



Unicorn Scarf

No. 1011-204-1551

Skill level: Intermediate

Crochet hook: 6.0, 5.5 and 3.5 mm

Materials: White sewing thread, black thread, stuffing

Yarn: Baby Snuggle Solid

Pastel Purple (#04) - 3 skeins

Yarn: Rainbow Cotton 8/8

Vanilla (#052) - 1 skein

White (#001) - 1 skein

Petunia Pink (#087) - 1 skein

Pink (#045) - 1 skein

Purple (#039) - 1 skein

Turquoise (#033) - 1 skein

Light Green (#019) - 1 skein

Orange (#057) - 1 skein

Yellow (#054) - 1 skein

The length of the scarf is approximately 145 cm, if you want a longer scarf you will need one more skein of Baby Snuggle Solid.

Abbreviations:

ch - chain

sc - single crochet

1 inc - 2 st in the same stitch

sl st - slip stitch

dc - double crochet

hdc - half double crochet

t-ch - turning chain

PATTERN

HOOD

Using Baby Snuggle Solid and a 5.5 mm hook

Ch 19.

Row 1: 1 dc in the 3rd ch from the hook, 15 dc, 3 dc in the same st, continue on the other side of the chain row, 15 dc, 2 dc in the last st, turn (37)

Row 2: ch 2, skip the first st, 15 dc, [1 inc] x5, 15 dc, 1 dc in the t-ch, turn (42)

Row 3: ch 2, skip the first st, 15 dc, [1 inc] x10, 15 dc, 1 dc in the t-ch, turn (52)

Row 4: ch 2, skip the first st, 1 dc in each st, 1 dc in the t-ch, turn (52)

Row 5: ch 2, skip the first st, 17 dc, [1 inc, 1 dc] x8, 17 dc, 1 dc in the t-ch, turn (60)

Row 6: ch 2, skip the first st, 1 dc in each st, 1 dc in the t-ch, turn (60)

Row 7: ch 2, skip the first st, 18 dc, [1 inc, 2 dc] x8, 16 dc, 1 dc in the t-ch, turn (68)

Row 8-16: ch 2, skip the first st, 1 dc in each st, 1 dc in the t-ch, turn (9 rows, 68)

Cut yarn but leave a long tail for sewing.

SCARF

Using Baby Snuggle Solid and a 6.0 mm hook

Ch 20.

Row 1: 1 dc in the 3rd st from the hook, 1 dc in each st, turn

Row 2: Ch 2 (counts as 1 dc), skip the first st, 1 dc in each st, turn

Repeat row 2 until the scarf measures 145 cm.

If you want a longer scarf just make a few more rows. But note that if so you may need one more skein of Baby Snuggle Solid.

Do NOT cut the yarn.

Attaching the hood

Measure out the middle of the scarf and place the hood along one of the wide sides of the scarf. Make sure that the hood is in the middle of it.

Sew on the hood.

Single crochet using a 6.0 mm hook all around the scarf and the hood with 3 sc in each corner. Fasten all threads.

POCKET (make 2)

Using Baby Snuggle Solid and a 6.0 mm hook

Ch 15

Row 1: 1 dc in the 3rd ch from the hook, 1 dc in each st, turn

Row 2-6: Ch 2 (counts as 1 dc), skip the first st, 1 dc in each st, turn

Single crochet on 3 of the sides with 3 sc in each corner.

Fasten all threads.

Sew on the pockets using sewing thread.

EAR (make 2)

Using Baby Snuggle and a 5.5 hook

Start with a magic ring

Rnd 1: 6 sc in the magic ring (6)

Rnd 2: 6 sc (6)

Rnd 3: [1 inc] x6 (12)

Rnd 4-5: 12 sc (2 rounds, 12)

Rnd 6: [1 sc, 1 inc] x6 (18)

Rnd 7-10: 18 sc (4 rounds, 18)

Cut yarn but leave a long tail for sewing.

EYE WHITES (make 2)

Using Rainbow 8/8 in White and a 3.5 mm hook

Start with a magic ring

Rnd 1: 6 sc in the magic ring (6)

Rnd 2: [1 inc] x6 (12)

Rnd 3: [1 sc, 1 inc] x6 (18)

Rnd 4: 1 sc, 1 inc, [2 sc, 1 inc] x5, 1 sc (24)

Rnd 5: [3 sc, 1 inc] x6 (30)

Fasten all threads.

Embroider eyelashes using white thread.

CHEEKS (make 2)

Using Rainbow 8/8 in Pink and a 3.5 mm hook

Start with a magic ring

Rnd 1: 6 sc in the magic ring (6)

Rnd 2: [1 inc] x6 (12)

Rnd 3: [1 sc, 1 inc] x6 (18)

Fasten all threads.

HORN

Using Rainbow 8/8 in Vanilla and a 3.5 mm hook

Start with a magic ring

Rnd 1: 6 sc in the magic ring (6)

Rnd 2: 6 sc (6)

Rnd 3: [1 inc] x6 (12)

Rnd 4-5: 12 sc (2 rounds, 12)

Rnd 6: [1 sc, 1 inc] x6 (18)

Rnd 7-8: 18 sc (2 rounds, 18)

Rnd 9: [2 sc, 1 inc] x6 (24)

Rnd 10-18: 24 sc (9 rounds, 24)

Fasten all threads

ROSE (make 3)

Using double threads of Rainbow 8/8 and a 5.5 mm hook

Ch 8

Rnd 1: Start in the 2nd ch from the hook, 2 sc in each st, ch 1 and turn (14)

Rnd 1: 2 sc in each st (28)

Fold the piece to a rose and sew the piece together so it doesn't roll up again.

LEAF (make 4)

Using double threads of Rainbow 8/8 and a 5.5 mm hook

Ch 6

Rnd 1: Start in the 2nd ch from the hook, 1 sc in the next 3 sts, 1 hdc in the next 2 sts (5)

Cut the yarn but leave a long tail for sewing.

Sew on two leaves on to two of the roses.

ASSEMBLING

Pin the ears to the hood and sew them on.

Pin the eyes and cheeks on to the hood and sew them on.

Stuff the horn with stuffing and sew it on.

Sew on the roses, place the one without leaves in the middle.

Cut pieces of yarn in different colors and use as fringes. See pictures further down in the pattern.

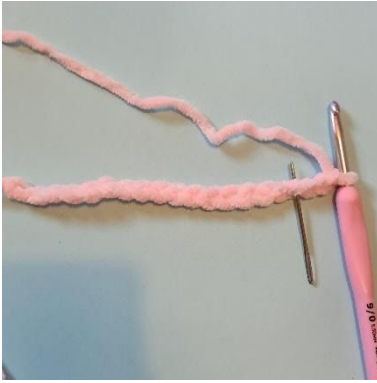

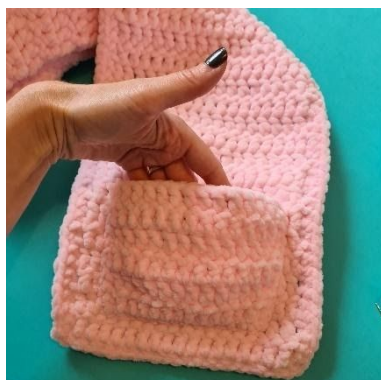
