



Cotton Stripes Pillow – Bolster

Materials

Rainbow Cotton 8/8 – col. 14 and 29

Crochet hook, 3 or 3.5 mm

Bolster pillow 40x15 cm

Yarn usage, about:

Col. A: 135g

Col: B: 130g

Crochet gauge

About 16 sts x 13.5 rows = 10x10 cm

Abbreviations

st(s): stitch(es)

ch: chain stitch

sc: single crochet

hdc: half double crochet

dc: double crochet

sl st: slip stitch

MR: magic ring

Pattern instructions – Guide with pictures can be found below the instructions

1. Using col. A, ch 65. Make 1 hdc in the 2nd st from the hook and 1 hdc in every st until end of row. (64)

2. Ch 1 and turn. 1 hdc in every st until end of row. (64)

Repeat the 2nd row, switching colors to make stripes as described, until you have 64 rows in total:

3 rows color A – incl. the first two rows.

5 rows color B

3 rows color A

5 rows color B

3 rows color A

5 rows color B

3 rows color A

5 rows color B

3 rows color A

5 rows color B

3 rows color A

5 rows color B

3 rows color A

5 rows color B

3 rows color A

5 rows color B

Turn and ch 1. Join the two shorter sides using sl sts. Cut the yarn and weave in the ends. Turn your tube inside out so the seam is on the inside.

Guide



Turn and ch 1.



Join the two short sides with sl sts.

Repeat until end of row..



Cut the yarn and weave in the ends. Turn your tube inside out so the seam is on the inside.

Using col A - Place the yarn at one end of the tube. Ch 1. Make 84 sc evenly distributed along the entire edge. End with a sl st. Cut the yarn and weave in ends. Repeat at the other end. Place the pillow inside the tube.



Using col A - Place the yarn at one end of the tube. Ch 1. Make 84 sc evenly distributed along the entire edge.



End with a sl st. Cut the yarn and weave in ends.



Like so.



Repeat at the other end.



Place the pillow inside the tube.

End pieces – using col. A.

NB: Every round starts with ch 1. This st does not replace any sts and doesn't count towards the number of sts.

Every round is finished with a sl st into the first st.

1. Make a MR and ch 1. Make 12 dc into the ring. Join with a sl st. (12)
2. Ch 1. Make 2dc in every st. Join with a sl st. (24)
3. Ch 1. *1 dc in the first st, 2 dc in the next*, repeat between ** until end of round. Join with a sl st. (36)
4. Ch 1. *1 dc in the first 2 sts, 2 dc in the next*, repeat between ** until end of round. Join with a sl st. (48)
5. Ch 1. *1 dc in the first 3 sts, 2 dc in the next*, repeat between ** until end of round. Join with a sl st. (60)
6. Ch 1. *1 dc in the first 4 sts, 2 dc in the next*, repeat between ** until end of round. Join with a sl st. (72)

7. Ch 1. *1 dc in the first 5 sts, 2 dc in the next*, repeat between ** until end of round.
Join with a sl st. (84)

Ch 1 and join the end piece to the tube with 1 sc in every st of the end and the tube edge.
End with a sl st. Cut the yarn and weave in ends.

Make another end piece in the same manner and join it to the other end.



Ch 1 and join the end piece to the tube with 1 sc in every st of the end and the tube edge.



Like so.



End with a sl st. Cut the yarn and weave in ends.



Make another end piece in the same manner and join it to the other end.
