



Salt and Pepper - Fingerless Gloves

Skill Level: Beginner **Measurements:** Wrist Width: 10.5 cm

Fingers section width: 10 cm

Length: 20 cm

Crochet Hook: 4 mm (US size G)

Materials: Sewing needle for weaving in the

ends, scissors

Gauge: 14 sts = 10 cm

13 rows = 10 cm

in the stitch pattern used

Yarn: Hurricane Film Noir (#8) - 1 cake

Info: Half a cake will be enough to make these fingerless gloves. With 1 cake you can make the gloves and the Salt and Pepper Cowl, that matches the gloves.



Abbreviations used in this pattern:

Ch - chain

Sc - single crochet

Dc - double crochet

BPdc - back post double crochet: Insert the hook from back to front (= right space of a post) and then from front to back (= left space of same post). Work the dc around the post of a stitch.

FPdc - front post double crochet: yarn over, insert the hook from front to back (= right space of a post) and then from back to front (=left space of same post). Work the dc around the post of the stitch.

SI st - slip stitch

St(s) - stitch (es)

* repeat section

R - row/round


Final Measurements

This pattern is available in one size.

Wrist Width a: 10.5 cm


Fingers section width b: 10 cm

Length c: 20 cm





Stitch chart (without ribbing)



Pattern Notes

Ch 3 at the beginning of the round count as first st.

All rounds are connected with a slip stitch in the 3rd stitch of the starting chain.

If you want to adjust the width, chain a multiple of 2 plus Ch 3 and start with 1st dc in the 5th chain from the hook.

Instructions

Left Glove

Start Ch 30 and join the ends with a sl st to make a circle.

R1| Ch 3, starting with 5th st, 1 dc in each st, join with a sl st with 3rd st of the starting ch.

R2| Ch 3, *1 FPdc, 1 BPdc* Repeat until you have 1 st left, 1 FPdc, join with a sl st with 3rd st of the starting ch.

R3| - R5| Repeat R2

R6| Ch 3, *1 BPdc, 1 FPdc* Repeat until you have 1 st left, 1 BPdc, join with a sl st with 3rd st of the starting ch.

R7| Repeat R2

R8-R17| Repeat R6 and R7



R18| Ch 3, 1 BPdc, 1 FPdc, 1 BPdc, ch 4, skip 6 sts, continue with the st pattern to the end of the round, join with a sl st with 3rd st of the turning ch.

R19| Ch 3, 1 FPdc, 1 BPdc, 1 FPdc, 1 dc in next 4 ch sts, continue with the st pattern to the end of the round, join with a sI st with 3rd st of the turning ch.

R20-R25| Repeat R6 and R7

Finish the glove with 1 more round of sc.

Fasten off.

Right Glove

R1-R17| Repeat the same pattern as for the left glove.

R18| Ch 3, *1BPdc, 1 FPdc* in the first 20 sts, ch 4, skip 6 sts, continue with the stitch pattern to the end of the round, join with a sl st with 3rd st of the starting chain.

R19 Ch 3, *1FPdc, 1 BPdc* in the first 20 sts, 1 dc in the next 4 ch sts, continue with the st pattern to the end of the round, join with a sl st with 3rd st of the starting chain.

R20-R25| Repeat R6 and R7

Finish the glove with 1 more round of sc.

Thumb

Start| Join yarn in one of sts of the thumb hole

R1| Ch 1, 1 sc in each st, join with a sl st with 1st sc.

R2-R4| Repeat R1

Fasten off.

Repeat the pattern of the other thumb hole.

Weave in all ends.
