



Havskum - Wrist Warmers

Materials:

Hobbii Universe XL color 03

Crochet hook 4

Gauge

Approx.19 sts x 15 rows = $10 \times 10 \text{ cm}$

Yarn usage approx. 100 (115)g

Sizes: S/M (M/L)

Circumference: Approx. 18-20 (20-22) cm

Length: Approx. 21.5 cm

Abbreviations:

Ch: Chain

St(s): Stitch(es)
Sc: Single crochet

Hdc: Half double crochet

Fpdc: Front post double crochet **Bpdc:** Back post double crochet



Note:

Ch 1 at the beginning of each round - This does not count as a stitch, neither does it count towards the st total.

Finish all rounds with a sl st in the first stitch, not in the ch.

You may want to use a larger hook for the base chain to avoid a tight edge.

Pattern – Photo tutorial can be found following the written pattern

- 1. Ch 32 (34) and join into a ring with a sl st in the first ch. Ch 1 and slightly tilt your base chain. Work in the horizontal loops that appear. Work hdc around and end with a sl st. = 32 (34)
- 2. 21 Ch 1. "Work 1 fpdc around the first st, work 1 bpdc around next st". Repeat "to" to the end of the round. End with a sl st. = 32 (34)
- 22. Ch 1. "Work 1 fpdc around the first st, work 1 bpdc around next st". Repeat "to" 7 (7) times in total. Work 1 fpdc around the next st.Ch 3 and skip 3 sts. "Work 1 fpdc around the next st, work 1 bpdc around the following st". Repeat "to" 7 (8) times in total. End with a sl st. = 32 (34)
- **23.** Ch 1. "Work 1 fpdc around the first st, work 1 bpdc around next st". Repeat "to" 7 (7) times in total. Work 1 fpdc around the next st.

Work 1 hdc in the next 3 ch sts.

"Work 1 fpdc around the next st, work 1 bpdc around the following st". Repeat "to" 7 (8) times in total. End with a sl st. = 32 (34)

- **24. 31.** Ch 1. "Work 1 fpdc around the first st, work 1 bpdc around next st". Repeat "to" to the end of the round. End with a sl st. = 32 (34)
- **32.** Ch 1. Work sc around and end with a sl st. = 32 (34). Cut the yarn and weave in ends.

Make 1 more identical to this one.







1. Ch 32 (34) and join into a ring with a slip stitch in the first ch.



2. Ch 1 and slightly tilt your base chain. Now, work in the horizontal loops.



3. Work 1 hdc in the first st.



4. Work hdc around and end with a sl st. = 32 (34)





5. Ch 1. "Work 1 fpdc around the first st. The needle indicates how to work the fpdc from the front around the post of the stitch below.



6. Like this. You have now made 1 fpdc.



7. Work 1 bpdc around the next st." The needle indicates how to work the bpdc from the back around the post of the stitch below.



8. Like this. You have now made 1 bpdc.



9. "Work 1 fpdc around the next st



10. Work 1 bpdc around the following st".





11. "Work 1 fpdc around the first st, work 1 bpdc around next st".



12. Repeat "to" to the end of the round. End with a sl st. = 32 (34)



13. This round is a repetition of round 2. Ch 1.



14. "Work 1 fpdc around the first st.



15. Like this.



16. Work 1 bpdc around the next st".





17. Like this.



18. Repeat "to" to the end of the round. End with a sl st. = 32 (34)

Rounds 4 - 21



19. Ch 1. "Work 1 fpdc around the first st, work 1 bpdc around next st". Repeat "to" to the end of the round. End with a sl st. = 32 (34)





20. Ch 1. "Work 1 fpdc around the first st, work 1 bpdc around next st". Repeat "to" 7 (7) times in total.



21. Work 1 fpdc around the next st.



22. Ch 3 and skip 3 sts.



23. "Work 1 fpdc around the next st, work 1 bpdc around the following st". Repeat "to" 7 (8) times in total. End with a sl st. = 32 (34)





24. Ch 1. "Work 1 fpdc around the first st, work 1 bpdc around next st". Repeat "to" 7 (7) times in total.



25. Work 1 fpdc around the next st.



26. Work 1 hdc in the next 3 ch sts.



27. "Work 1 fpdc around the next st, work 1 bpdc around the following st". Repeat "to" 7(8) times in total. End with a sl st. = 32 (34)



Rounds 24-31



28. Ch 1. "Work 1 fpdc around the first st, work 1 bpdc around next st". Repeat "to" to the end of the round. End with a sl st. = 32 (34)



29. Ch 1.



30. Work sc around and end with a sl st. = 32 (34).





31. Cut the yarn and weave in ends.



32. Make 1 more identical to this one.
