



Liffey - Women's socks

Materials

1 (1, 1) ball of Magic Sock Wool, col 21

Double pointed needles US 1.5 / 2.5 mm and US 2.5 / 3 mm Stitch markers

Yarn quality

Magic Sock Wool, Happy Sheep 70 % Superwash Wool, 30 % Polyamide / 3.5 oz / 100 g = 437 yds / 400 m

Gauge

28 sts and 40 rnds = 4" / 10 cm in stockinette stitch with needle US 2.5 / 3 mm.

Sizes

Shoe size: US: 6/6.5 (7.5/8) 9.5/10 / EU: 36/37 (38/39) 40/41

Foot length: approx 9.4" (10.2") 11" / 24 (26) 28

About the pattern

The socks have a long leg which can be folded down.

Due to the long color runs of the yarn, the socks will not be identical.

NB! The socks can also be worked on a circular needle with the Magic Loop technique.

Leg

Loosely co 56 (60) 64 sts on US needle size 1.5 (2.5 mm) and distribute them on 4 double pointed needles.

Work rib in the round like this: *K2, p2* until the leg measures 9.4" / 24 cm. Switch to US needle size 2.5 (3 mm)

Preparing for the heel

Work until you have 28 (30) 32 sts on the first double pointed needle.

The sts on top of the foot/instep are put on hold on 2 double needles.

Heel

Work the 28 (30) 32 heel sts in stockinette stitch in the flat. Work 20 (20) 22 rows. The heel flap now measures approx 2.2" (2.2") 2.4" / 5.5 (5.5) 6 cm. End with a WS row.

NB! Place a marker midway on the heel after 14 (15) 16 sts. Take measurements for the foot before the toe from here.

Heel decreases

Row 1 (RS): Work until 8 (9) 9 sts remain, k2tog tbl,

k1, turn.

Row 2 (WS): Work until 8 (9) 9 sts remain, p2tog,

p1, turn.

Row 3: Work until 7 (8) 8 sts remain, k2tog tbl, k1, turn.

Row 4: Work until 7 (8) 8 sts remain, p2tog, p1, turn.

Continue like this with 1 st less before the decrease, until all sts on the needle are worked. Continue in stockinette stitch. On the next rnd, pick up approx 14 (15) 16 sts on each side of the heel flap.

Distribute the heel sts on 2 needles.

Gusset

Continue working in stockinette stitch in the round.

Place a marker on each side at the transition from heel flap to instep.

Gusset decreases

Work until 2 sts before the marker, k2tog, work the instep sts until the second marker, k2tog sts tbl, work the remaining sts.

Work 1 rnd.

Decrease on every other rnd, until 56 (60) 64 sts remain.

Foot

Work until the work measures approx 7.5" (8.1") 8.7" / 19 (20.5) 22 cm measured from the marker on the heel. (The toe measures approx 2" (2.2") 2.4" / 5 (5.5) 6 cm).

Toe



Place 1 marker on each side so that you have 28 (30) 32 sts for instep and sole, respectively.

Work until the marker.

Decreases

Rnd 1: 1st and 2nd double pointed needle: k1, k2tog tbl, work until 3 sts before the marker, k2tog, k1.

3rd and 4th double pointed needle: k1, k2tog tbl, work until 3 sts before the marker, k2tog, k1.

Rnd 2: k all sts.

Repeat rnds 1-2, until 20 (20) 20 sts remain.

Bo all sts.

Sew the hole together with Kitchener Stitch.

Same procedure for the other sock.
