



Siggy Baggy Hat

Materials:

Hobbii Metallico color 4 Crochet hook 5

Gauge

Approx.14 sts x 13 rows = $10 \times 10 \text{ cm}$

Yarn usage approx. 105 (115)g

Sizes: S/M (L/XL)

Circumference: 52-54 (56-58)

Abbreviations

Ch: Chain

St(s): Stitch(es)
Mr: Magic ring
SI st: Slip stitch

Dc: Double crochet

FPdc: Front post double crochet



Note:

Ch 1 at the beginning of each round - This does not count as a stitch, neither does it count towards the st total.

Finish all rounds with a sl st in the first stitch, not in the ch.

<u>Pattern</u> – Photo tutorial can be found following the written pattern

Sizes S/M

- 1. Make a mr. Ch 1 and work 12 dc into the ring. End with a sl st. (12)
- 2. Ch 1. "Work 1 dc in the first st and work 1 FPdc around the post of the same st". Repeat "to" to the end of the round. End with a sl st. (24)
- 3. Ch 1. "Work 1 dc in the first st and work 1 FPdc around the post of the same st and the next st". Repeat "to" to the end of the round. End with a sl st. (36)
- **4.** Ch 1. "Work 1 dc in the first st, work 1 FPdc around the post of the first st and the next 2 sts". Repeat "to" to the end of the round. End with a sl st. (48)
- **5.** Ch 1. "Work 1 dc in the first st, work 1 FPdc around the post of the first st and the next 3 sts". Repeat "to" to the end of the round. End with a sl st. (60)
- **6.** Ch 1. Work FPdc around. End with a sl st. (60)

Repeat round 6 until your hat measures 24-25 cm.

Ch 1. Work sc around and end with a sl st. Cut the yarn and weave in ends.



Sizes L/XL

- 1. Make a mr. Ch 1 and work 12 dc into the ring. End with a sl st. (12)
- 2. Ch 1. "Work 1 dc in the first st and work 1 FPdc around the post of the same st". Repeat "to" to the end of the round. End with a sl st. (24)
- 3. Ch 1. "Work 1 dc in the first st and work 1 FPdc around the post of the same st and the next st". Repeat "to" to the end of the round. End with a sl st. (36)
- **4.** Ch 1. "Work 1 dc in the first st, work 1 FPdc around the post of the first st and the next 2 sts". Repeat "to" to the end of the round. End with a sl st. (48)
- **5.** Ch 1. "Work 1 dc in the first st, work 1 FPdc around the post of the first st and the next 3 sts". Repeat "to" to the end of the round. End with a sl st. (60)
- **6.** Ch 1. "Work 1 dc in the first st, work 1 FPdc around the post of the first st and the next 14 sts". Repeat "to" to the end of the round. End with a sl st. (64)
- 7. Ch 1. Work FPdc around. End with a sl st. (64)

Repeat round 7 until your hat measures 26-27 cm.

Ch 1. Work sc around and end with a sl st. Cut the yarn and weave in ends.



Tutorial for the stitch pattern used in the hat



1. Make a mr. Ch 1 and work 12 dc into the ring. End with a sl st. (12)



2. Ch 1. "Work 1 dc in the first st.



3. Work 1 FPdc around the post of the same st". A FPdc is a raised front post double crochet which is worked from the front around the dc post of the previous round. The needle indicates how to work the dc from the front and around the post.



4. Like this.





5. "Work 1 dc in the next st.



6. Work 1 FPdc around the post of the same st".



7. Like this.



8. "Work 1 dc in the next st and work 1 FPdc around the post of the same st".



9. Repeat "to" to the end of the round. End with a sl st. (24)



10. Ch 1. "Work 1 dc in the first st.





11. Work 1 FPdc around the post of the same st.



12. Like this.



13. Work 1 FPdc around the next st".



14. Like this.



15. "Work 1 dc in the next st.



16. Work 1 FPdc around the post of the same st.





17. Like this.



18. Work 1 FPdc around the next st".



19. "Work 1 dc in the next st and work 1 FPdc around the post of the same st and the next st".



20. Repeat "to" to the end of the round. End with a sl st. (36)



21. Ch 1. "Work 1 dc in the first st.



22. Work 1 FPdc around the post of the first st.





23. Like this.



24. Work 1 FPdc around the next 2 sts".



25. "Work 1 dc in the next st, work 1 FPdc around the post of the first st and the next 2 sts".



26. Repeat "to" to the end of the round. End with a sl st. (48)



27. Repeat the increases as described in the pattern instructions.



28. Continue working rounds without increasing as stated in the pattern instructions.







29. Chain 1 and work sc around. End with a sl st.

 $30. \ \mbox{Cut}$ the yarn and weave in ends.
