



# Tweed Wrist Warmers

No. 1001-204-3045

**Materials:**

Tweed Delight color 15  
Crochet hook 5

**Gauge**

Approx. 14 sts x 13 rows = 10 x 10 cm

**Yarn usage approx.** 80 (100)g per pair

**Sizes:** S/M (L/XL)

**Circumference:** Approx. 18-20 (20-22) cm

**Length:** Approx. 20 cm

**Abbreviations**

**Ch:** Chain

**St(s):** Stitch(es)

**Sc:** Single crochet

**Sl st:** Slip stitch

**Hdc:** Half double crochet

**FPdc:** Front post double crochet

**Note:**

Work 1 sl st at the beginning of each round - This does not count as a stitch, neither does it count towards the st total.

Finish all rounds with a sl st in the first stitch, not in the ch.

When casting on, it's a good idea to keep the chain stitches loose or use a larger hook to avoid that the base chain becomes too tight.

**Pattern** – Photo tutorial can be found following the written pattern

**Left:**

1. Ch 24 (27) and join into a ring with a slip stitch in the first ch. Ch 1 and slightly tilt your base chain. Work in the horizontal loops that appear. Work hdc around and end with a sl st. = 24 (27)
2. - 18. Ch 1. Work FPdc around. End with a sl st. = 24 (27)
19. Ch 1. Work 1 FPdc around the first 6 (7) sts. Ch 3 and skip 3 sts. Work 1 Fpdc around the last 15 (17) sts. End with a sl st. = 24 (27)
20. Ch 1. Work 1 FPdc around the first 6 (7) sts. Work 1 hdc in the ch 3 of the previous round. Work 1 FPdc around the last 15 (17) sts. End with a sl st. = 24 (27)
21. - 27. Ch 1. Work FPdc around. End with a sl st. = 24 (27)
28. Ch 1. Work sc around and end with a sl st. = 24 (27). Cut the yarn and weave in ends.

Work a round of sc in the base chain. End with a sl st. Weave in ends.



**Right:**

1. Ch 24 (27) and join into a ring with a slip stitch in the first ch. Ch 1 and slightly tilt your base chain. Work in the horizontal loops that appear. Work hdc around and end with a sl st. = 24 (27)
2. - 18. Ch 1. Work FPdc around. End with a sl st. = 24 (27)
19. Ch 1. Work 1 FPdc around the first 15 (17) sts. Ch 3 and skip 3 sts. Work 1 FPdc around the last 6 (7) sts. End with a sl st. = 24 (27)
20. Ch 1. Work 1 FPdc around the first 15 (17) sts. Work 1 hdc in the ch 3 of the previous round. Work 1 FPdc around the last 6 (7) sts. End with a sl st. = 24 (27)
21. - 27. Ch 1. Work FPdc around. End with a sl st. = 24 (27)
28. Ch 1. Work sc around and end with a sl st. = 24 (27). Cut the yarn and weave in ends.

Work a round of sc in the base chain. End with a sl st. Weave in ends.





**Photo tutorial:**

**Round 1**



1. Ch 24 (27) and join into a ring with a slip stitch in the first ch.



2. Ch 1 and slightly tilt your base chain.



3. Now, work in the horizontal loops.



4. Work 1 hdc in the first ch.



5. Work hdc around.



6. End with a sl st. = 24 (27)

## Round 2



7. Ch 1.



8. Work 1 FPdc around the first st. A FPdc is a raised double dc which is worked from the front around the post of the previous row. The needle indicates where to work the dc from the front and around the post.



