

KNITTING PATTERN
Irma Jumper

## MATERIALS

$5(5,6,6,7,7)$ skeins of Amigo,
Color 48
Needles 3 mm (US 2.5) and 4 mm (US 6)
Stitch markers
Stitch holders

## YARN QUALITY

## (63) Amigo, Hobbii

100\% HB Acrylic / $50 \mathrm{~g}(1.8 \mathrm{oz})=175 \mathrm{~m}(191$ yds)

## GAUGE

22 sts $\times 30$ rows in stockinette stitch with needle $4 \mathrm{~mm}($ US 6$)=10 \mathrm{~cm}\left(4^{\prime \prime}\right)$

## SIZE

S (M, L, XL, 2XL, 3XL)

## MEASUREMENTS

Width: $43(47,50,55,58,63) \mathrm{cm} / 16.9^{\prime \prime}$ (18.5", 19.7", 21.7", 22.8", 24.8")

Length: $51(52,53,54,55,56) \mathrm{cm} / 20.1^{\prime \prime}$ (20.5", 20.9", 21.3", 21.7", 22")

## ABOUT THE PATTERN

The jumper is worked in stockinette stitch with hem and collar in seed stitch. Back piece, front piece and sleeves are worked separately.

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ABBREVIATIONS
$\mathrm{st}(\mathrm{s})=$ stitch(es)
$\mathrm{k}=\mathrm{knit}$
$\mathrm{p}=$ purl
$\mathrm{RS}=$ right side
$\mathrm{WS}=$ wrong side
$\mathrm{co}=$ cast on
$\mathrm{bo}=$ bind off
tbl = through back loop
inc1 = increase 1 stitch by picking up the bar
between the stitches and knitting it through the
back loop

## SEED STITCH

Repeat *k1, p1* to end.
Then $k$ the $p$ sts and $p$ the $k$ sts on all rows.

## BIND OFF

Slip the first st before each bind off.

## BACK

## Hem

Co $88(96,102,112,118,128)$ sts with needle 3 mm (US 2.5).
Work $4 \mathrm{~cm}\left(1.6^{\prime \prime}\right)$ in seed stitch. End with a WS row.

## Body

Change to needle 4 mm (US 6).
Row with increases, RS: *K 14 (12, 10, 10, 10, 10), inc1 (= pick up the bar between the sts and $k$ it tbl)*, repeat from * to * a total of $6(8,10,10,10,12)$ times, work to end $=94(104$, $112,122,128,140)$ sts.

Work in stockinette stitch until the work measures $34(34,34,35,35,35) \mathrm{cm} / 13.4^{\prime \prime}\left(13.4^{\prime \prime}\right.$, 13.4", 13.8", 13.8", 13.8"). End with a WS row.

## Armhole

Bo 2 sts at the beginning of the next 2 rows a total of $1(2,3,4,5,6)$ time(s) $=4(8,12,16,20$, $24)$ sts decreased $=90(96,100,106,108,116)$ sts.
Bo 1 st at the beginning of each row until $82(84,84,86,86,88)$ sts remain.

## All sizes

Work even until the work measures 49 (50, 51, 53, 54, 55) cm / 19.3" (19.7", 20.1", 20.9", 21.3", 21.7"). End with a WS row.

## Right shoulder

RS: K $28(29,28,29,28,29)$ sts, turn the work and place the remaining sts on a stitch holder. Repeat *bo 2 sts at the beginning of each WS row* 3 times $=22(23,22,23,22,23)$ sts.

Bo.

## Neck

RS: Bo $26(26,28,28,30,30)$ sts, $k$ to end $=28(29,28,29,28,29)$ sts.

## Left shoulder

WS: $P$ to end.
Repeat *bo 2 sts at the beginning of each RS row* 3 times $=22(23,22,23,22,23)$ sts.
P 1 row.
Bo.

## FRONT PIECE

## Edge

Co $88(96,102,112,118,128)$ sts with needle 3 mm (US 2.5).
Work $4 \mathrm{~cm}\left(1.6^{\prime \prime}\right)$ in seed stitch. End with a WS row.

