

## Volga - Gloves

No. 2004-204-4462

Materials
2 balls of BabyWool, color 23
Double pointed needles 2.5 mm and 3 mm (approx. US 2 and US 3)
Stitch markers

## Yarn properties

(22) BabyWool, Happy Sheep

100 \% wool / 1.7 oz ( 50 g ) = 180 yds ( 165 m )

## Gauge

25 sts x 30 rows $=4$ " ( 10 cm )
with needle 3 mm (approx. US 3)

Size
S (M, L)
Finished size
Girth: approx. 6.3" (7.1", 7.9"). The gloves will stretch in the width.
Length (from the bottom to the tip of the middle finger): approx. 9.8" (10.2", 10.6")

## About the pattern

 The gloves are knit bottom up from the cuff. The fingers are knit separately. The thumb is knit last.Hashtags on social media \#hobbiidesign \#hobbiivolga

## Pattern

## Cuff

Loosely co 40 (44) 48) sts on needle 3 mm (approx. US 3). Change to needle 2.5 mm (approx. US 2) and knit in the round.
Knit 2.4" of ribbing like this: k2, p2

## Left glove

Change to needle 3 mm (approx. US 3) and knit st st. On the first rnd, inc with $0(1,2)$ sts = $40(45,50)$ sts.
Work straight for $1.0^{\prime \prime}$.

## Increasing for the thumb

Place a stitch marker at the beg. of the rnd.
Rnd 1: k1, yo, k until 1 st remains before the marker, yo, k1 =
2 incs.
Rnd 2: k throughout the rnd. The incs are $\mathrm{ktbl}=2$ incs $=42(47,52)$ sts.
Rnd 3: k2, yo, k until 2 sts remain before the marker, yo, k2 = 2 incs.
Rnd 4: k throughout the rnd. The incs are $\mathrm{ktbl}=2$ incs $=44(49,54)$ sts.
Rnd 5: k3, yo, $k$ until 3 sts remain before the marker, yo, k3 = 2 incs.
Rnd 6: $k$ throughout the rnd. The incs are $k \mathrm{tbl}=2$ incs $=46(51,56)$ sts.
Continue like this, i.e. with one inc on each side of the marker, until $54(61,68)$ sts.
End the rnd $8(9,10)$ sts before the beg of the rnd.
Put the $16(18,20)$ sts for the thumb on hold (on a strand of yarn), co 2 new sts and $k$ throughout the rnd $=40(45,50)$ sts on the rnd.

Work straight until the work measures approx. 1.6" from the thumb sts on hold. End at the beg of the rnd = above the middle of the thumb sts.

## Index finger

Place $6(7,8)$ sts from the left side of the marker and $7(8,9)$ sts from the right side on double pointed needles $=13(15,17)$ sts.
Put the remaining sts on hold (on a strand of yarn).
Co 4 new sts on the inside of the finger $=17(19,21)$ sts.
Work straight until the finger measures approx. 2.4"-2.6".
Decreasing for the fingertip: k2tog until 4 sts remain. Cut off the yarn, pull it through the sts, tighten it and weave in the end.

## Middle finger

Place $4(5,5)$ sts from the left side of the marker and $4(5,6)$ sts from the right side on double pointed needles $=8(10,11)$ sts.
(The remaining sts stay on the strand of yarn.)
Pick up 4 new sts from the index finger and co 4 new sts on the outside $=16(18,19)$ sts. Work straight until the finger measures approx. 2.6"-3.1".
Decreasing for the fingertip: k2tog until 4 sts remain. Cut off the yarn, pull it through the sts, tighten it and weave in the end.

## Ring finger

Place $4(4,5)$ sts from the left side of the marker and $4(5,5)$ sts from the right side on double pointed needles $=8(9,10)$ sts.
(The remaining sts stay on the strand of yarn.)
Pick up 4 new sts from the middle finger and co 4 new sts on the outside $=16(17,18)$ sts. Work straight until the finger measures approx. 2.4"-2.6".
Decreasing for the fingertip: k2tog until 4 sts remain. Cut off the yarn, pull it through the sts, tighten it and weave in the end.

## Little finger

Place the remaining $11(11,12)$ sts on double pointed needles. Pick up 4 new sts from the ring finger $=15(15,16)$ sts.
Work straight until the finger measures approx. 1.6"-2.0".
Decreasing for the fingertip: k2tog until 4 sts remain. Cut off the yarn, pull it through the sts, tighten it and weave in the end.

Thumb $16(18,20)$ sts on hold
Place the $16(18,20)$ sts on double pointed needles 3 mm (approx. US 3 ) and pick up 2 sts on the glove $=18(20,22)$ sts.
Knit st st until the thumb measures approx. 2.0" (2.2", 2.4").
Decreasing for the thumb tip: k2tog until 6 sts remain. Cut off the yarn, pull it through the sts, tighten it and weave in the end.

## Right glove

On the right glove, the sts are reversed like this:
Index finger: Place $7(8,9)$ sts from the left side of the marker and $6(7,8)$ sts from the right side on double pointed needles $=13(15,17)$ sts.

Middle finger: Place $4(5,6)$ sts from the left side of the marker and $4(5,5)$ sts from the right side on double pointed needles $=8(10,11)$ sts.

Ring finger: Place $4(5,5)$ sts from the left side of the marker and $4(4,5)$ sts from the right side on double pointed needles $=8(9,10)$ sts.

Little finger: Place the remaining $11(11,12)$ sts on double pointed needles.
