# Sopka

**Bucket hat with brim**

## MATERIALS

1 skein of Rainbow Cotton 8/8, color 07  
1 skein of Rainbow Cotton 8/8, color 63  
1 skein of Rainbow Cotton 8/8, color 56

Circular needle US 4 / 3.5 mm, 31.5" / 80 cm

## YARN QUALITY

 **Rainbow 8/8**, Hobbii  
100 % Cotton, 1.8 oz / 50 g = 82 yds / 75 m

## GAUGE

18 sts x 40 rows = 4" / 10 cm  
in garter stitch

## SIZES

S/M (L/XL)

## MEASUREMENTS

Circumference: 19.7" (22") / 50 (56) cm,  
stretches during use

## ABOUT THE PATTERN

The hat is worked bottom up.  
Work in the flat on the circular needle.  
All stitches are knit = garter stitch.  
Let the yarn colors of the stripes run along  
the side and be careful not to tighten them.  
When decreasing on the crown, two stitches  
are knit together.  
Finally, the hat is stitched together.

# Pattern



## BRIM

Co 151 (161) sts with color 07 and work 4 rows in garter stitch = k all rows.

Start decreasing

Change to color 63.

\*K 13 (14) sts, k2tog\*, repeat from \* to \* until 1 st remains, k1 = 141 (151) sts.

Work 3 rows.

Change to color 56.

\*K 12 (13) sts, k2tog\*, repeat from \* to \* until 1 st remains, k1 = 131 (141) sts.

Work 3 rows.

Change to color 07.

\*K 11 (12) sts, k2tog\*, repeat from \* to \* until 1 st remains, k1 = 121 (131) sts.

Work 3 rows.

Change to color 63.

\*K 10 (11) sts, k2tog\*, repeat from \* to \* until 1 st remains, k1 = 111 (121) sts.

Work 3 rows.

Change to color 56.

\*K 9 (10) sts, k2tog\*, repeat from \* to \* until 1 st remains, k1 = 101 (111) sts.

Work 3 rows.

Change to color 07.

\*K 8 (9) sts, k2tog\*, repeat from \* to \* until 1 st remains, k1 = 91 (101) sts.

Work 3 rows.

## HAT

Continue working stripes for the rest of the work.

Striped pattern: Alternate between 4 rows with color 63, 4 rows with color 56 and 4 rows with color 07.

Work until the hat measures 3.9" (4.3") / 10 (11) cm.

## CROWN

### Decreasing

\*K 7 (8) sts, k2tog\*, repeat from \* to \* until 1 st remains, k1 = 81 (91) sts.

Work 3 rows.

\*K 6 (7) sts, k2tog\*, repeat from \* to \* until 1 st remains, k1 = 71 (81) sts.

Work 3 rows.

\*K 5 (6) sts, k2tog\*, repeat from \* to \* until 1 st remains, k1 = 61 (71) sts.

Work 3 rows.

\*K 4 (5) sts, k2tog\*, repeat from \* to \* until 1 st remains, k1 = 51 (61) sts.

Work 3 rows.

\*K 3 (4) sts, k2tog\*, repeat from \* to \* until 1 st remains, k1 = 41 (51) sts.

Work 3 rows.

\*K 2 (3) sts, k2tog\*, repeat from \* to \* until 1 st remains, k1 = 31 (41) sts.

Work 3 rows.

\*K 1 (2) st(s), k2tog\*, repeat from \* to \* until 1 st remains, k1 = 21 (31) sts.

Work 1 row.

K2tog until 1 st remains, k1 = 11 (16) sts.

## SEAMING

Cut off the yarn while keeping a long strand. Pull the yarn through the sts and pull tight.

Stitch the hat together so that the side with the visible color changes is facing out.

Weave in all ends.
