



Tweed Hat

No. 1001-211-1638

Materials:

Tweed Delight color 15
Crochet hook 5
Pompom maker 8.5 cm

Gauge

Approx. 14 sts x 13 rows = 10 x 10 cm

Yarn usage approx. 115 (125)g

Sizes: S/M (L/XL)

Circumference: 52-54 (56/58) cm

Abbreviations:

Ch: Chain

St(s): Stitch(es)

Mr: Magic ring

Sc: Single crochet

Sl st: Slip stitch

Hdc: Half double crochet

FPdc: Front post double crochet

L-bl: Lower back loop

Note:

Work 1 ch at the beginning of each round - This does not count as a stitch, neither does it count towards the st total.

Finish all rounds with a sl st in the first stitch, not in the ch.

Sizes S/M

1. Make a mr. Ch 1 and work 12 dc into the ring. End with a sl st. (12)
2. Ch 1. "Work 1 dc in the first st and work 1 FPdc around the post of the same st". Repeat "to" to the end of the round. End with a sl st. (24)
3. Ch 1. "Work 1 dc in the first st and work 1 FPdc around the post of the same st and the next st". Repeat "to" to the end of the round. End with a sl st. (36)
4. Ch 1. "Work 1 dc in the first st, work 1 FPdc around the post of the first st and the next 2 sts". Repeat "to" to the end of the round. End with a sl st. (48)
5. Ch 1. "Work 1 dc in the first st, work 1 FPdc around the post of the first st and the next 3 sts". Repeat "to" to the end of the round. End with a sl st. (60)
6. Ch 1. "Work 1 dc in the first st, work 1 FPdc around the post of the first st and the next 29 sts". Repeat "to" 1 more time. End with a sl st. (62)
7. - 21. Ch 1. Work FPdc around. End with a sl st. (62)

Edge/hem

22. - 23. Ch 1. Work hdc around. End with a sl st. (62)
24. Ch 1 and turn. Work hdc around. End with a sl st. (62)
25. Ch 1. Work hdc around. End with a sl st. (62)
26. Ch 1. Work hdc around in the l-bl. End with a sl st. (62)
27. - 31. Ch 1. Work FPdc around. End with a sl st.(62)
31. Ch 1. Work sc around. End with a sl st. (62) Cut the yarn and weave in ends.

Make a pompom that measures approx. 8.5 cm. Sew it onto the top of the hat.

Sizes L/XL

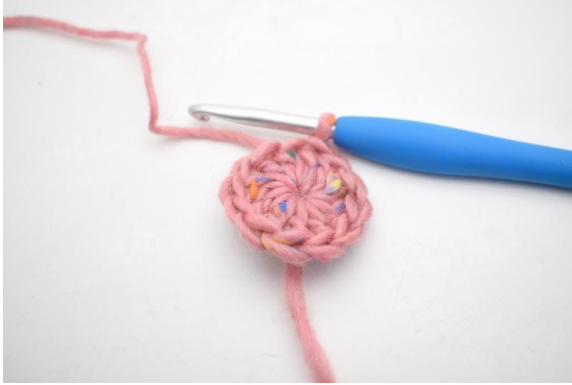
1. Make a mr. Ch 1 and work 12 dc into the ring. End with a sl st. (12)
2. Ch 1. "Work 1 dc in the first st and work 1 FPdc around the post of the same st". Repeat "to" to the end of the round. End with a sl st. (24)
3. Ch 1. "Work 1 dc in the first st and work 1 FPdc around the post of the same st and the next st". Repeat "to" to the end of the round. End with a sl st. (36)
4. Ch 1. "Work 1 dc in the first st, work 1 FPdc around the post of the first st and the next 2 sts". Repeat "to" to the end of the round. End with a sl st. (48)
5. Ch 1. "Work 1 dc in the first st, work 1 FPdc around the post of the first st and the next 3 sts". Repeat "to" to the end of the round. End with a sl st. (60)
6. Ch 1. "Work 1 dc in the first st, work 1 FPdc around the post of the first st and the next 9 sts". Repeat "to" to the end of the round. End with a sl st. (66)
7. - 21. Ch 1. Work FPdc around. End with a sl st. (66)

Edge/hem

22. - 23. Ch 1. Work hdc around. End with a sl st. (66)
24. Ch 1 and turn. Work hdc around. End with a sl st. (66)
25. Ch 1. Work hdc around. End with a sl st. (66)
26. Ch 1. Work hdc around in the l-bl. End with a sl st. (66)
27. - 31. Ch 1. Work FPdc around. End with a sl st. (66)
32. Ch 1. Work sc around. End with a sl st. (66) Cut the yarn and weave in ends.

