MATERIALS

1 skein of Amigo XL - Egg Yolk (A37)
1 skein of Amigo XL - Emerald Green (A31)
1 skein of Amigo XL - Black (A12)

Crochet hook 2.75mm (US C2)
Crochet hook 3.75mm (US F5)

2 safety eyes 7 mm (US 0.3")
Stuffing
Yarn needle
Scissors

YARN QUALITY

 **Amigo XL**, Hobbii
100% acrylic
50 g / 1.8 oz. = 285 m / 109 yds

ABBREVIATIONS

FO = fasten off
MR = magic ring
BLO = back loops only
YO = yarn over
ch = chain
sl st = slip stitch
sc = single crochet
hdc = half double crochet
inc = increase
dec = decrease

SIZE

One size

MEASUREMENTS

Height: Approx. 10 cm / 4" (without counting tail)

INFO AND TIPS

- Use the 2.75mm (US C2) hook for all parts of the pattern, except for the head and stem. The head and stem are made with the 3.75mm (US F5) hook.

LEGS (x2)

Work with black yarn and the 2.75mm (US C2) hook.

(Note: The legs are made using the “i-cord” crochet technique.)

Set up the i-cord: Ch 3. Insert hook into 2nd ch from hook, YO, pull up a loop, insert hook into next ch, YO, and pull up a loop. (3 loops on hook)

R1: Drop 2 loops from hook, but hold onto them tightly with your non-hook hand so that they do not come undone. YO, pull through loop on hook. Insert hook into first dropped loop, YO, pull through. (2 loops on hook.) Insert hook into second dropped loop, YO, and pull through. (3 loops on hook)

R2-R12: Repeat R1.

To finish, YO and pull through all 3 loops on hook.

FO with a long tail for sewing to the body later.

ARMS (x2)

Work with black yarn and the 2.75mm (US C2) hook.

Repeat R1-R8 of the ‘Legs’ section.

FO with a long tail for sewing to the body later.

BODY

Work with green yarn and the 2.75mm (US C2) hook.

R1: 6 sc in MR. (6)

R2: Inc around. (12)

R3: (Sc, inc) x 6. (18)

R4-R8: Sc around. (18)

R9: (Sc 4, dec) x 3. (15)

R10: Sc around. (15)

R11: In BLO, (sc 3, dec) x 3. (12)

R12: Sc around. (12)

FO with a long tail for sewing later.

DRESS SKIRT

Note: I prefer sewing the legs to the body before starting the dress skirt, then sewing the arms to the sides of the body after the dress skirt is complete.

Work with green yarn and the 2.75mm (US C2) hook. Attach yarn to the back loops created in R11 of the 'Body'.

R1: Ch 2, hdc around. *Join with a sl st to the first hdc. (15)

R2: Ch 2, (hdc 2, inc) x 5. *Join. (20)

R3: Ch 2, (hdc 3, inc) x 5. *Join. (25)

R4: Ch 2, (hdc 4, inc) x 5. *Join. (30)

R5: Ch 2, (hdc 5, inc) x 5. *Join. (35)

R6: Ch 1, (inc, sl st) around. *Join.

FO and weave in the ends.

PUMPKIN HEAD

Work with orange yarn and the 3.75mm (US F5) hook.

Ch 14.

R1: Insert hdc in 3rd ch from hook. Hdc across the next 11 ch. (12)

R2: Ch 2, turn. Hdc across in BLO. (12)

R3-R12: Repeat R2.

FO with a long tail. Attach 7mm plastic safety eyes in the middle of the rectangle between R5-R6 and R7-R8.

STEM

Use green yarn and 3.75 mm (US F5) hook.

Ch 3.

R1: Sc in 2nd ch from hook. Sc in next st.

FO with a long tail for sewing to the head later.



FINISHING INSTRUCTIONS

1. If you haven't already, sew the legs to the bottom of the body and the arms to the sides of the body.
2. Use a running stitch across the top edge of the rectangular pumpkin head piece. Pull the yarn tightly to cinch the top closed. Continue sewing the sides of the pumpkin together, stitch by stitch. Stuff the pumpkin head but be careful not to stretch the stitches and create gaps. After stuffing, sew the bottom closed. To make the pumpkin shape, insert the yarn needle from the bottom through the top, pulling tightly to create the center indent.
3. Sew the stem to the top of the pumpkin head.
4. Sew the pumpkin head to the body.
