Stitch markers

## Yarn Quality

(44) Winter Glow, Hobbii

51\% wool, 49\% acrylic
$200 \mathrm{~g}(7 \mathrm{oz})=700$ meter $(765 \mathrm{yd})$

## Gauge

19 stitches and 26 rows equals 10 cm (3.9 in) of stockinette
22 stitches and 40 rows equals 10 cm (3.9 in) of design

## Abbreviations

$\mathrm{K}=$ knit
$P=$ purl
Yo = yarn over
SI 1 st = slip 1 stitch

Size
Onesize

## Measurements

Width along neck: 150 cm
Length at middle: 75 cm

## Pattern information

The shawl is knit from the middle of the neck down towards the tip. The shawl is knit on a circular needle because of the cast-ons and the many stitches at the end. There are increases on each side and in the middle.
NB The shawl weighs 200 grams ( 7 oz ), so, if you want a bigger shawl, you need to buy more yarn.

## Pattern instructions

## Shawl-cast-on

Cast on 5 sts on the circular needle and work 11 rows of garter stitch $=5$ grooves.
Pick up 5 sts along the left side $=10$ sts. Pick up 5 sts along the next side $=15$ sts.
NB There is always worked 5 sts of garter at each side as edge and 3 sts garter stitch in the middle, between increases.
The pattern stretches across 4 rows, the number of stitches is increased, and the "long" stitches are staggered.

The pattern is staggered in the pattern instructions because the increases at the edges and the middle displaces it.
The yarn behind the loose sts should be placed on the wrong side.
The loose stitches are staggered on every 2nd groove.
Place a marker at each increase.
Row 1 (RS): k5, yo, k1, yo, k3, yo, k1, yo, k5 = 19 sts.
Row 2 (WS): k5, p3, k3, p3, k5.
Row 3 (RS): k5, yo, k3, yo, k3, yo, k3, yo, k5 = 23 sts.
Row 4 (WS): $k$ all sts and yo's.
Row 5 (RS): k5, yo, k2, sl 1 st, k2, yo, k3, yo, k2, sl 1 st, k2, yo, k5 = 27 sts.
Row 6 (WS): k5, p3, sl 1 sts, p3, k3, p3, sl 1 st, p3, k5.
Row 7 (RS): k5, yo, k3, sl 1 st, k3, yo, k3, yo, k3, sl 1 st, k3, yo, k5 = 31 sts.
Row 8 (WS): knit all sts and yo's.
Row 9 (RS): k5, yo, k2, sl 1 st, k3, sl 1 st, k2, yo, k3, yo, k2, sl 1 st, k3, sl 1 st, k2, yo, k5 = 35 sts.
Row 10 (WS): k5, p3, sl 1 st, p3, sl 1 st, p3, k3, p3, sl 1 st, p3, sl 1 st, p3, k5.
Row 11 (RS): k5, yo, k3, sl 1 st, k3, sl 1 st, k3, yo, k3, yo, k3, sl 1 st, k3, sl 1 st, k3, yo, k5 = 39 sts.
Row 12 (WS): knit all sts and yo's.
Row 13 (RS): k5, yo, k2, * sl 1 st, k3 *. Repeat between ** 2 times in total. SI 1 st, k2, yo, k3, yo, k2, * sl 1 st, k3 *. Repeat between ** 2 times in total. SI 1 st, k2, yo, k5 = 43 sts.
Row 14 (WS): k5, p3, * sl 1 st, p3 *. Repeat between ** 3 times in total, k3, p3, * sl 1 st, p3 *. Repeat between ** 3 times in total, k5.
Row 15 (RS): k5, yo, k3, * sl 1 st, k3 *. Repeat between ** 3 times in total, yo, k3, yo, k3, * sl 1 st, k3 *. Repeat between ** 3 times in total, yo, k5 = 47 sts.
Row 16 (WS): knit all sts and yo's.
Row 17 (RS): k5, yo, k2, * sl 1 st, k3 *. Repeat between ** 3 times in total. SI 1 st, k2, yo, k3, yo, k2, * sl 1 st, k3 *. Repeat between ** 3 times in total. SI 1 st, k2, yo, k5 = 51 sts.
Row 18 (WS): k5, p3, * sl 1 st, p3 *. Repeat between ** 4 times in total, k3, p3, * sl 1 st, p3 *. Repeat between ** 4 times in total, k5.
Row 19 (RS): k5, yo, k3, * sl 1 st, k3 *. Repeat between ** 4 times in total, yo, k3, yo, k3, * sl

1 st, k3 *. Repeat between ** 4 times in total, yo, k5 = 55 sts.
Row 20 (WS): knit all sts and yo's.
Continue the pattern by repeating row $17-20$, where the number of stitches is increased between the increases.

Knit until your work measures approx 150 cm (59") along the neck, or until you only have enough yarn left to bind off. End with a row knit on WS. Bind off with k.
