Materials 2 skeins of BabyWool, color 23

Double pointed needles in sizes 2,5 mm & 3 mm

## Yarn

**BabyWool**, Happy Sheep 100% wool, 50 g = 165 meters

#### Gauge

24 stitches & 28 rows = 10 cm in stockinette st on size 3 mm needles

Sizes S (M, L)

Measurements Circumference: 50 (53, 56) cm, has sideways stretch

#### Pattern information

The hat is knitted from the bottom up and has a ribbed edge that folds over, and there are decreases at the crown.

## **Pattern Instructions**

## Ribbing

Cast on 120 (128, 136) sts on a size 2,5 mm needle and join to knit in the round. Knit 12 cm of ribbing: knit 2, purl 2.

## Hat

Change to a size 3 mm needle and continue in stockinette st. Knit until work measures 17 (18, 19) cm from the cast on edge.

#### Decreases

Place a stitch marker at the beginning of the row. **Row 1:** \*knit 13 (14, 15), knit 2 together\*, repeat between \*-\* until the end of the row = 8 stitches decreased = 112 (120, 128) sts. **Row 2:** knit. **Row 3:** \*knit 12 (13, 14), knit 2 together\*, repeat between \*-\* until the end of the row = 8 stitches decreased = 104 (112, 120) sts. **Row 4:** knit. **Row 5:** \*knit (12, 13), knit 2 together\*, repeat between \*-\* until the end of the row = 8 stitches decreased = 96 (104, 112) sts. **Row 6:** knit. Continue in this manner with a diminishing number of sts between decreases until there are 24 sts left.

Knit 2 together until there are 12 sts left. Break the yarn and pull it through the remaining sts, pull tight and weave in the ends.

Fold the ribbing in half.