9. This is how it will look.



10. Work 1 FPdc around the next st.



11. This is how it will look.

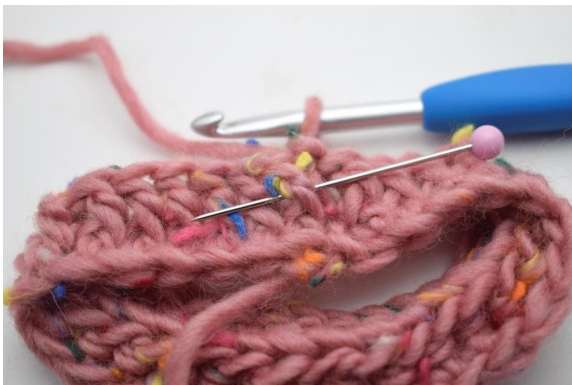


12. Work FPdc around.



13. End with a sl st. = 24 (27)

### Round 3



14. This round is a repetition of round 2. Ch 1. Work 1 FPdc around the first st.



15. This is how it will look.



16. Work FPdc around. End with a sl st. = 24 (27)

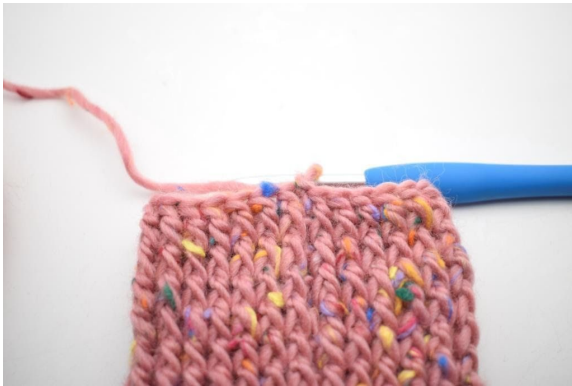


17. Ch 1. Work FPdc around. End with a sl st. = 24 (27)

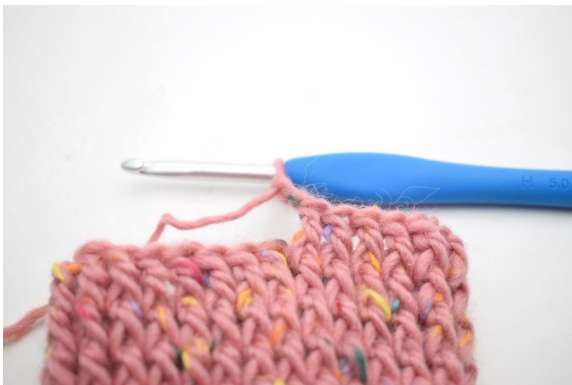




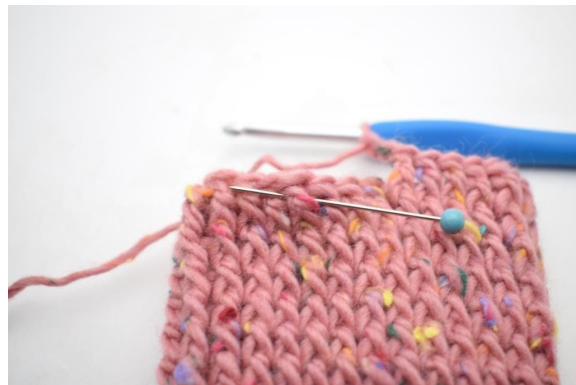
18. Ch 1.

21. Skip 3 sts.



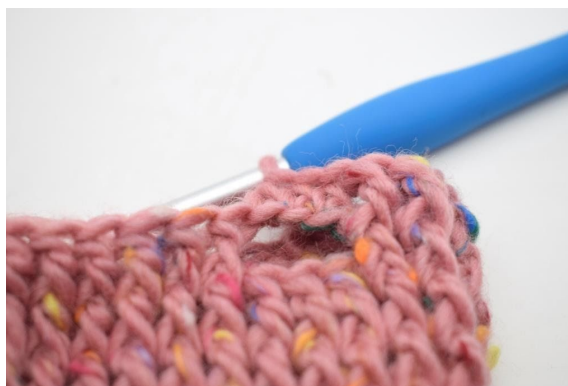
22. Work 1 FPdc around the last 15 (17) sts. End with a sl st. = 24 (27)

