

CROCHET PATTERN

# Josefine <br> Blouse 

Design: Sys Fredens | Hobbii Design

## MATERIALS

$4(4,5,5)$ skeins, Twister Solid, color 148

Crochet hook size 4.5 mm (US size 7)
Stitch markers

## YARN

(20) Twister Solid, Hobbii

55\% cotton, 45\% acrylic/
$100 \mathrm{~g}=400$ meters

## GAUGE

18 stitches and 18 rounds $=10 \mathrm{~cm}$ in rib pattern

## Sizes

S (M, L, XL)

## MEASUREMENTS

Width: $41(44,48,51) \mathrm{cm}$
Length: $54(56,59,62) \mathrm{cm}$

## PATTERN INFORMATION

The blouse is crocheted top-down. It has a pattern on the yoke.
Body and sleeves are crocheted in a spiral.

## Pattern instructions



## ABBREVIATIONS

ch = chain
hdc = half double crochet = yarn over, pick the yarn through the next stitch $=3$ loops on the hook, yarn over and pull the hook through the 3 loops on the hook.

## EXPLANATION

1 rib hdc: yarn over, pick the yarn through the next stitch (under the 2 loops behind the front loop), yarn over and pull the hook through the 3 loops on the hook (a small rib is created on the front side).

2 rib hdc together: Yarn over, pick the yarn through the next stitch (under the 2 loops behind the front loop), pick the yarn through the next stitch (under the 2 loops behind the front loop), yarn over and pull the hook through the 4 loops on the hook.

1 pattern stitch: yarn over 3 times, pick the yarn through the next stitch (under the 2 loops behind the front loop) = 5 loops on the hook, yarn over and pull through 2 loops, yarn over and pull through 2 loops, yarn over and pull through 3 loops.

## SINGLE CROCHET FOUNDATION CHAIN

Make a loop and chain 2, insert your hook into the first chain and pull up one loop, yarn over and pull through both loops on your hook.
*Pull the yarn through the left chain of the stitch you just crocheted $=2$ loops on your hook, yarn over and pull through the 2 loops on your hook*, repeat from * - *.

## BLOUSE

Cast on 84 stitches using single crochet cast on. Join into a ring with a slip stitch.

Neck edge: Chain (ch) 1, 1 hdc in each stitch (in the back loop). Join the round with a slip stitch. A rib is created on the front side.
Join each round with a slip stitch.

## YOKE

Round 1: Ch 1, 1 rib hdc in each stitch.
Round 2, increase: Ch 1, * 5 rib hdc, 2 rib hdc in the next stitch*, work * to * 14 times in total = 14 stitches increase $=98$ stitches.
Round 3, pattern: Ch 3 (replaces 1 pattern stitch), 1 pattern stitch in each stitch.
Round 4, increase: Ch 1, *6 rib hdc, 2 rib hdc in the next stitch*, work * to * 14 times in total = 14 stitches increase $=112$ stitches.
Round 5, pattern: Ch 3 (replaces 1 pattern hdc), 1 pattern hdc in each stitch.
Round 6, increase: Ch 1, * 7 rib hdc, 2 rib hdc in the next stitch*, work * to * 14 times in total = 14 stitches increase $=126$ stitches.

Continue like this with 1 more stitch between the increases until you have 224 stitches. End with a round without increases.

From here, work rib hdc in a spiral.

## Size S only

Round 1: Ch 1, rib hdc to the end of the round $=224$ stitches.

## Size M only

Round 1: Ch 1, *15 rib hdc, 2 rib hdc in the next stitch*, work * to * 14 times in total = 14 stitches increase $=238$ stitches.
Round 2: Ch 1 , rib hdc to the end of the round while increasing 4 stitches evenly across the round $=242$ stitches.

## Size L only

Round 1: Ch 1, *15 rib hdc, 2 rib hdc in the next stitch*, work * to * 14 times in total = 14 stitches increase $=238$ stitches.
Round 2: Ch 1 , hdc to the end of the round.
Round 3: Ch 1, *16 rib hdc, 2 rib hdc in the next stitch*, work * to * 14 times in total = 14 stitches increase $=252$ stitches.
Round 4: Ch 1, rib hdc to the end of the round while increasing 10 stitches evenly across the round $=262$ stitches.

## Size XL only

Round 1: Ch 1, *15 rib hdc, 2 rib hdc in the next stitch*, work * to * 14 times in total $=14$ stitches increase $=238$ stitches.
Round 2: Ch 1, hdc to the end of the round.
Round 3: Ch 1, *16 rib hdc, 2 rib hdc in the next stitch*, work * to * 14 times in total $=14$ stitches increase $=252$ stitches.
Round 4: Ch 1, hdc to the end of the round.
Round 5: Ch 1, *17 rib hdc, 2 rib hdc in the next stitch*, work * to * 14 times in total $=14$ stitches increase $=266$ stitches.
Round 6: Ch 1, rib hdc to the end of the round while increasing 16 stitches evenly across the round $=282$ stitches.

## DIVIDE FOR SLEEVES AND BODY

Cast on 9 stitches for armhole using single crochet cast on, skip $47(50,54,58)$ stitches for sleeve, work $65(71,77,83)$ rib hdc, cast on 9 stitches for armhole, skip $47(50,54,58)$ stitches for sleeve, work $65(71,77,83)$ rib hdc.

## BODY

## From here, work rib hdc in a spiral.

Work in a spiral over the $148(160,172,184)$ stitches on the body like this:
Place a marker around the center stitch of each armhole.
Work until the piece measures $5(5,6,6) \mathrm{cm}$ from the armhole.
End the round 4 stitches before a marker.

Decrease round: *2 rib hdc together, 5 rib hdc, 2 rib hdc together, work until 4 stitches before the marker on the opposite side, 2 rib hdc together, 5 rib hdc, 2 rib hdc together $=4$ stitches decrease.
Work 5 rounds in rib hdc*.
Repeat from *_* 3 times more $=132(144,156,168)$ stitches.
Work straight up until the piece measures $20(20,21,22) \mathrm{cm}$ from the armhole.
End the round 3 stitches before a marker.

Increase round: *2 rib hdc in the same stitch, 5 rib hdc, work 2 rib hdc in the same stitch, work until 3 stitches before the marker on the opposite side, 2 rib hdc in the same stitch, work 5 rib hdc, work 2 rib hdc in the same stitch $=4$ stitches increase.
Work 3 rounds in rib hdc*.
Repeat from *_* 3 times more $=148(160,172,184)$ stitches.

Work straight up until the piece measures $33(33,34,35) \mathrm{cm}$ from the armhole.
Bind off.

## SLEEVES

## From here, work rib hdc in a spiral.

Work over the $56(59,63,67)$ stitches of the armhole. Place a marker around the center stitch of the armhole.
Work $8(8,7,7)$ rounds.
End the round 4 stitches before the marker.

Decrease round: 2 rib hdc together, 5 rib hdc, 2 rib hdc together, work to the end of the round = 2 stitches decrease.

Work $7(7,6,6)$ rounds.
Repeat these last $8(8,7,7)$ rounds until $16(18,20,22)$ stitches have been decreased $=40(41,43$, 45) stitches.

Work straight up until the piece measures approx. 45 cm from the armhole.

Work the second sleeve the same way.
