# Monika

**Sweater**

# **MATERIALS**

1 (2) 2 skein(s) of Manaya col 07 4 (5) 6 skeins of Mohair delight col 13

Circular needle US 13 (9 mm), 31.5" (80 cm) Jumper needles and double pointed needles US 13 (9 mm)

# **YARN QUALITY**

Manaya, Hobbii
65 % Superwash Wool, 35 % Acrylic /
7.1 oz (200 g) = 558 yds (510 m)
Mohair Delight, Hobbii
50 % Mohair, 50 % Acrylic /
1.8 oz (50 g) = 164 yds (150 m)

#### **GAUGE**

with 1 thread of each yarn quality on needle US 13 (9 mm) 12 sts x 16 rounds = 4" (10 cm)

# SIZE

S (M) L

#### **MEASUREMENTS**

Width: 21.7" (23.6") 25.6" / 55 (60) 65 cm Length: 19.3" (19.7") 20.1" / 49 (50) 51 cm

# PATTERN INFORMATION

The sweater is worked bottom up with 1 thread of each yarn quality = 2 threads. Armholes and neckline are bound off. The shoulders are stitched together and stitches are picked up in the armhole. The sleeves are worked top down.

# **Pattern**







#### **ELABORATION**

Increasing 1 stitch (inc1): Pick up the bar between the stitches and knit it through the back loop.

# **BODY**

# Rib edge

Co 122 (132) 144 sts on circular needle US 13 (9 mm), 31.5" (80 cm) and work 10 rnds in rib like this: k1, p1.

# **SWEATER**

#### **Rnd with incs**

Inc 1 (0) 1, \*k11, inc1\*, repeat from \* to \* throughout the rnd = 132 (144) 156 sts.

Work in st st in the round, until the work measures 11.8" / 30 cm.

Place a marker on each side = side seams = 66 (72) 78 sts for the back piece and front piece respectively.

Now the work is divided into armholes. Put the sts of the front piece on hold on the circular needle and work the back piece on jumper needles.

#### **BACK PIECE**

Work in st st in the flat on jumper needles.

Work even until the armhole measures 7.5" (7.9") 8.3" / 19 (20) 21 cm. End with a WS row.

# Right shoulder (when wearing the sweater)

Shape the shoulder with short rows:

K 27 (30) 33 sts, turn, work 1 turn st,

\*p until 7 sts remain at the shoulder, turn,

work 1 turn st, k until 3 sts remain at the neckline, turn,

work 1 turn st, p until 15 sts remain at the shoulder, turn,

work 1 turn st, k until 6 sts remain at the neckline, turn,



work 1 turn st, p the remaining sts (work the turn sts as 1 st), turn,

bo these 27 (30) 33 sts (work the turn sts as 1 st)\*.

Count 21 (24) 27 sts in from each side and place a marker. These sts are for the shoulder.

The 6 sts are for the neck.

#### Neck

Bo 12 sts and work the rest of the row.

#### Left shoulder

Follow the same procedure as for the right shoulder from \* to \*.

Count 21 (24) 27 sts in from each side and place a marker. These sts are for the shoulder.

The 6 sts are for the neck.

# **FRONT PIECE**

Work even in st st, until the armhole measures 3.9" / 10 cm. End with a WS row.

K 25 (28) 31 sts, bo 16 sts for the neck, k the rest of the row.

The right-hand and left-hand side of the front piece are now worked separately.

# Right-hand side of the front piece (when wearing the sweater)

Dec at the neck like this:

Row 1: p all sts

Row 2: k2tog tbl, k the rest of the row.

Repeat these 2 rows, until 4 decs have been worked = 21 (24) 27 sts remain for the shoulder.

Work even until the armhole measures 7.5" (7.9") 8.3" / 19 (20) 21 cm. End with a WS row.

# Left-hand side of the front piece (when wearing the sweater)

Dec at the neck like this:

Row 1: p all sts

Row 2: k until 2 sts remain, k2tog.

Repeat these 2 rows, until 4 decs have been worked = 21 (24) 27 sts.

Work even until the armhole measures 7.5'' (7.9'') 8.3'' / 19 (20) 21 cm. End with a WS row. Bo.

Sew the shoulder seams together.

# SLEEVES (WORKED TOP-DOWN)

Pick up approx 46 (48) 50 sts in the armhole on double pointed needles. The sts on the first rnd are k tbl. Place a marker at the beg of the rnd.

Work in st st while dec 1 st on each side of the marker with a margin of 2 sts.

Dec every 2" / 5 cm. Work even until the work measures 15.7" / 40 cm.

On the next rnd, decrease 6 sts evenly.

Bo.

Same procedure for the second sleeve.



# **NECKLINE**

Pick up sts along the neckline from the RS. Bo knitwise.