## Body

Change to needle US 10 (4 mm).
Row with increases, RS: *K 14 (12, 10, 10, 10, 10), inc1 (= pick up the bar between the sts and k it tbl)*, repeat from * to * a total of $6(8,10,10,10,12)$ times, work to end $=94(104$, $112,122,128,140)$ sts.

Work in stockinette stitch until the work measures $34(34,34,35,35,35) \mathrm{cm} / 13.4^{\prime \prime}\left(13.4^{\prime \prime}\right.$, 13.4", 13.8", 13.8", 13.8"). End with a WS row.

Place a marker in the middle of the work $=47(52,56,61,64,70)$ sts for each part.
Now the work is divided and each side is worked separately.

## Left armhole and slit in seed stitch

Row 1, RS: Bo $3(4,4,5,5,6)$ sts, $k$ until 3 sts before marker, work 6 sts in seed stitch, turn $=$ $47(51,55,59,62,67)$ sts. Place the remaining sts on a stitch holder.
Row 2, WS: Work 6 sts in seed stitch, $p$ to end.
Row 3, RS: Bo $2(2,3,3,4,4)$ sts, $k$ until 6 sts remain, work 6 sts in seed stitch.
Row 4, WS: Work 6 sts in seed stitch, p to end $=45(49,52,56,58,63)$ sts.

Continue binding off like this: Repeat *bo 2 sts at the beginning of each RS row* a total of 0 $(1,2,3,3,4)$ time(s) $=45(47,48,50,52,55)$ sts, then repeat *bo 1 st at the beginning of each RS row* a total of $2(3,3,4,5,7)$ times $=43(44,45,46,47,48)$ sts.

## All sizes

Work in until the work measures 44 (45, 46, 48, 49, 50) cm / 17.3" (17.7", 18.1", 18.9", 19.3", 19.7"). End with a RS row.

## Neckline

WS: Place 6 sts on a stitch holder, bo $2(2,2,3,3,4)$ sts and $p$ to end.
RS: K to end.
WS: Bo $3(4,4,4,5,5)$ sts and $p$ to end $=32(32,33,33,33,33)$ sts.
RS: K to end.

Continue binding off like this: Repeat *bo 2 sts at the beginning of each WS row* 3 times = $26(26,27,27,27,27)$ sts, then repeat *bo 1 st at the beginning of each WS row* until $22(23$, $22,23,22,23)$ sts remain.

Work even until the work measures 51 (52,53, 54, 55, 56) cm / 20.1" (20.5", 20.9", 21.3", 21.7", 22").

Bo.

## Right armhole and slit

Row 1, RS: Co 6 sts for the slit and place the remaining sts on a stitch holder $=50(55,59,64$, 67, 73) sts.
Row 2, WS: Bo 3 (4, 4, 5, 5, 6) sts, p until 6 sts remain, work 6 sts in seed stitch $=47(51,55,59,62,67)$ sts.
Row 3, RS: Work 6 sts in seed stitch, $k$ to end.
Row 4, WS: Bo $2(2,3,3,4,4)$ sts, p until 6 sts remain,
work 6 sts in seed stitch $=45(49,52,56,58,63)$ sts.

Continue binding off like this: Repeat *bo 2 sts at the beginning of each WS row* a total of 0 $(1,2,3,3,4)$ time(s) $=45(47,48,50,52,55)$ sts, then repeat *bo 1 st at the beginning of each WS row* a total of $2(3,3,4,5,7)$ times $=43(44,45,46,47,48)$ sts.

## All sizes

Work in until the work measures 44 ( $45,46,48,49,50$ cm / 17.3" (17.7", 18.1", 18.9", 19.3", 19.7"). End with a WS row.

## Neckline

RS: Place 6 sts on a stitch holder, bo $2(2,2,3,3,4)$ sts and $k$ to end.
WS: $P$ to end.
RS: Bo $3(4,4,4,5,5)$ sts and work to end = $32(32,33,33,33,33)$ sts.
WS: $P$ to end.

Continue binding off like this: Repeat *bo 2 sts at the beginning of each RS row* 3 times = $26(26,27,27,27,27)$ sts, then repeat *bo 1 st at the beginning of each RS row* until $22(23$, $22,23,22,23)$ sts remain.

Work even until the work measures 51 (52, 53, 54, 55, 56) cm / 20.1" (20.5", 20.9", 21.3", 21.7", 22").

