MATERIALS

1 skein of Rainbow Cotton 8/8 color 066 1 skein of Rainbow Cotton 8/8 color 001 1 skein of Rainbow Cotton 8/8 color 008

Crochet hook 4.5 mm (US size G)

Stuffing
Small amount of black felt
Scissors
Tapestry needle
Fabric glue

YARN QUALITY

Rainbow Cotton 8/8, Hobbii 100% Cotton / 50 g (1.8 oz) = 75 meter (82 yds)

ABBREVIATIONS

CH: chain stitch SC: single crochet BLO: back loops only

() at end of round: refers to the amount of stitches you have at the end of that round

SIZE

One size

MEASUREMENTS

Height: Approx. 18 cm (7 inches)

INFO AND TIPS

CH at beginning of round always counts as first stitch. Join with a slip stitch after each round.

CUP

(make one with col. 066)

Round 1: CH 2 and work 6 SC into the second CH from hook, join to form a small circle (7)

Round 2: CH 1 and work 2 SC into each stitch around and join (14)

Round 3: CH 1 and work (2 SC into the first stitch, 1 SC into the next) repeat from (to) around and join (21)

Round 4: CH 1 and work (2 SC into the first stitch, 1 SC into each of the next 2 stitches) repeat from (to) around and join. (28)

Round 5: CH 1 and work (2 SC into the first stitch, 1 SC into each of the next 3 stitches) repeat from (to) around and join. (35)

Round 6: CH 1 and work (2 SC into the first stitch, 1 SC into each of the next 4 stitches) repeat from (to) around and join. (42)

Round 7: working in BLO, work 1 SC into each stitch around and join. (42)

Rounds 8-21: CH 1 and work 1 SC into each stitch around and join (42)

Finish off here and weave in ends.

TOP OF THE CUP

(make one with col. 066)

Round 1: CH 2 and work 6 SC into the second CH from hook, join to form a small circle (7)

Round 2: CH 1 and work 2 SC into each stitch around and join (14)

Round 3: CH 1 and work (2 SC into the first stitch, 1 SC into the next) repeat from (to) around and join (21)

Round 4: CH 1 and work (2 SC into the first stitch, 1 SC into each of the next 2 stitches) repeat from (to) around and join. (28)

Round 5: CH 1 and work (2 SC into the first stitch, 1 SC into each of the next 3 stitches) repeat from (to) around and join. (35)

Round 6: CH 1 and work (2 SC into the first stitch, 1 SC into each of the next 4 stitches) repeat from (to) around and join. (42)



Finish off and leave a long tail for sewing, then stuff the cup and sew the lid on top.

FROSTING/WHIPPED CREAM

(make one with col. 001)

Round 1: CH 2 and work 5 SC into the second CH from hook, join to form a small circle (6)

Rounds 2-3: CH 1 and work 1 SC into each stitch around and join (6)

Round 4: CH 1 and work (2 SC in the first stitch, 1 SC in the next) repeat from (to) around and join (9)

Rounds 5-6: CH 1 and work 1 SC into each stitch around and join (9)

Round 7: CH 1 and work (2 SC in the first stitch, 1 in each of the next 2) repeat from (to)

around and join (12)

Round 8-75: CH 1 and work 1 SC into each stitch around and join (12)

Finish off and leave a long tail for sewing.

ASSEMBLY

First flatten the open end of the frosting and sew it closed using the tapestry needle. To get the twist in the frosting swirl start at the "bottom" and twist it into a circle roughly the same size as the top of the cup. Use the tail left from sewing the end shut and secure the circle into place. Then twist another, slightly smaller loop on top and secure that into place as well. It helps to try to do all your sewing from the inside of the swirl to hide your stitches. Continue twisting your swirl into shape and securing it into place as you go. Once you're happy with the shape finish off and weave in ends.



















CINNAMON STICKS (make two with col. 008)

Round 1: CH 2 and work 5 SC into the second CH from hook and join to form a small circle (6) **Rounds 2-8:** CH 1 and work 1 SC into each stitch around and join (6) Finish off and leave a tail for sewing. To attach, just insert them into the small opening left in the middle of the frosting swirl. Offset them for a cute balance and sew into place.

EYES

(make 2 with col. 001)

Round 1: CH 2 and work 6 SC into the second CH from hook, join to form a small circle (7)

Round 2: CH 1 and work 2 SC into each stitch around and join (14)

Rounds 3-4: CH 1 and work 1 SC into each stitch around and join (14)

Finish off and leave a tail for sewing

To attach, just place them where you'd like and sew them into place.

PUPILS AND MOUTH

Cut small pieces of felt and glue into place.
