**Skill level:** Beginner **Crochet hook:** 2.50 mm

Measurements: Approx. 37 cm (14.5

inches)

**Materials:** A small piece of black scrap yarn for the eyebrows, 2 safety eyes 6

mm, stuffing

Yarn: Friends Cotton 8/4
Ash Brown (08) - 2 skeins
Oatmilk (03) - 1 skein
Silver (118) - 1 skein
Icy Blue (76) - 1 skein

# **Abbreviations:**

ch = chain

sc = single crochet sl st = slip stitch mr = magic ring

hdc = half double crochet

hdc inc = increase in half double crochets

inc = increase
dec = decrease
rnd = round(s)

(xx) = Number of stitches after ended

round



## Info and tips:

Always stuff the head and body firmly.

Always stuff between head and body as you sew the head on to avoid a wobbly head.

Work tightly to avoid holes between the stitches.

All pieces are worked in the round

# **Body**

In Ash Brown

Rnd 1: 6 sc in a mr

Rnd 2: (inc) 6 times (12)

Rnd 3: (1 sc, inc) 6 times (18)

Rnd 4: (2 sc, inc) 6 times (24)

Rnd 5: (3 sc, inc) 6 times (30)

Rnd 6: (4 sc, inc) 6 times (36)

Rnd 7: (5 sc, inc) 6 times (42)

Rnd 8: (6 sc, inc) 6 times (48)

Rnd 9: (7 sc, inc) 6 times (54)

Rnd 10: (8 sc, inc) 6 times (60)

Rnd 11: (9 sc, inc) 6 times (66)

Rnds 12-20: 1 sc in each st (66)

Rnd 21: (9 sc, dec) 6 times (60)

Rnds 22-25: 1 sc in each st (60)

Rnd 26: (8 sc, dec) 6 times (54)

Rnds 27-30: 1 sc in each st (54)

Rnd 31: (7 sc, dec) 6 times (48)

Rnds 32-34: 1 sc in each st (48)

Rnd 35: (6 sc, dec) 6 times (42)

Rnds 36-39: 1 sc in each st (42)

Rnd 40: (5 sc, dec) 6 times (36)

Rnds 41-43: 1 sc in each st (36)

Rnd 44: (4 sc, dec) 6 times (30)

Rnds 45-47: 1 sc in each st (30)

Rnd 48: (3 sc, dec) 6 times (24)

Rnd 49: 1 sc in each st (24)

Fasten off and leave a tail long enough for sewing.

#### Head

In Oatmilk

Rnd 1: 6 sc in a mr

Rnd 2: (inc) 6 times (12)

Rnd 3: (1 sc, inc) 6 times (18)

Rnd 4: (2 sc, inc) 6 times (24)

Rnd 5: (3 sc, inc) 6 times (30)

Rnd 6: (4 sc, inc) 6 times (36)

Rnd 7: (5 sc, inc) 6 times (42)

Rnd 8: (6 sc, inc) 6 times (48)



Rnds 9-14: 1 sc in each st (48)

Change to Ash Brown.

Rnd 15: (hdc inc) 6 times, (6 sc, inc) 6 times (60)

Rnd 16: (1 hdc, hdc inc) 6 times, 48 sc (66)

Rnd 17: 1 sc in each st (66)

Now, insert the safety eyes between rounds 14 and 15 right at the color change, below the half double crochets in the 2nd and 5th hdc increase with 4 hdc in between.



Rnds 18-23: 1 sc in each st

Remember to stuff the head as you work.

Rnd 24: (9 sc, dec) 6 times (60)

Rnd 25: (8 sc, dec) 6 times (54)

Rnd 26: (7 sc, dec) 6 times (48)

Rnd 27: (6 sc, dec) 6 times (42)

Rnd 28: 1 sc in each st (42)

Rnd 29: (5 sc, dec) 6 times (36)

Rnd 30: (4 sc, dec) 6 times (30)

Rnd 31: (3 sc, dec) 6 times (24)

Rnd 32: (2 sc, dec) 6 times (18)

Rnd 33: (1 sc, dec) 6 times (12)

Rnd 34: (2 sc, dec) 3 times (9)

Fasten off and leave a tail long enough for closing the hole. Use a needle to gather the last 9 stitches in the front loop and tighten the yarn to close the hole nicely. Weave in ends.

#### Ear

In Ash Brown, make 2

Rnd 1: 6 sc in a mr

Rnd 2: (inc) 6 times (12)

Rnd 3: (1 sc, inc) 6 times (18)

Rnd 4: (2 sc, inc) 6 times (24)

Rnd 5: (3 sc, inc) 6 times (30)

Rnd 6: (4 sc, inc) 6 times (36)

Rnd 7: (5 sc, inc) 6 times (42)

Rnds 8-16: 1 sc in each st (42)



Rnd 17: (5 sc, dec) 6 times (36)

Rnds 18-22: 1 sc in each st (36)

Rnd 23: (10 sc, dec) 3 times (33)

Rnds 24-26: 1 sc in each st (33)

Rnd 27: (9 sc, dec) 3 times (30)

Rnds 28-30: 1 sc in each st (30)

Rnd 31: (8 sc, dec) 3 times (27)

Rnds 32-34: 1 sc in each st (27)

Rnd 35: (7 sc, dec) 3 times (24)

Rnds 36-37: 1 sc in each st (24)

Rnd 38: (6 sc, dec) 3 times (21)

Rnds 39-40: 1 sc in each st (21)

Rnd 41: (5 sc, dec) 3 times (18)

Rnds 42-43: 1 sc in each st (18)

Rnd 44: (4 sc, dec) 3 times (15)

Rnd 45: 1 sc in each st (15)

Fasten off and leave a tail long enough for sewing.