Make a pompom that measures approx. 8.5 cm. Sew it onto the top of the hat.

Tutorial for the stitch pattern used in the hat



1. Make a mr. Ch 1 and work 12 dc into the ring. End with a sl st. (12)



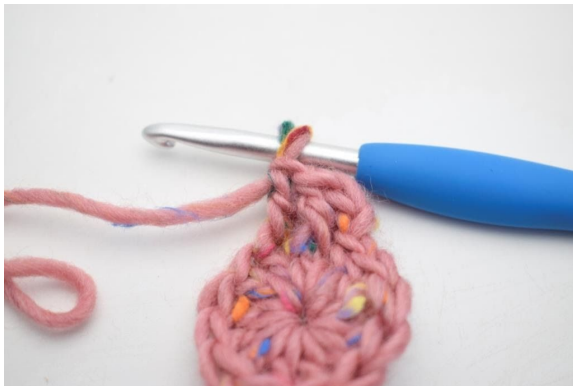
2. Ch 1. "Work 1 dc in the first st.



3. Work 1 FPdc around the post of the same st". A FPdc is a raised front post double crochet which is worked from the front around the dc post of the previous round. The needle indicates how to work the dc from the front and around the post.



4. This is how it will look.



5. "Work 1 dc in the next st."



6. Work 1 FPdc around the post of the same st".



7. This is how it will look.



8. "Work 1 dc in the next st and work 1 FPdc around the post of the same st".



9. Repeat "to" to the end of the round.



10. End with a sl st. (24)



11. Ch 1. "Work 1 dc in the first st.



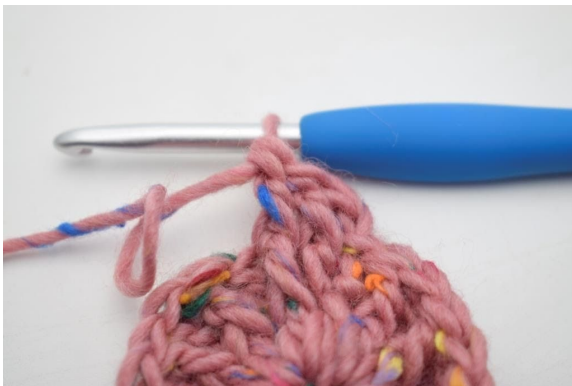
12. Work 1 FPdc around the post of the same st.



13. This is how it will look.



14. Work 1 FPdc around the next st".



15. This is how it will look.



16. "Work 1 dc in the next st.



17. Work 1 FPdc around the post of the same st.



18. This is how it will look.



19. Work 1 FPdc around the next st”.



20. This is how it will look.



21. “Work 1 dc in the next st and work 1 FPdc around the post of the same st and the next st”.



22. Repeat “to” to the end of the round.



23. End with a sl st. (36)



24. Ch 1. "Work 1 dc in the first st."



25. Work 1 FPdc around the post of the first st.



26. This is how it will look.



27. Work 1 FPdc around the next 2 sts".



28. "Work 1 dc in the next st, work 1 FPdc around the post of the first st and the next 2 sts".



