

## Havskum - Wrist Warmers

## Materials:

Hobbii Universe XL color 03
Crochet hook 4

## Gauge

Approx. 19 sts $\times 15$ rows $=10 \times 10 \mathrm{~cm}$

Yarn usage approx. 100 (115)g

Sizes: S/M (M/L)
Circumference: Approx. 18-20 (20-22) cm Length: Approx. 21.5 cm

## Abbreviations:

Ch: Chain
St(s): Stitch(es)
Sc: Single crochet
Hdc: Half double crochet
Fpdc: Front post double crochet
Bpdc: Back post double crochet

## Note:

Ch 1 at the beginning of each round - This does not count as a stitch, neither does it count towards the st total.
Finish all rounds with a sl st in the first stitch, not in the ch.
You may want to use a larger hook for the base chain to avoid a tight edge.

Pattern - Photo tutorial can be found following the written pattern

1. Ch 32 (34) and join into a ring with a sl st in the first ch. Ch 1 and slightly tilt your base chain. Work in the horizontal loops that appear. Work hdc around and end with a sl st. $=32$ (34)
2.     - $\mathbf{2 1}$ Ch 1. "Work 1 fpdc around the first st, work 1 bpdc around next st". Repeat "to" to the end of the round. End with a sl st. $=32(34)$
3. Ch 1. "Work 1 fpdc around the first st, work 1 bpdc around next st". Repeat "to" 7 (7) times in total. Work 1 fpdc around the next st.
Ch 3 and skip 3 sts. "Work 1 fpdc around the next st, work 1 bpdc around the following st". Repeat "to" 7 (8) times in total. End with a sl st. $=32$ (34)
4. Ch 1. "Work 1 fpdc around the first st, work 1 bpdc around next st". Repeat "to" 7 (7) times in total. Work 1 fpdc around the next st.
Work 1 hdc in the next 3 ch sts.
"Work 1 fpdc around the next st, work 1 bpdc around the following st". Repeat "to" 7 (8) times in total. End with a sl st. $=32$ (34)
5.     - 31. Ch 1. "Work 1 fpdc around the first st, work 1 bpdc around next st". Repeat "to" to the end of the round. End with a sl st. = 32 (34)
1. Ch 1. Work sc around and end with a sl st. $=32$ (34). Cut the yarn and weave in ends.

Make 1 more identical to this one.


## Round 1



1. Ch 32 (34) and join into a ring with a slip stitch in the first ch.

2. Work 1 hdc in the first st.

3. Ch 1 and slightly tilt your base chain. Now, work in the horizontal loops.

4. Work hdc around and end with a sl st. = 32 (34)

## Round 2


5. Ch 1. "Work 1 fpdc around the first st. The needle indicates how to work the fpdc from the front around the post of the stitch below.

7. Work 1 bpdc around the next st." The needle indicates how to work the bpdc from the back around the post of the stitch below.

9. "Work 1 fpdc around the next st

6. Like this. You have now made 1 fpdc.

8. Like this. You have now made 1 bpdc.

10. Work 1 bpdc around the following st".

11. "Work 1 fpdc around the first st, work 1 bpdc around next st".

## Round 3


13. This round is a repetition of round 2 .

Ch 1.

15. Like this.

12. Repeat "to" to the end of the round. End with a sl st. $=32(34)$

14. "Work 1 fpdc around the first st.

16. Work 1 bpdc around the next st".


Rounds 4-21
19. Ch 1. "Work 1 fpdc around the first st, work 1 bpdc around next st". Repeat "to" to the end of the round. End with a sl st. $=32$ (34)
18. Repeat "to" to the end of the round. End with a sl st. = 32 (34)



## Round 22


20. Ch 1. "Work 1 fpdc around the first st, work 1 bpdc around next st". Repeat "to" 7 (7) times in total.

22. Ch 3 and skip 3 sts.

21. Work 1 fpdc around the next st.

23. "Work 1 fpdc around the next st, work 1 bpdc around the following st". Repeat "to" 7 (8) times in total. End with a sl st. $=32$ (34)

## Round 23


24. Ch 1. "Work 1 fpdc around the first st, work 1 bpdc around next st". Repeat "to" 7 (7) times in total.

26. Work 1 hdc in the next 3 ch sts.

25. Work 1 fpdc around the next st.

27. "Work 1 fpdc around the next st, work 1 bpdc around the following st". Repeat "to" 7 (8) times in total. End with a sl st. $=32$ (34)

## Rounds 24-31


28. Ch 1 . "Work 1 fpdc around the first st, work 1 bpdc around next st". Repeat "to" to the end of the round. End with a sl st. $=32$ (34)

## Round 32


29. Ch 1.

30. Work sc around and end with a sl st. = 32 (34).

31. Cut the yarn and weave in ends.
