



Mount Elbert - Headband and tube scarf

Materials

4 skeins Snowstorm, col 23

Straight needles, 10 mm (headband)
Circular needles 60 cm/ 12 mm (tube scarf)

Yarn

 **Snowstorm**, Hobbii
100% wool/ 50 g = 50 meters

Gauge

10 cm in moss stitch using 2 strands:
10 sts and 17 rows on 10 mm needles,
8 sts and 15 rows on 12 mm needles.

Size

Onesize

Measurements

Headband

Circumference: 52 cm

Width: 9 cm

Tube scarf

Circumference: 60 cm

Width: 20 cm

Pattern information

The headband is worked on 10 mm needles and the tube scarf is worked on 12 mm needles. They are made in moss stitch and 2 strands of yarn.

Tip

When switching to a new skein, the yarn ends can be fused, as they are 100% wool

Moss stitch

Row 1: *k1, p1*, repeat between **.

Row 2: p over k, k over p.

Repeat row 2..

Pattern instructions

Headband

Cast on 9 sts with 2 strands on 10 mm needles.

Row 1: Slip 1 st as k, work moss stitch until end of row.

Repeat this row until the work measures about 52 cm. You can measure it to fit your own head.

Bind off

Slip 1 st as k and bind off the rest of the sts in moss stitch.

Finishing

Twist the band once and sew the ends together. You can sew up both the right and wrong side.

Tube Scarf

Cast on 45 sts using 2 strands of yarn on 12 mm circular needles and work in the round.

Work in moss stitch in a spiral: *k1, p1* until the work measures about 20 cm.

NB Since you cast on an uneven number of stitches, you just continue the *k1, p1*-pattern on and on

Bind off in moss stitch.