29. Repeat "to" to the end of the round.

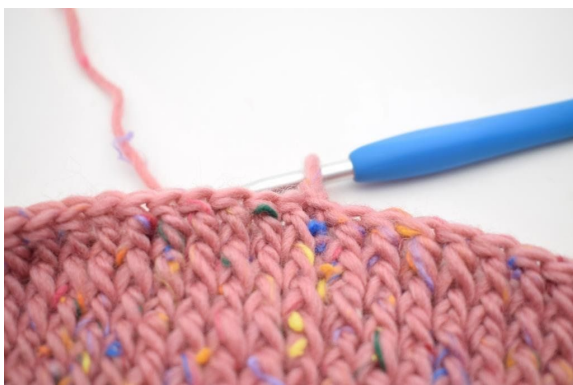


30. End with a sl st. (48)

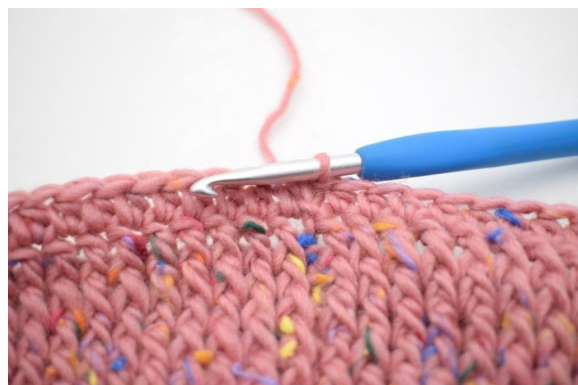


31. Continue as described in the pattern instructions until you reach the edge/hem.

Tutorial for the edge/hem



1. Ch 1.



2. Work hdc around. End with a sl st.



3. Work hdc around. End with a sl st.



4. Ch 1 and turn.



5. Now you will be working from the inside out. Work hdc around. End with a sl st.



6. This is how it will look.



7. Ch 1. Work hdc around. End with a sl st.



8. Ch 1.



9. Now, work hdc in the l-bl. This is the lower loop behind your 2 “regular” loops. The needle indicates the loop that you will be working your hdc into.



10. This is how it will look. We have now worked 1 hdc in the l-bl.



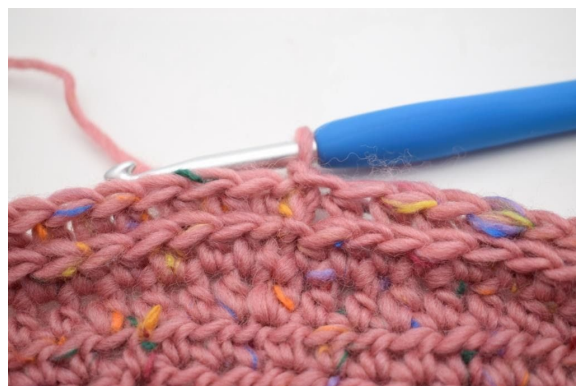
11. Work 1 hdc in the l-bl of the next st.



12. This is how it will look.



13. Work hdc around in the l-bl.



14. End with a sl st.



15. Ch 1. Work 1 FPdc around the first st.



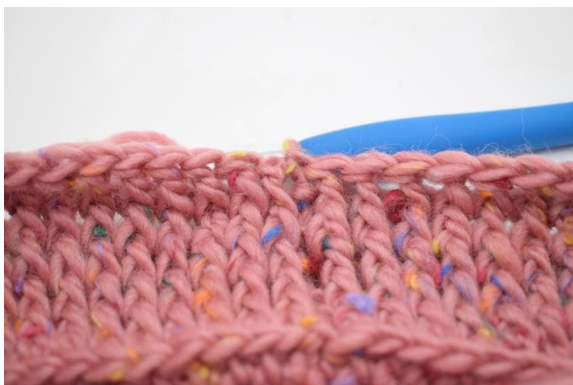
16. This is how it will look.



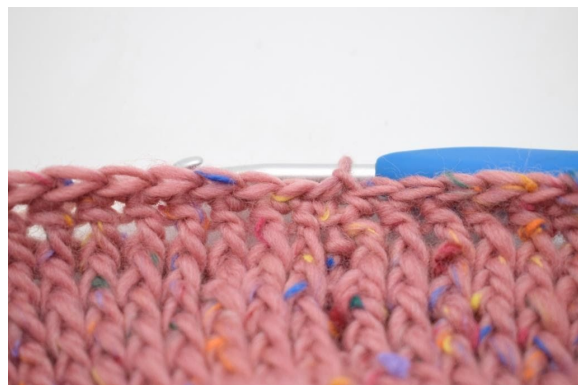
17. Work 1 FPdc around the next st.



18. Work FPdc around. End with a sl st.



19. Repeat the FPdc rounds as described in the pattern instructions.



20. Work sc around to finish the edge/hem. Ch 1. Work sc around. End with a sl st. Cut the yarn and weave in ends.



21. Fold the edge over to make the hem.

Pompom



1. Make a pom-pom and leave a long tail for assembling.



2. Sew the pom-pom onto the top of the hat.