## Round 20

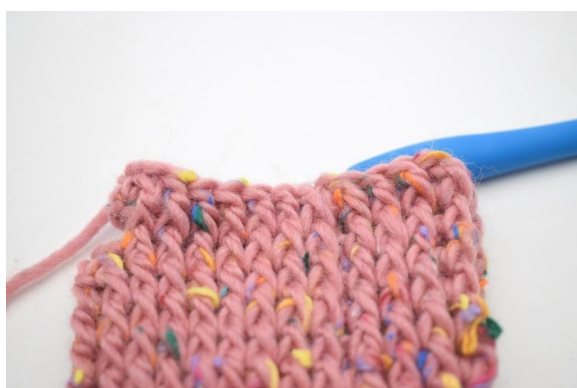




23. Ch 1. Work 1 FPdc around the first 6 (7) sts.

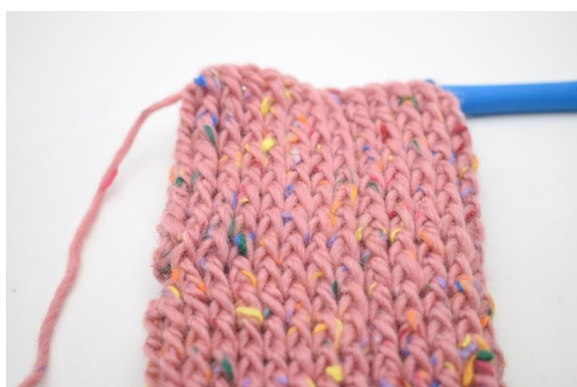


24. Work 1 hdc in the ch 3 of the previous round.



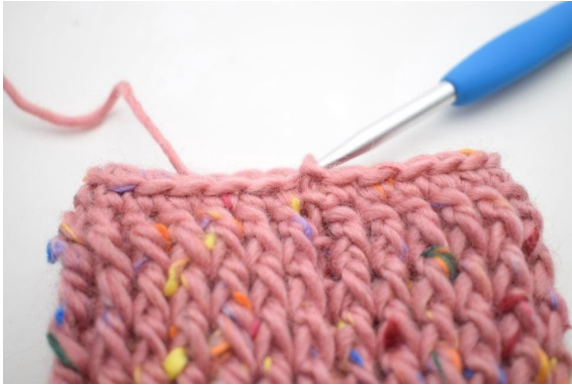
25. Work 1 FPdc around the last 15 (17) sts. End with a sl st. = 24 (27)

### Rounds 21-27

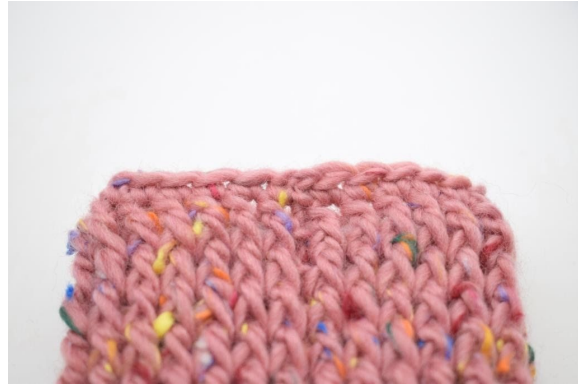


26. Ch 1. Work FPdc around. End with a sl st. = 24 (27)

## Round 28



27. Ch 1. Work sc around and end with a sl st. = 24 (27).

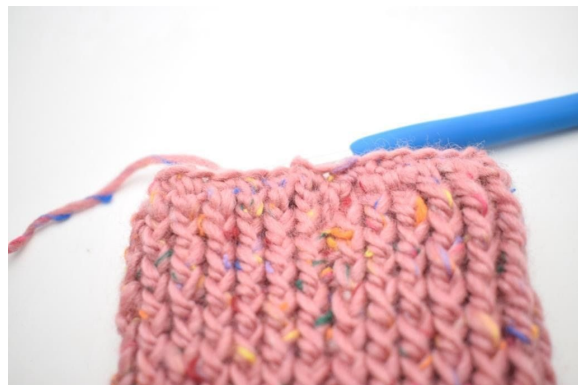


28. Cut the yarn and weave in ends.

29. Work 1 round of sc in the base chain.



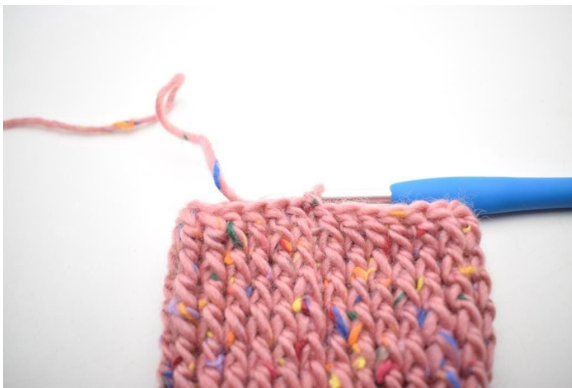
30. End with a sl st. Weave in ends.



