



Ombre Net Bag for Yoga Mat

No. 1001-212-6983

Materials:

Rainbow Cotton 8/4 - The bag is crocheted holding two strands of yarn together
Crochet hook 4 mm (US size G/6)

Yarn usage approx.

Color A: 35g
Color B: 30g
Color C: 30g
Color D: 30g
Color E: 30g

Size: Fits the size of a standard yoga mat 180x60 cm - 3-5 mm of thickness

Abbreviations

Mr: Magic ring
Ch: Chain
St(s): Stitch(es)
Sc: Single crochet
Hdc: Half double crochet
Sl st(s): Slip stitch(es)

Note:

When crocheting the base, ch 1 at the beginning of each round - This does not count as a stitch, neither does it count towards the st total.

Finish each round with a sl st in the first st.

You may try it on your mat as you work.

The bag is worked holding two strands of yarn together.

It's a good idea to weave in ends as you work.

The ombre effect is achieved by changing colors continuously throughout the pattern in the following way:

Begin with color A and work 12 rounds.

Change one strand to color B so you are now working with colors A and B. Work 4 rounds.

Change so you are now working only with color B. Work 10 rounds.

Change one strand to color C so you are now working with colors B and C. Work 4 rounds.

Change so you are now working only with color C. Work 9 rounds.

Change one strand to color D so you are now working with colors C and D. Work 4 rounds.

Change so you are now working only with color D. Work 9 rounds.

Change one strand to color E so you are now working with colors D and E. Work 4 rounds.

Change so you are now working only with color E. Work 9 rounds.

Pattern

1. Make 1 mr and ch 1. Work 10 hdc into the ring. Finish with a sl st. (10)
2. Ch 1. Work 2 hdc in each st. Finish with a sl st. (20)
3. Ch 1. "Work 1 hdc in the first st, 2 hdc in the next st". Repeat "to" to the end of the round and finish with a sl st. (30)
4. "Ch 5, skip 1 st and work 1 sc in the next st". Repeat "to" to the end of the round. Finish with a sl st. (15 ch spaces)
5. Work 3 sl sts up along the first ch space to begin in the middle of the space. "Ch 5, work 1 sc into the next ch space" Repeat "to" to the end of the round. To end the round, work 1 sc in the first ch space made in this same round. (15 ch spaces)
6. - 64. "Ch 5, work 1 sc into the next ch space" Repeat "to" to the end of the round. (15 ch spaces)

- 65.** Work 2 sc into the ch space into which you worked the last sc of the previous round. "Work 1 sc in the next st, work 3 sc into the following ch space". Repeat "to" to the end of the round. Finish with a sl st. Cut the yarn and weave in ends.

Pattern tutorial:

Round 1



1. Make 1 mr and ch 1.



2. Work 10 hdc into the ring. Finish with a sl st. (10)

Round 2



3. Ch 1. Work 2 hdc in each st. Finish with a sl st. (20)

Round 3



4. Ch 1. "Work 1 hdc in the first st, 2 hdc in the next st". Repeat "to" to the end of the round and finish with a sl st. (30)

Round 4



5. "Ch 5."



6. Skip 1 st and work 1 sc in the next st".



7. Like this.



8. "Ch 5."



9. Skip 1 st and work 1 sc in the next st".



10. Like this.



11. "Ch 5, skip 1 st and work 1 sc in the next st". Repeat "to" to the end of the round.



12. Finish with a sl st.



13. Like this. (15 ch spaces)

Round 5



14. Work 3 sl sts up along the first ch space to begin in the middle of the space.



15. Like this.



16. "Ch 5, work 1 sc into the next ch space"



17. Like this.



18. "Ch 5, work 1 sc into the next ch space"



19. Like this.



20. Repeat "to" to the end of the round.



20. To end the round, work 1 sc into the first ch space made in this same round.



21. Like this. (15 ch spaces)

Round 6



22. "Ch 5, work 1 sc into the next ch space"



23. Like this.



24. Repeat "to" to the end of the round. (15 ch spaces)

Rounds 7-64



26. Repeat row 6 until you have a total of 64 rounds.

Round 65



27. Work 2 sc into the ch space into which you worked the last sc of the previous round.



28. "Work 1 sc in the next st.



29. Work 3 sc into the following ch space”.



30. “Work 1 sc in the next st, work 3 sc into the following ch space”.



31. Repeat “to” to the end of the round.
Finish with a sl st.



32. Cut the yarn and weave in ends.

Tie-string:

Using color A. Ch 100. Tilt your base chain to make the back vertical loops appear.
Work 1 sl st in the 2nd loop from the hook. Work sl sts in all loops to the end of the row. Cut the yarn and weave in ends.

Insert the string into the spaces on rounds 61-62.



1. Ch 100.



2. Tilt your base ch to make the back vertical loops appear.
Work 1 sl st in the 2nd loop from the hook.



3. Like this.




4. Work sl sts in all loops to the end of the row.



5. Cut the yarn and weave in ends.



6. Insert the string into the spaces on rounds 61-62.



7. Like this.

Handle:

The ombre effect of the handle is made in the following way:

14 rows with color A

14 rows with color B

14 rows with color C


14 rows with color D

14 rows with color E

1. Ch 7. Work 1 hdc in the 3rd ch from the hook. Work 1 hdc in each ch to the end of the row. (5)
2. - 70. Ch 1 and turn. Work hdc to the end of the row. (5) Cut the yarn but leave a long tail for assembling.

Sew one end of the handle on across a ch space on round 7. Sew the other end of the handle on across a ch space on round 58.