Bo.

## SLEEVES

## RIGHT SLEEVE

## Hem

Co $46(48,50,52,54,56)$ sts with needle 3 mm (US 2.5).
Work $4 \mathrm{~cm}\left(1.6^{\prime \prime}\right)$ in seed stitch. End with a WS row.

## Row with increases

Change to needle 4 mm (US 6).
RS: *K 3, inc1 (= pick up the bar between the sts and k it tbl)*, repeat from * to * a total of $12(14,16,16,18,18)$ times, $k$ to end $=58(62,66,68,72,74)$ sts.

## Sleeve

Work in stockinette stitch while increasing 1 st on each side like this:
RS: K1, inc1, k until 1 st remains, inc1, k1 = 2 incs.
Increase on every 4th row until there are $76(80,84,86,90,92)$ sts.
Work in until the work measures approx $17(17,18,18,19,19) \mathrm{cm} / 6.7^{\prime \prime}\left(6.7^{\prime \prime}, 7.1^{\prime \prime}, 7.1^{\prime \prime}, 7.5^{\prime \prime}\right.$, $7.5^{\prime \prime}$ ). End with a WS row.

NB Sts are not bound off identically on the right-hand side and left-hand side of the sleeve (see below).

## Armhole

## Size S

Row 1, RS: Bo 3 sts, $k$ to end.
Row 2, WS: Bo 1 st, $p$ to end.
Repeat rows 1-2 a total of 2 times $=68$ sts.
Row 5, RS: Bo 2 sts, $k$ to end.
Row 6, WS: Bo 1 st, p to end.
Repeat rows 5-6 a total of 2 times $=62$ sts.
Row 9, RS: Bo 1 st, $k$ to end.
Row 10, WS: Bo 1 st, $p$ to end.
Repeat rows 9-10 a total of 9 times $=44$ sts.
Row 27, RS: Bo 1 st, $k$ to end.
Row 28, WS: Bo 2 sts, p to end.
Repeat rows 27-28 a total of 4 times $=32$ sts.
Row 35, RS: Bo 3 sts, $k$ to end.
Row 36, WS: Bo 3 sts, p to end.
Repeat rows 35-36 a total of 3 times $=14$ sts.
Bo.

## Size M

Row 1, RS: Bo 3 sts, $k$ to end.
Row 2, WS: Bo 1 st, $p$ to end.
Repeat rows 1-2 a total of 3 times $=70$ sts.
Row 7, RS: Bo 2 sts, k to end.
Row 8, WS: Bo 1 st, p to end.
Repeat rows 7-8 a total of 2 times $=64$ sts.
Row 11, RS: Bo 1 st, $k$ to end.
Row 12, WS: Bo 1 st, $p$ to end.
Repeat rows 11-12 a total of 8 times $=48$ sts.
Row 27, RS: Bo 1 st, $k$ to end.
Row 28, WS: Bo 2 sts, p to end.
Repeat rows 27-28 a total of 5 times $=33$ sts.
Row 37, RS: Bo 3 sts, $k$ to end.
Row 38, WS: Bo 3 sts, p to end.
Repeat rows 37-38 a total of 3 times $=15$ sts.
Bo.

## Size L

Row 1, RS: Bo 3 sts, $k$ to end.
Row 2, WS: Bo 1 st, p to end.
Repeat rows 1-2 a total of 3 times $=72$ sts.
Row 7, RS: Bo 2 sts, $k$ to end.
Row 8, WS: Bo 1 st, p to end.
Repeat rows 7-8 a total of 2 times $=66$ sts.
Row 11, RS: Bo 1 st, $k$ to end.
Row 12, WS: Bo $1 \mathrm{st}, \mathrm{p}$ to end.
Repeat rows 11-12 a total of 9 times $=48$ sts.
Row 29, RS: Bo 1 st, $k$ to end.
Row 30, WS: Bo 2 sts, p to end.
Repeat rows 29-30 a total of 5 times $=33$ sts.
Row 39, RS: Bo 3 sts, $k$ to end.
Row 40, WS: Bo 3 sts, p to end.
Repeat rows 39-40 a total of 3 times $=15$ sts.
Bo.

