## Materials

3 balls of Tweed Delight, color 13
1 ball of Tweed Delight, color 11
Uni-colored: 4 balls of Tweed Delight
Circular needles US 7 ( 4.5 mm ) and US 8 ( 5 mm ) / 31.5" (80 cm)
Circular needle US 6 ( 4 mm ) / 15.7" ( 40 cm ) Markers
Stitch holder

## Yarn properties

## (44) Tweed Delight, Hobbii

85\% Wool, 10\% Acrylic, 5\% Viscose/
$1.8 \mathrm{oz}(50 \mathrm{~g})=109 \mathrm{yds}(100 \mathrm{~m})$

## Gauge

25 sts x 27 rows $=4$ " ( 10 cm )
worked in pattern with needle US 8 ( 5 mm )

## Size

Onesize - adult

## Finished size

Width: 11" ( 28 cm )
Length: $13.8^{\prime \prime}(35 \mathrm{~cm})$

## About the pattern

The neck warmer is worked bottom up starting with the front piece, moving up towards the neck and down the back. The turtleneck is worked last.

## Elaborations

SE A = WS selvedges beginning:
Sl1p, p1, k1, p1.
SE $A=R S$ selvedges beginning:
SI1p, k1, p1, k1.

SE B = WS selvedges end:
P1, k1, p1, k1 tbl.
SE B = RS selvedges end:
$\mathrm{K} 1, \mathrm{p} 1, \mathrm{k} 1, \mathrm{k} 1 \mathrm{tbl}$.

NB! Be aware that the selvedges are worked differently (both in the beginning and the end of a row) depending on whether you are on the RS or the WS of the work.

## Pattern repeat

WS pattern: $k$ all sts.
RS pattern: *K1, p1*

## Pattern

## Front

Co 65 sts on circular needle US $7(4.5 \mathrm{~mm}) / 31.5^{\prime \prime}(80 \mathrm{~cm})$ with color 1 and work in the flat. Work 4 rows in rib like this:
WS: SE A, ${ }^{*} \mathrm{p} 1, \mathrm{k} 1^{*}$ until 5 sts remain, p1, SE B.
RS: SE A, *p1, k1* until 5 sts remain, p1, SE B.

Change to circular needle US 8 ( 5 mm ).
Row 1, WS: SE A, WS pattern, SE B.
Row 2, RS: SE A, $k$ the bar between the sts tbl, RS pattern until 4 sts remain, $k$ the bar between the sts tbl, SE B = 2 incs.
Work rows 1 and 2 a total of 3 times $=6$ incs $=71$ sts.
Continue working the pattern repeat, until the work measures 11" (28 cm). End with a WS row.

Place the 23 middle sts on a stitch holder.

## Left shoulder

24 sts are worked.
Row 1, RS: SE A, RS pattern until 6 sts remain, k2tog, SE B.
Turn.
Row 2, WS: SE A, WS pattern until 4 sts remain, SE B.
Work rows 1 and 2 a total of 8 times $=8$ decs $=16$ sts.
Work 11 rows in pattern repeat.

## Neck

Row 1, WS: SE A, $k$ the bar between the sts tbl, WS pattern until
4 sts remain, $\mathbf{S E} \mathbf{B}=1 \mathrm{inc}$ (at the neck).

Row 2, RS: SE A, RS pattern until 4 sts remain, SE B.
Work rows 1 and 2 a total of 3 times $=3$ incs $=19$ sts.

Place the sts on a stitch holder.

## Right shoulder

24 sts are worked.
Row 1, RS: SE A, k2tog tbl, RS pattern until 4 sts remain, SE B.
Row 2, WS: SE A, WS pattern until 4 sts remain, SE B.
Work rows 1 and 2 a total of 8 times $=8$ decs $=16$ sts.
Work 11 rows in pattern repeat.

## Neck

Row 1, WS: SE A, WS pattern until 4 sts remain, $k$ the bar between the sts tbl, SE B = 1 inc (at the neck).
Row 2, RS: SE A, RS pattern until 4 sts remain, SE B.
Work rows 1 and 2 a total of 3 times $=3$ incs $=19$ sts.

## Back

Start at the right shoulder.
Row 1, WS: SE A, work 19 sts in WS pattern, co 33 sts (knitted cast on), work the sts from the left shoulder until 4 sts remain, $\mathbf{S E} \mathbf{B}=71$ sts.

Continue working the pattern repeat, until the back measures $10.2^{\prime \prime}(26 \mathrm{~cm})$.
Row 1, WS: SE A, WS pattern until 4 sts remain, SE B.
Row 2, RS: SE A, k2tog, RS pattern until 6 sts remain, k2tog, SE B.
Work rows 1 and 2 a total of 3 times $=6$ decs $=65$ sts.
Work 4 rows in rib like this:
WS: SE A, ${ }^{*} \mathrm{p} 1, \mathrm{k} 1^{*}$ until 4 sts remain, SE B.
RS: SE A, ${ }^{*} 1$ 1, k1* until 4 sts remain, SE B.
Bo.

## Turtleneck

Pick up 84 sts along the neckline with color 2 using circular needle US $7(4.5 \mathrm{~mm}) / 15.7$ " $(40 \mathrm{~cm})$. Begin at the left shoulder.
Work rib in the round like this: *K1, p 1 *
Work 5.5 " $(14 \mathrm{~cm})$ in rib.
Change to color 1 .
Work 0.4 " ( 1 cm ) in rib.
Change to color 2.
Work $0.4 "(1 \mathrm{~cm})$ in rib.
Bind off loosely in rib.