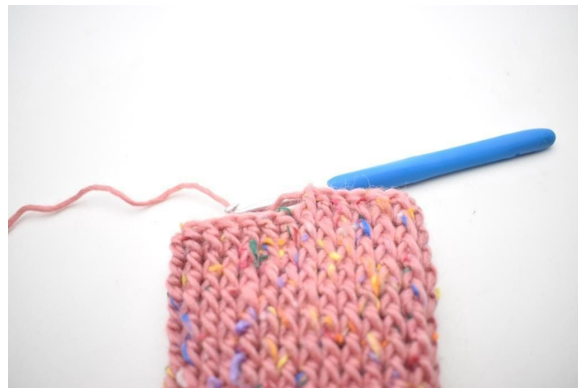

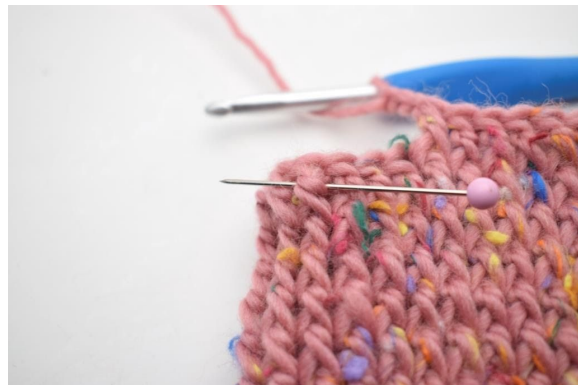
32. Ch 1.



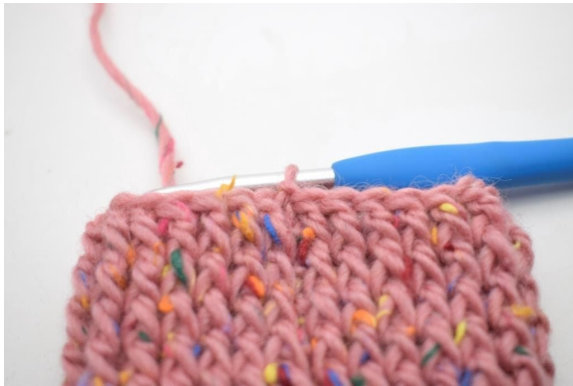
33. Work 1 FPdc around the first 15 (17) sts.

End with a sl st. = 24 (27)

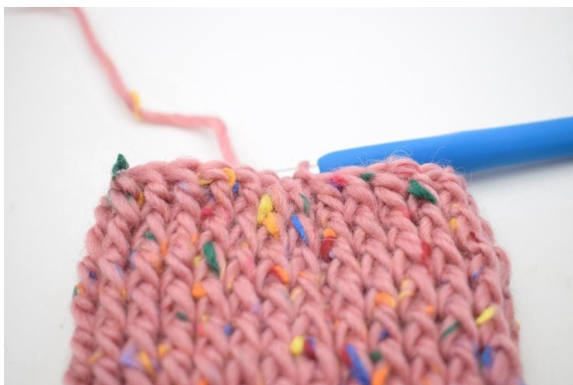
### Round 20



37. Ch 1. Work 1 FPdc around the first 15 (17) sts.



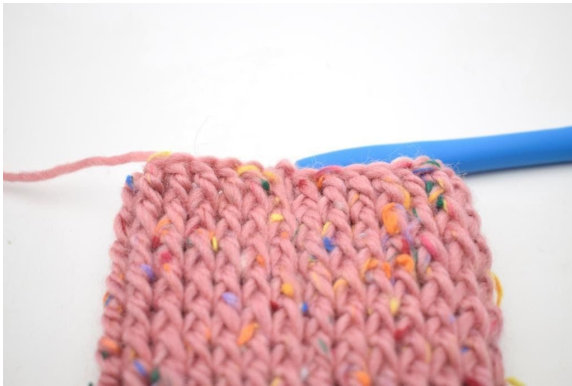
38. Work 1 hdc in the ch 3 of the previous round.

### Rounds 21-27





40. Ch 1. Work FPdc around. End with a sl st. = 24 (27)

### Round 28



41. Ch 1. Work sc around and end with a sl st. = 24 (27).

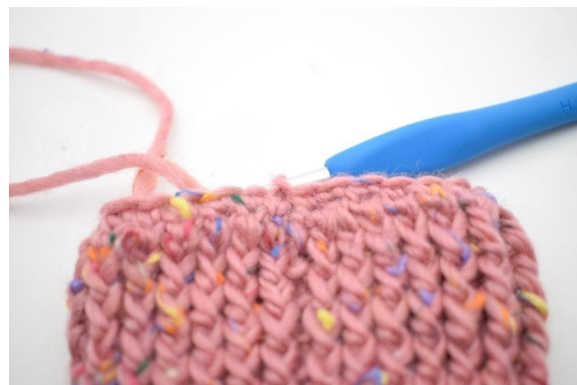


42. Cut the yarn and weave in ends.

### Edge in the base chain.



43. Work 1 round of sc in the base chain.



44. End with a sl st.



45. Weave in ends.
