YARN USAGE

Sensory Duck: 29 x 29 x L33 cm Bohème Velvet "double": Calour A 100 g Calour B 50 g

Soft Bamboo "double":Calour C50 g

MATERIALS

Filling, Eyes: 10 mm Wooden ring: 55 mm Rattle ring: 63 mm Rattle cellophane Mirror PC D10 cm Teething ring, Ring link Squeaker: 25 mm Crochet hook: 3,5 - 4,0 mm

Crochet Sensory Duck with Go handmade's Bohème Velvet "double": 100% Polyester, 50 g/70 m. Crochet straps and mirror attachments in Go handmade's Soft Bamboo "double": 70% Bamboo/23% Cotton/7% Acrylic, 50 g/115 m. Gauge: 19 dc/10 cm

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Soft Bamboo "double": Colour C 50 g

MATERIALS

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Gauge: 19 dc/10 cm

Indicated yarn lengths are for guidance only.

If nothing else is specified, work in spiral rounds. To finish the work, join the round with a sl st. Leave a 20 cm length of yarn and cut. Pull the yarn through the stitch.

Mounting of the safety eyes:

The eyes are inserted, and the rear stops to the eyes are pushed from the inside.

The rear stops can and should be a little hard to plug in to ensure that they are sticking well.

Stuff the head with filling.			

Shape the eye hollows:

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With Bohème Velvet "double", thread a needle with approx. 25 cm yarn.


Put the needle in from under the chin and out at the side of the eye.

Guide the thread around some stitches by the eye and then back out under the chin. Tighten the yarn to form the hollow around the eye, tighten the yarn through a few stitches under the chin.

The hollow for the eye is now completed.

Should you want the hollow deeper the process can be repeated and a stitch added towards the top of the eye.

Repeat the process for the other eye. See illustration.

BEAK (COLOUR B)

- 1.) 5 ch, 3 dc in 2nd ch from crochet hook, 2 dc, 3 dc in last ch, 2 dc on the opposite side of the chain, 2 dc in the last ch (12)
- 2. 4.) 12 dc (12)

Attach the beak on round 11 of the head.

HAIR (COLOUR C)

For the hair, cut a few pieces of yarn of 10 cm long. Pull them through a stitch so they lie double. Attach them with a knot and cut.

COMFORT BLANKET (COLOUR A)

Crochet Comfort Blanket like a Granny Square as follows:

Each round starts with 3 ch replacing the 1st tr. Finish with 1 sl st in the 3rd ch at the start of the rd.

- 1.) mr, *3 tr, 2 ch* in ring x 4
- 2.) *3 tr, 2 ch, 3 tr, 2 ch around the 2 ch from the previous rd* in every corner x 4
- 3.) 3 sl st from the corner*, 3 tr, 2 ch, 3 tr, 2 ch around the 2 ch from the previous rd of the corner groups, 3 tr, 2 ch around the 2 ch from the previous rd of the corner groups* x 4
- 4. 12.) Crochet as rd 3, which increases by 1 tr gr + 2 ch around the 2 ch from the previous rd

Continue until the desired size.

In this pattern there are 12 rd for approx. 29 x 29 cm. Weave in the ends, and sew the head onto the centre of the blanket when everything is mounted on the head.

WINGS (COLOUR A, 2 X)

Add 2 layers of Rattle cellophane to the wings and sew them onto the blanket as shown in the pictures. Cut the yarn.

STAR (COLOUR B, 2 X)

1.)	mr with 6 dc	(6)
2.)	1 dc inc	(12)
3.)	*1 dc, 1 dc inc*	(18)
4.)	*2 dc, 1 dc inc*	(24)
Create 5	tips on the circle:	
1.)	4 dc, 1 t-ch	(4)
2.)	*dc 2 tog*, 1 t-ch	(2)
3.)	dc 2 tog	(1)

Weave in the ends. Sew the two parts together. Insert Squeaker and filling.



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MIRROR (COLOUR A AND C)

Cut a round mirror to D6,5 cm.

Make a total of 16 holes of approx. D3mm, round, at approx. 2 mm from the edge. The holes can be made with a pair of pliers (photo 1).

Front of the mirror (Colour C):

Start in the holes on the mirror:

1.)	1 sl st in all holes	(16)
2.)	2 dc in each sl st	(32)
3.)	32 dc	(32)

Finish the round with 1 sl st in the 1st "hole st". Cut the yarn at approx. 50 cm to be able to sew the sides together with it (photo 2).


Back for the mirror (Colour A):

1.)	mr with 6 dc	(6)
2.)	*1 dc inc*	(12)
3.)	*1 dc, 1 dc inc*	(18)
4.)	*2 dc, 1 dc inc*	(24)
5.)	*3 dc, 1 dc inc*	(30)
6.)	30 dc	(30)

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Finish and weave in end (photo 3).

Sew together with the mirror (photo 4 and 5). Mount the mirror on the underside of the blanket.











STRAP FOR THE STAR (COLOUR C)

1.)	8 ch, 1 t-ch	(8)
2 3.)	8 dc, 1 t-ch	(8)
4.)	8 dc	(8)

Cut the yarn.

Sew the strap to one of the tips of the star, and then sew to one of the corners of the blanket.

STRAP FOR THE WOODEN RING (COLOUR C)

1.)	10 ch, 1 t-ch	(10)
2 3.)	10 dc, 1 t-ch	(10)
4.)	10 dc	(10)

Cut the yarn. Add the Wooden ring and sew onto one of the corners of the blanket.

STRAP FOR THE RATTLE RING (COLOUR C)

1.)	14 ch, 1 t-ch	(14)
2 3.)	14 dc, 1 t-ch	(14)
4.)	14 dc	(14)

Cut the yarn. Add the Rattle ring and sew onto one of the corners of the blanket.

STRAP	For the teethin	NG RING (COLOUR C)
1.)	8 ch, 1 t-ch	(8)
2 3.)	8 dc, 1 t-ch	(8)
4.)	8 dc	(8)

Cut the yarn. Add the Teething ring and sew onto one of the corners of the blanket.

STRAP FOR THE RING LINK (COLOUR C)

Cut the yarn. Sew onto to the top of the head.			









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Good to know

Hook Size + Tension

Crocheters crochet very differently: some crochet with a hook size 2,0 mm and obtain the same size of design and quality as a person who crochets with a hook size 4,0 mm. We owe this knowledge to the team of crocheters who join us. The key to crochet a specific size is a lot about the crochet style/hands/skills, rather than the size of hook. Therefore, we will recommend a range of hook sizes.
