**Sweater**

#### **MATERIALS**

10 (11, 12, 12, 13, 13) skeins of Tweed Delight, color 08

Needles 5 mm (US 8) 2 auxiliary needles (double pointed needles) 5 mm (US 8) for attaching the collar

Stitch holders Stitch markers

# YARN QUALITY

**Tweed Delight,** Hobbii 85 % Wool, 10 % Acrylic, 5 % Viscose/ 50 g (1.75 oz) = 100 m (109 yds)

## **GAUGE**

18 sts x 26 rows in waffle stitch = 10 cm (4'')

## **ABBREVIATIONS**

st(s) = stitch(es)
k = knit
p = purl
tbl = through the back loop
RS = right side
WS = wrong side
sl1p = slip 1 stitch purlwise
M1 = pick up the bar between two stitches and
knit it through the back loop
co = cast on
bo = bind off

#### SIZE

S (M, L, XL, 2XL, 3XL)

## **MEASUREMENTS**

Width: approx 48 (52, 56, 60, 64, 68) cm / 18.9" (20.5", 22", 23.6", 25.2", 27") Length, all sizes: 60 cm / 23.6"

# **ABOUT THE PATTERN**

The sweater is wide and spacious. It is worked in pattern repeats alternating between waffle stitch and stockinette stitch. The collar is only worked in waffle stitch. Back piece, front piece and sleeves are worked separately. The collar is sewn together at the neck.

# **Pattern**







#### **BACK**

Co 86 (94, 100, 108, 116, 122) sts.

#### Work waffle stitch

The first and last st on the needle are k on the RS and p on the WS = edge sts.

Row 1, RS: K1, \*k1, p1\*, repeat from \* to \* until 1 st remains, k1.

Row 2, WS: P1, \*k on k, p on p\*, repeat from \* to \* until 1 st remains, p1.

Row 3, RS: K to end.

Row 4, WS: P1, k until 1 st remains, p1.

Repeat rows 1-4 until you have worked a total of 24 rows.

Row 25, RS: K to end.

Row 26, WS: P to end.

Repeat rows 25-26 until you have worked a total of 16 rows = stockinette stitch.

Together, these 40 rows form 1 pattern repeat = approx 15 cm (5.9").

Work pattern repeats until the work measures 60 cm (23.6") = 4 pattern repeats. Bo.

## **FRONT PIECE**

Work following the same procedure as for the back piece until you have worked 2 full pattern repeats and 24 rows of waffle stitch = approx 38 cm (15"). End with k sts on a WS row.

#### Left-hand side and left-hand side collar

Continue working the front piece in pattern repeats (with one edge st as side seam). The collar is only worked in waffle stitch (without edge st at the front edge).

**NB** Make sure that the pattern is placed correctly.

RS: K the 29 (32, 35, 38, 42, 44) sts of the front piece and work the 28 (30, 30, 32, 32, 34) sts of the collar in waffle stitch = 57 (62, 65, 70, 74, 78) sts. Place the remaining sts on a stitch holder.

**NB** From here, edge sts are only worked on the side.

Work until you have a total of 4 pattern repeats and the work measures approx 60 cm (23.6"). End with a WS row.

RS: Bo the 29 (32, 35, 38, 42, 44) sts of the front piece and work the 28 (30, 30, 32, 32, 34) sts of the collar.

**NB** From here, edge sts are only worked in the neck.



Work until the collar measures approx 9% (10, 10, 10½, 10½, 11) cm / 3.7" (3.9", 3.9", 4.1", 4.1", 4.3").

End in the neck (3rd row of the pattern) Place the sts on a stitch holder.

## Right-hand side and right-hand side collar

Continue working the front piece in pattern repeat and the collar only in waffle stitch.

**NB** Make sure that the pattern is placed correctly.

Join new yarn and co 28 (30, 30, 32, 32, 34) sts for the collar with the knitted cast on method, keep the sts on the right needle and work the 29 (32, 35, 38, 42, 44) sts of the front piece = 57 (62, 65, 70, 74, 78) sts.

**NB** From here, edge sts are only worked on the side.

Work this side following the same procedure as for the left-hand side until you have worked a total of 4 pattern repeats and the work measures approx 60 cm (23.6"). End with a WS row. RS: Work the 28 (30, 30, 32, 32, 34) sts of the collar and bo the 29 (32, 35, 38, 42, 44) sts of the front piece.

**NB** From here, edge sts are only worked in the neck.

Work until the collar measures approx 9% (10, 10, 10%, 10%, 11) cm / 3.7" (3.9", 3.9", 4.1", 4.1", 4.3"). End in the neck (2nd row of the pattern) Place the sts on a stitch holder.

#### ATTACHING THE COLLAR

Sew together the shoulder seams with kitchener stitch = 29 (32, 35, 38, 42, 44) sts. Sew the cast on edge of the right-hand side of the collar onto the WS.

Place the collar sts on two double pointed needles = auxiliary needles A and B. Place the two parts against each other, WS facing WS. Merge the sts together with needle 5 mm (US 8) like this: Begin at the outer edge of the collar, \*sl1p from auxiliary needle A and sl1p from auxiliary needle B = 2 sts on the needle, bo (pass the first st over the second st)\*, repeat from \* to \* until all sts

Pull the yarn through the st and weave in the end. Place a marker in this st and a marker in the middle of the neck.

The collar is 4 cm (1.6") longer than the bo in the neck.

Attach the collar along the neck by holding it closed with the markers directly next to each other.

# **SLEEVES**

Co 46 (48, 50, 50, 52, 54) sts and work in pattern repeats as you did on the back piece (remember edge sts).

Work 4 rows.

## **Increases**

RS: K1, M1, work until 2 sts remain, M1, k1.

Increase on every 6th row until you have 76 (78, 80, 80, 82, 84) sts.

Work even until the work measures approx 40 cm (15.7").

Bo.

Same procedure for the second sleeve.

#### **FINISHING**

Attach the sleeves to the sweater. Sew together the sleeve seams and side seams.
