



# Christy - Sweater

## Materials

6 (6, 7) skeins of Mohair Delight, color 20  
1 cone Glitter 'deluxe', color Winter Red  
Circular needles sz. 4 (3.5 mm) and sz. 7  
(4.5 mm) / 32" (80 cm)  
Stitch markers

## Yarn qualities

**Mohair Delight**, Hobbii

50% mohair, 50% acrylic / 1.75 oz. (50 g) =  
164 yds (150 meter)

**Glitter 'deluxe'**, Go Handmade

100% polyester/ 3.5 oz. (100 g) = 7655 yds  
(7000 meter)

## Gauge

20 sts and 26 rounds/rows = 4" (10 cm) in  
pattern on needle no. 7 (4.5 mm) using 2  
strands of yarn.

## Size

S (M, L)

## Measurements

Width: 17.7" (21.6", 25.6") or 45 (55, 65) cm

Length: 18.1" (18.9", 19.7") or 46 (48, 50) cm

## Pattern information

Knit with 1 strand of Mohair Delight and 1 strand  
of Glitter 'deluxe' = 2 strands.

The sweater is knitted from the bottom up. The  
body is knitted in the round. When the shoulder  
seams are sewn together, you knit up stitches for  
sleeves.

**NOTE.** The sweater is knitted with the wrong side  
out and is to be turned around when finished.

Pay special attention to this when assembling  
and knitting up stitches for sleeves.

This is a short and wide model, so opt. try on the  
sweater to measure sleeve length.

### **Pattern in the round**

**1st round:** \*k1, p1\*, repeat from \* to \*.

**2nd round:** Knit.

Repeat 1st-2nd round.

### **Pattern back and forth**

**Wrong side row:** \*k1, p1\*, repeat from \* to \*.

**Right side row:** Knit.

### **Body**

Cast on 180 (220, 260) sts on circular needles no. 4 (3.5 mm).

Knit rib: \*k1tbl, p1\*.

Knit 7 rounds of rib all in all.

Turn the work.

Switch to needle no. 7 (4.5 mm) and knit **pattern in the round** until the work measures 11" (11.4", 11.8") or 28 (29, 30) cm. Now, the work is separated in to front- and back pieces.

Number of stitches on front/back = 90 (110, 130) sts.

### **Back**

Continue knitting **pattern back and forth** until the work measures 18.1" (18.9", 19.7") or 46 (48, 50) cm.

### **Shoulders and neck**

Place stitch markers after 23 (31, 39) sts from each side to shoulder.

### **Front**

Is knitted like the back until the work measures 15.7" (16.5", 17.3") or 40 (42, 44) cm.

### **Neckline**

#### **Left shoulder**

Continue with **pattern back and forth**.

**Right side row:** Knit 32 (40, 48) sts, set the remaining sts aside on the needle.

**Wrong side row:** Cast off 5 sts and knit across.

**Right side row:** Knit

**Wrong side row:** Cast off 4 sts and knit across = 23 (31, 39) sts for shoulder.

Knit straight up until the work measures 18.1" (18.9", 19.7") or 46 (48, 50) cm.

Cast off the 23 (31, 39) sts of the shoulder.

Place the center 26 (30, 34) sts on a stitch holder.

#### **Right shoulder**

**Wrong side row:** Attach yarn and knit the remaining 32 (40, 48) sts.

Continue with **pattern back and forth**.

**Right side row:** Cast off 5 sts and knit across.

**Wrong side row:** Knit **pattern back and forth**.

**Right side row:** Cast off 4 sts and knit across = 23 (31, 39) sts for shoulder.  
Knit straight up until the work measures 18.1" (18.9", 19.7") or 46 (48, 50) cm.  
Cast off the 23 (31, 39) sts of the shoulder.

Sew the shoulder seams together.

**NOTE.** Be aware that the finished model's right side is the wrong side of the work, so the wrong sides of the work need to be towards each other when the shoulder seams are sewn together.

## Sleeve

Knit up 76-80 sts from the wrong side of the work. Then turn the work so the right side is facing out. Knit in the round using magic loop.

Knit **pattern in the round** until the sleeve measures 15.8" or 40 cm.

Turn the work.

Switch to circular needles no. 4 (3.5 mm) and decrease 26-30 sts evenly = 50 sts.

Knit 7 rounds of rib: \*k1tbl, p1\*.

Cast off.

Knit the other sleeve just the same.

## Neckline

From the wrong side of the work, knit up approx. 100-110 sts in the neckline on a circular needle no. 4 (3.5 mm).

Knit 7 rounds of rib: \*k1tbl, p1\* (magic loop).

Cast off loosely in rib.
