there are 2 sts left, k2tog.

Repeat these 2 rows until there are 20 (22, 24) sts left for the shoulder.

Work straight up until the armscye measures 19 (20, 21) cm. End on a wrong side row.

Bind off.

Sew up the shoulder seams using the kitchener stitch.

## Sleeves (worked from the armscye and down)

Pick up about 46 (48) 50 sts in the armscye on double-pointed needles. The first row is knit through back loops. Place a marker at the beginning of the round = sleeve seam.

Knit stockinette stitches and decrease 1 stitch on each side of the marker as follows:

Knit until you have 3 stitches left before you reach the marker, k2tog, k2, k2tog = decrease 2.

Decrease for every 5 cm.

Continue until the sleeve measures 40 cm.

Work 6 decreases evenly spaced on the next round.

Bind off.

Make the other sleeve in the same manner.

## Neckline

Pick up sts from the right side along the neckline.

Bind off in knit.
