

# Metorit - Asymmetrical Shawl

## Materials

2 skeins of Butterfly, co. 04
Circular needles 32 " ( 80 cm )/ sz. 7 ( $4,5 \mathrm{~mm}$ )
Crochet hook G/6 (4 mm)
Yarn quality

## (33) Butterfly, Hobbii

$100 \%$ premium acrylic/ $7.1 \mathrm{oz} .(200 \mathrm{~g})=547$ yds (500 meter)

## Gauge

20 sts and 40 rows for 4 " ( 10 cm ) in garter st.

## Measurements

Width: $27.5^{\prime \prime}(70 \mathrm{~cm})$
Length: 71" (180 cm)

## Pattern information

The shawl is knitted in garter st. The first part is knitted with increases on all rows all together with stripes. The last part is knitted with decreases on every 4th row. Finally a round of single crochet is made.

## Abbreviations

Garter: knit on all rows.
1 st inc: Knit through front and back loop of stitch.
1 st dec: Knit 2 together

## Stripe pattern

Knit with 1 strand of yarn from the center of the skein and 1 strand from the outside, so there is as much contrast as possible.
Knit 2 rows with alternately a strand in a bright color and 2 rows with a dark color.

## Pattern

## First part

Cast on 2 sts in a bright color.
1st row, bright: 1 st inc, $\mathrm{k} 1=3$ sts.
2nd row, dark: $\mathrm{k} 2,1$ st inc $=4$ sts.
3rd row, dark: 1 st inc, k $3=5$ sts.
4th row, bright: $\mathrm{k} 4,1$ st inc $=6$ sts.
5th row, bright: 1 st inc, k $5=7$ sts.
Repeat rows 2 to 5 until there's 140 sts $=$ approx. 27.5" $(70 \mathrm{~cm})$ in width.

## Second part

Cut the bright strand.
Start decreasing in the same side as the increases on every 4th row:
Knit to 3 sts left, k2tog, k1 = 139 sts.
Knit 3 rows.
Repeat these 4 rows until there is 3 sts left. Cast off, but don't cut the yarn.
NB When beginning a new skein, finish and start with the same shade of color.

## Border

Place the last st on the crochet hook and work 1 row of single crochet.
