



# Madeline - Jumper

## Materials

1 (1) 1 (1) ball of Twister, color 01

Circular needle US 1.5 / 2.5 mm, 31.5" / 80 cm  
Crochet hook size B/1 (if relevant)

## Yarn quality

 **Twister**, Hobbii

55 % Cotton, 45 % Acrylic /  
8.8 oz / 250 g = 1094 yds / 1000 m

## Gauge

26 sts x 38 rnds  
in stockinette stitch = 4" / 10 cm

## Sizes

XS (S) M (L)

## Measurements

Width: 15.7" (16.5") 17.7" (19.3") /  
40 (42) 45 (49) cm

Length, measured midway on the  
back:

20.9" (21.3") 22" (22.4") / 53 (54) 56  
(57) cm

## About the pattern

The jumper is worked top down with  
increases on the yoke. Knit on a  
31,5" (80 cm) circular needle using a  
magic loop.

Stitches are bound off the for  
sleeves, after which you work even  
with "stripes" in stockinette stitch  
and garter stitch.

## Pattern

**NB** Begin with the lightest color.

Save some yarn in the light color in order to work single crochet along the neckline as well as some yarn in a darker color in order to work single crochet along the armholes.

## Neckline

Co 120 (120) 132 (132) sts and work in the round on the circular needle.

K 1 rnd, p 1 rnd, k 1 rnd.

Place a marker for every 10th (10th) 11th (11th) st = 12 markers.

## Yoke

The yoke is worked in garter stitch with increases in stockinette stitch.

### Begin increasing

**Rnd 1:** \*P 10 (10) 11 (11) sts, yo\*, repeat from \* to \* throughout the rnd.

**Rnd 2:** K all sts and yos = 12 incs = 132 (132) 144 (144) sts.

**Rnd 3:** \*P 10 (10) 11 (11) sts, k1\*, repeat from \* to \* throughout the rnd.

**Rnd 4:** K all sts.

**Rnd 5:** \*P 10 (10) 11 (11) sts, yo, k1\*, repeat from \* to \* throughout the rnd.

**Rnd 6:** K all sts and yos = 12 incs.

**Rnd 7:** \*P 10 (10) 11 (11) sts, k2\*, repeat from \* to \* throughout the rnd.

**Rnd 8:** K all sts.

Repeat rnds 5-8 with 1 additional st after the yo = incs on every

4th rnd = 12 incs per rnd with incs.

Increase until you have 10 (10) 11 (11) sts of garter stitch and 18 (19) 20 (22) sts of stockinette stitch = 336 (348) 372 (396) sts.

## Sleeves

Work until you reach a stripe in stockinette stitch.

Bind off 66 (68) 73 (77) stitches for the sleeve (=stripes in: garter, stockinette, garter, stockinette, garter), knit until you have 102 (106) 113 (121) stitches on the front piece, bind off 66 (68) 73 (77) stitches for the sleeve (=stripes in: garter, stockinette, garter, stockinette, garter), knit 102 (106) 113 (121) stitches on the back.

### Armhole

Co 4 (5) 6 (6) sts below each sleeve = 212 (222) 238 (254) sts.

These stitches are knit using garter stitches.

## Body

Work even in pattern (without incs), until the work measures approx 11.8" (12.6") 13.4" (14.2") / 30 (32) 34 (36) cm (or desired length) measured from the armhole.

Bo loosely in rib: k1, p1.

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## Edges

If you wish, you can work a rnd of single crochet along the neckline and in the armholes to tighten the edges.