## Size XL

Row 1, RS: Bo 3 sts, $k$ to end.
Row 2, WS: Bo 1 st, p to end.
Repeat rows 1-2 a total of 3 times $=74$ sts.
Row 7, RS: Bo 2 sts, $k$ to end.
Row 8, WS: Bo 1 st, p to end.
Repeat rows 7-8 a total of 2 times $=68$ sts.
Row 11, RS: Bo 1 st, $k$ to end.
Row 12, WS: Bo 1 st, $p$ to end.
Repeat rows 11-12 a total of 11 times $=46$ sts.
Row 33, RS: Bo 1 st, k to end.
Row 34, WS: Bo 2 sts, p to end.
Repeat rows 33-34 a total of 4 times $=34$ sts.
Row 41, RS: Bo 3 sts, $k$ to end.
Row 42, WS: Bo 3 sts, $p$ to end.
Repeat rows 41-42 a total of 3 times $=16$ sts.
Bo.

Size 2XL
Row 1, RS: Bo 3 sts, $k$ to end.
Row 2, WS: Bo 1 st, $p$ to end.
Repeat rows 1-2 a total of 3 times $=78$ sts.
Row 7, RS: Bo 2 sts, $k$ to end.
Row 8, WS: Bo 1 st, p to end.
Repeat rows 7-8 a total of 2 times $=72$ sts.
Row 11, RS: Bo 1 st, $k$ to end.
Row 12, WS: Bo $1 \mathrm{st}, \mathrm{p}$ to end.
Repeat rows 11-12 a total of 12 times $=48$ sts.
Row 35, RS: Bo 1 st, $k$ to end.
Row 36, WS: Bo 2 sts, p to end.

Repeat rows 35-36 a total of 4 times $=36$ sts.
Row 43, RS: Bo 3 sts, $k$ to end.
Row 44, WS: Bo 3 sts, p to end.
Repeat rows 43-44 a total of 3 times $=18$ sts.
Bo.

## Size 3XL

Row 1, RS: Bo 3 sts, $k$ to end.
Row 2, WS: Bo 1 st, p to end.
Repeat rows 1-2 a total of 3 times $=80$ sts.
Row 7, RS: Bo 2 sts, $k$ to end.
Row 8, WS: Bo $1 \mathrm{st}, \mathrm{p}$ to end.
Repeat rows 7-8 a total of 2 times $=74$ sts.
Row 11, RS: Bo 1 st, $k$ to end.
Row 12, WS: Bo 1 st, $p$ to end.
Repeat rows 11-12 a total of 13 times $=48$ sts.
Row 37, RS: Bo 1 st, $k$ to end.
Row 38, WS: Bo 2 st, p to end.
Repeat rows 37-38 a total of 4 times $=36$ sts.
Row 45, RS: Bo 3 sts, $k$ to end.
Row 46, ws: Bo 3 sts, p to end.
Repeat rows 45-46 a total of 3 times $=18$ sts.
Bo.

## LEFT SLEEVE

Worked following the same procedure as for the right sleeve until the armhole and the work measures approx 17 ( $17,18,18,19,19$ cm / 6.7" (6.7", 7.1", 7.1", 7.5", 7.5"). End with a RS row.

## Armhole

Worked following the same procedure as for the right sleeve, but reversed. The 1st row is a WS row.

## COLLAR

Sew the shoulder seams together.
Place the 6 sts on the stitch holder on needle 3 mm (US 2.5), work the 6 sts in seed stitch and pick up approx $101(103,105,107,109,111)$ sts along the neckline, work the 6 sts on the stitch holder in seed stitch.

## Row with increases

Work in seed stitch while increasing like this: Work $16(17,18,19,21,22)$ sts, inc1 (= pick up the bar between the sts and $k$ it tbl), repeat *work 9 sts, inc1* a total of 10 times $=10 \mathrm{incs}$. Work to end = approx $123(125,127,129,131,133)$ sts.
Work 2 rows in seed stitch.

Change to needle 4 mm (US 6) and work in seed stitch until the collar measures $7 \mathrm{~cm}\left(2.8^{\prime \prime}\right)$. Bo in seed stitch.

## FINISHING

Remember that the right and left sleeve are not identical. Sew the sleeve onto the jumper while holding the middle part together.
Sew together the side and sleeve seams.