#### Arm

In Oatmilk, make 2

Rnd 1: 6 sc in a mr

Rnd 2: (inc) 6 times (12)

Rnd 3: (3 sc, inc) 3 times (15)

Rnds 4-6: 1 sc in each st (15)

Stuff the arm lightly with stuffing as you work but only halfway up.

Change to Ash Brown.

Rnds 7-35: 1 sc in each st (15)

Fasten off and leave a tail long enough for sewing.

# Leg

In Oatmilk, make 2

Rnd 1: 6 sc in a mr

Rnd 2: (inc) 6 times (12)

Rnd 3: (1 sc, inc) 6 times (18)

Rnd 4: (2 sc, inc) 6 times (24)

Rnd 5: (3 sc, inc) 6 times (30)

Rnds 6-7: 1 sc in each st (30)

Change to Ash Brown.

Rnds 8-9: 1 sc in each st (30)

Rnd 10: (3 sc, dec) 6 times (24)

Rnd 11: 1 sc in each st (24)

Rnd 12: (2 sc, dec) 6 times (18)

Rnd 13: 1 sc in each st (18)

Rnd 14: (4 sc, dec) 3 times (15)

Stuff the foot firmly with stuffing. Stuff the rest of the leg only lightly.

Rnds 15-46: 1 sc in each st (15)



Fasten off and leave a tail long enough for sewing.

# Snout

In Ash Brown

Rnd 1: 6 sc in a mr

Rnd 2: (inc) 6 times (12)

Rnd 3: (1 sc, inc) 6 times (18)

Rnd 4: (2 sc, inc) 6 times (24)

Rnd 5: (3 sc, inc) 6 times (30)

Rnds 6-8: 1 sc in each st, 1 sl st (30)

Fasten off and leave a tail long enough for sewing.

# **Sweatshirt**

In Icy Blue

Rnd 1: Ch 33, join into a ring with 1 sl st in the first ch

Rnds 2-3: 1 sc in each st (32)

Rnd 4: (7 sc, inc) 4 times (36)

Rnd 5: (5 sc, inc) 6 times (42)

Rnd 6: 4 sc, inc, ch 10, skip 9 sts, 4 sc, inc, 4 sc, inc, ch 10, skip 9 sts, 4 sc, inc, 4 sc (48)

(the chain arches are for the sleeves)

Rnd 7: 6 sc, 12 sc around the chains (you have to crochet around the chain, not into the

actual chain), 5~sc, inc, 6~sc, 12~sc around the chains, 5~sc, inc, 4~sc (54)

Rnd 8: 1 sc in each st (54)

Change to Silver.

Rnds 9-10: 1 sc in each st (54)

Change to Icy Blue

Rnds 11-12: 1 sc in each st (54)

Change to Silver.

Rnds 13-14: 1 sc in each st (54)

Change to Icy Blue

Rnd 15: (8 sc, inc) 6 times (60)

Rnd 16: 1 sc in each st (60)

Change to Silver.

Rnds 17-18: 1 sc in each st (60)

Change to Icy Blue

Rnd 19: (9 sc, inc) 6 times (66)

Rnd 20: 1 sc in each st (66)

Change to Silver.

Rnds 21-23: 1 sc in each st (66)

Fasten off.

# Tail

In Oatmilk

Rnd 1: 5 sc in a mr Rnd 2: inc, 4 sc (6)



Rnd 3: inc, 5 sc (7)

Rnd 4: inc, 6 sc (8)

Rnd 5: inc, 7 sc (9)

Rnd 6: inc, 8 sc (10)

Rnd 7: inc, 9 sc (11)

Rnd 8: inc, 10 sc (12)

Rnd 9: (3 sc, inc) 3 times (15)

Rnds 10-11: 1 sc in each st (15)

Rnd 12: (3 sc, dec) 3 times (12)

Rnd 13: (2 sc, dec) 3 times (9)

Stuff the tip with stuffing.

Rnds 14-43: 1 sc in each st (9)

Fasten off and leave a tail long enough for sewing.

# **Assembling**

- · Stuff body and head firmly with stuffing.
- · Pull the sweatshirt down over the body.
- · Insert the arms into the armhole and sew them on the 2nd round from the top of the body.
- · Sew the head onto the body making sure to place the edge of the front side of the body at the color change between muzzle and head, see picture below.
- · Sew the ears onto the head from rnd 20-25 with 10 sc in between.
- · Stuff the snout and sew it onto the head from rnd 1-9.
- · Embroider the eyebrows diagonally on the head just above the eyes, see picture below.
- · Sew the legs onto the body on rnds 5-10.
- · Sew the tail on in the middle of the backside.
