



Siggy Tube

Materials

Hobbii Metallico color 3
Crochet hook 5

Gauge

Approx. 14 sts x 13 rows = 10 x 10 cm

Yarn usage approx. 200 g

Measurements

Approx. 65x32 cm.

Abbreviations

Ch: Chain

St(s): Stitch(es)

Sl st: Slip stitch

Hdc: Half double crochet

FPdc: Front post double crochet

Note:

Ch 1 at the beginning of each round - This does not count as a stitch, neither does it count towards the st total.

Finish all rounds with a sl st in the first stitch, not in the ch.

Pattern – Photo tutorial can be found following the written pattern

1. Chain 90. Join into a ring with 1 sl st. Ch 1. Slightly tilt your base chain. Now, work into the horizontal loops that appear. Work hdc around. End with a sl st. (90)
2. Ch 1. Work FPdc around. End with a sl st. (90)

Repeat round 2 until your tube measures approx. 31-32 cm.

Chain 1 and work hdc around. End with a sl st. (90) Cut the yarn and weave in ends.

Photo tutorial:**Round 1**

1. Chain 90. Join into a ring with 1 sl st.



2. Ch 1 and slightly tilt your base chain. Now, work in the horizontal loops.



3. Work 1 hdc in the first ch.



4. Work hdc around. End with a sl st. (90)

Round 2



5. Ch 1.



6. Work 1 FPdc around the first st. A FPdc is a double dc which is worked from the front around the post of the previous row. The needle indicates how to work the dc from the front and around the post.



7. Like this.



8. Work 1 FPdc around the next st.



9. Like this.



10. Work 1 FPdc around. End with a sl st.
(90)

Round 3



11. This round is a repetition of round 2. Ch 1. Work 1 FPdc around the first st.



12. Like this.



13. Work FPdc around. End with a sl st.
(90)

Round 4 and onwards



14. Repeat round 2 until your tube measures approx. 31-32 cm.

Last round



15. Ch 1. Work hdc around. End with a sl st. (90)



16. Cut the yarn and weave in ends.
