



Agnete - Hat

Materials

1 (1, 1) skein of Babywool color 15
1 (1, 1) skein of Diablo color 49

Circular needle 6 (4.0 mm) and 8 (5.0 mm)
32" (80 cm) for Magic loop
Double pointed needle/cable needle

Yarn quality

Babywool, Happy Sheep
100% wool/ 50 g = 230 meters

Diablo, Hobbii
40% Akryl, 30% Mohair, 30% Polyamid/
25 g = 225 meters

Gauge

18 sts and 25 rows on 4" (10 cm) in
stockinette st on needle no. 8 (5.0 mm)

Sizes

S (M, L)

Measurements

18½" (20", 21¼") or 47 (51, 54) cm,
expands in the width.

Pattern information

The hat is knit in the round using 1 strand
of each quality, on a circular needle using
the magic loop technique.

Abbreviations

Dec 2 sts: slip 2 sts as to knit tog, k1,
pass the slipped sts over.

M st: Marked st

CN: extra needle/cable needle

Hat

Cast on 80 (88, 92) sts on needle no. 6 (4,0 mm) and knit in the round. Place a marker at the beginning of the round.


Knit 2" (2½", 3") or 5 (6, 7) cm of ribbing: k1, p1.

Change to needle no. 8 (5,0 mm).

Knit pattern from diagram over the first 22 sts and knit stockinette st over the remaining sts.

Knit in the round until you have 5 reps of the diagram all in all.

Diagram



Knit



Purl



Place 2 sts on a cable stitch holder **BEHIND** the work, k2, k the 2 sts on the cable stitch holder



Place 2 sts on a cable stitch holder **IN FRONT OF** the work, k2, k the 2 sts on the cable stitch holder

Divide for decreases

Now remove the marker at the beginning of the round.

In stead, place a marker in the st **BEFORE** the beginning of the round.

NB! This will mark the beginning of the round on all subsequent rounds.

Count 23 (23, 23) sts and place a marker around the st = M st, count 17 (21, 23) sts and place a marker around the st, count 23 (23, 23) sts and place a marker around the st, there's now 17 (21, 23) sts to the first marker = 4 marked sts.

Now decrease like this:

1st round: *k to 1 st before **M st, dec 2 sts***. Rep * - * around = 8 sts dec = 72 (80, 84) sts.

2nd round: knit.

3rd round: *k to 1 st before **M st, dec 2 sts***. Rep * - * around = 64 (72, 76) sts.

4th round: knit.

5th round: *k to 1 st before **M st, dec 2 sts***. Rep * - * around = 56 (64, 68) sts.

6th round: knit.

7th round: *K to 1 st before **M st, dec 2 sts** *. Rep * - * around = 48 (56, 60) sts.

8th round: knit.

9th round: *K to 1 st before **M st, dec 2 sts** *. Rep * - * around = 40 (48, 52) sts.

10th round: knit.

11th round: *K to 1 st before **M st, dec 2 sts** *. Rep * - * around = 32 (40, 44) sts.

12th round: knit.

13th round: *K to 1 st before **M st, dec 2 sts** *. Rep * - * around = 24 (32, 36) sts.

14th round: knit.

15th round: *K to 1 st before **M st, dec 2 sts** *. Rep * - * around = 16 (24, 28) sts.

16th round: knit.

Only size S

17th round: *k2tog * Rep * - * around = 8 sts.

Only sizes M og L

17th round: *K to 1 st before **M st, dec 2 sts** *. Rep * - * around = (16, 20) sts.

18th round: knit.

19th round: *K to 1 st before **M st, dec 2 sts** *. Rep * - * around = (8, 12) sts.

Assembling

Cut the yarn and pull the end through the sts, tighten and weave in on the wrong side.
