



# Abigail - Sweater

No. 2004-211-2933

## Materials

5 (6) 6 (7) skeins of Mohair Delight,  
color 13

Needles US 4 (3.5 mm) and 6 (4 mm)  
Circular needle 14.7" / US 4 (40 cm / 3.5 mm)  
Cable knitting needle

## Yarn

**Mohair Delight**, Hobbii  
50% Mohair, 50% Acrylic  
1.8 oz (50 g) = 164 yds (150 meter)  
18 sts x 24 rows = 3.9" (10 cm) of stockinette on  
needle size US 6 (4 mm)

## Knitting gauge

18 stitches and 24 rows on 4 inches (10 cm) in  
stockinette stitch

## Sizes

S (M) L (XL)

## Measurements

**Width:** 17.7 (19.2) 20.5 (22) inches  
/ 45 (49) 52 (56) cm

**Length:** 21.65 (21.65) 21.65 (21.65)  
inches  
/ 55 (55) 55 (55) cm

## Pattern information

The sweater is knitted down-up. The  
back, the front and the sleeves are  
knitted separately, back and forth on  
jumper knitting needles.

The shoulders are sewn together and  
lastly the sleeves are attached.  
Cables are knitted on the front.

When only one measurement is  
stated, it's the same for all sizes.

## Back

### Rib edge

CO 80 (88) 94 (100) stitches on needle size US 4 (3.5 mm) and knit rib according to size.

The first row is the wrong side.

**Size S:** purl 2, knit 4, (purl 4, knit 4) 9 times, purl 2.

**Size M:** purl 2, knit 4, (purl 4, knit 4) 10 times, purl 2.

**Size L:** knit 5, (purl 4, knit 4) 11 times, knit 1.

**Size XL:** knit 4, (purl 4, knit 4) 12 times.

**All sizes:** knit until the rib measures 2.4 inches (6 cm). End with the wrong side.

## Body

Change to needle size US 6 (4 mm). Continue in stockinette stitch until your work measures 20.9 inches (53 cm).

Cast off.

**NB.** The back is shorter than the front. Back and front are sewn together 0.8" (2 cm) down on the back.

## Front

### Rib edge

CO 86 (94) 100 (108) stitches on needle size US 4 (3.5 mm) and knit rib according to size.

The first row is the wrong side.

**Size S:** purl 2, knit 4, (purl 4, knit 4) twice, purl 10, (knit 6, purl 10) twice, (knit 4, purl 4) twice, knit 4, purl 2.

**Size M:** knit 2 (purl 4, knit 4) 3 times, purl 10 (knit 6, purl 10) twice, (knit 4, purl 4) 3 times, knit 2.

**Size L:** knit 5 (purl 4, knit 4) 3 times, purl 10, (knit 6, purl 10) twice, (knit 4, purl 4) 3 times, knit 5.

**Size XL:** purl 1, (purl 4, knit 4) 4 times, purl 10, (knit 6, purl 10) twice, (knit 4, purl 4) 4 times, purl 1.

**All sizes:** Knit 4 rows according to the stitches.

**Row 6, right:** knit cables over the 10 stitches as follows:

Put 5 stitches on a cable needle in front of your work, knit 5, knit the 5 stitches from the cable needle = 3 cables.

Then you knit cables every 10th row.

Knit as the stitches show until the rib measures 2.4 inches (6 cm). Finish with a row purl stitches.

## Body

Change to needle size US 6 (4 mm).. Continue in stockinette stitch in the sides and cables in the middle.

1. Rnd, right side: knit 18 (22) 25 (29), p4, k10, (p6, k10) 2 times, p4, knit 18 (22) 25 (29).
2. Rn, wrong side: Knit as the stitches show.

Repeat these two rnds and remember the cables every 10th rnd. Work even until the project measures approximately 19" (48 cm). Measure the height while the project is pulled slightly widthwise. Finish with a rnd of purl stitches after a cable.

## Neckline

### Left side

1st row, right side: knit 34 (38) 41 (45) stitches, turn.

2nd row, wrong side: cast off 5 stitches, knit the rest of the row.

3rd row: knit as the stitches show.

4th row: cast off 4 stitches, knit the rest of the row.

5th row: knit as the stitches show.

Hereafter, you cast off 2 x 2 stitches and 1 x 1 stitch in the neck side on every 2nd row = 20 (24) 27 (31) stitches to the shoulder. Knit straight up until your work measures 21.65 inches (55 cm). Mark the side of the sleeve = shoulder.

Do not fasten off, continue with the neck.

## Neck

**Left side** with the increases in the neck.

Knit into the stitch from the front and the back in the neck side on the right side rows 3 times = 23 (27) 30 (34) stitches.

Cast off.

### Right side

Place the 18 middle stitches on a stitch holder. Join yarn and knit as the stitches show.

Finish this side as the left side.

## Sleeves

### Rib edge

CO 40 (40) 44 (44) stitches on size US 4 (3.5 mm) and knit rib according to size.

The first row is the wrong side.

**Sizes S and M:** purl 2, knit 4, (purl 4, knit 4) 4 times, purl 2.

**Sizes L and XL:** purl 4, (knit 4, purl 4) 5 times.

**All sizes:** Knit until the rib measures 2.4 inches (6 cm). End with the wrong side.

### Start increases

Change to needle size US 6 (4 mm). End with a right side (RS) row

Continue in stockinette stitch while increasing with 1 stitch on each side every 8th row until you have 64 (66) 68 (70) stitches. Knit straight up until your work measures 18.9 inches (48 cm). End with a right side (RS) row.

### **Sleeve cap**

The cap is shaped by using German Short Rows.

Knit until you have 5 stitches left on the needle, turn with a turning stitch, knit until you have 5 stitches left on the needle, turn with a turning stitch, \*knit until you are 5 stitches from the turning stitch, turn with a turning stitch\*, repeat \*to\* 3 more times. Finish the row by knitting the turning stitches together into 1 stitch.

Cast off by knitting the turning stitches together into 1 stitch. Place a marker in the middle of the bind off of the sleeve.

### **Assembly**

Sew the back and front piece together.

Attach the sleeves so the markers at the shoulders fit.

Sew the sleeve seams and the side seams together.

### **Neck edge**

Pick up approximately 102 stitches in the neckline on circular needle size US 4 (3.5 mm).

On the next round, 2 x 2 stitches are k tog in each cable while knitting rib: k2, p2 = 96 stitches (divisible by 4).

Knit until the edge measures 0.8" (2 cm).

BO loosely in rib.
