# Christmas Hat

**Design: Sys Fredens** | Hobbii Design



#### **MATERIALS**

2 (2, 2) skeins of Snowstorm, color 10

Circular needle 9 mm (US 13) / 80 cm (32") Stitch markers

# YARN QUALITY

**5** Snowstorm, Hobbii 100 % Wool / 50 g (1.8 oz) = 50 m (55 yds)

#### **GAUGE**

11 stitches x 16 rounds = 10 cm (4'')

#### SIZE

Child (Teen, Adult)

# **MEASUREMENTS**

Circumference: approx. 51 (54, 58) cm / 20.1" (21.3", 22.8"), the width of the hat stretches Length: 37 (39, 41) cm / 14.6" (15.4", 16.1")

### **ABOUT THE PATTERN**

The hat is worked top down in stockinette stitch in the round with the magic loop technique.

The edge is worked in double rib worked through the back loop.

In the end, a tassel is attached to the top of the hat.

# **Pattern**







#### **HAT**

Cast on 6 (8, 10) stitches and work in stockinette stitch in the round with the magic loop technique.

**Round 1:** Repeat \*yarn over, knit 2\* 4 times = 4 yarn overs.

**Round 2:** Repeat \*knit the yarn over through the back loop, knit 2\* 4 times = 4 increased stitches = 10 (12, 14) stitches.

Round 3: Knit all stitches.

Round 4: Knit all stitches.

**Round 5:** Repeat \*yarn over, knit 3\* 4 times = 4 yarn overs.

**Round 6:** Repeat \*knit the yarn over through the back loop, knit 3\* 4 times = 4 stitches increased = 14 (16, 18) stitches.

Round 7: Knit all stitches.

**Round 8:** Knit all stitches.

Continue like this with 1 more stitch between the yarn overs on every 4th round.

Work until you have 54 (60, 66) stitches on the needle.

Work even without increasing until the work measures approx. 34 (36, 38) cm / 13.4" (14.2", 15").

#### **EDGE**

#### Decreases and rib through the back loop.

**Child:** \*Knit 2 through the back loop, purl 1, (knit 1 through the back loop, purl 1) 3 times\*, repeat from \* to \* 6 times =

6 stitches decreased= 48 stitches.

**Teen:** \*Knit 2 through the back loop, purl 1, (knit 1 through the back loop, purl 1) 3 times\*, repeat from \* to \* 6 times,

purl 1, knit 1 through the back loop = 6 stitches decreased = 54 stitches.

**Adult:** \*Knit 2 through the back loop, purl 1, (knit 1 through the back loop, purl 1) 3 times\*, repeat from \* to \* 6 times =

6 stitches decreased= 60 stitches.

#### All sizes

Work approx. 7 cm / 2.8" in rib like this: \*knit 1 through the back loop, purl 1\*. Bind off in rib.

Fold the edge on the middle so that the wrong side faces in and sew it onto the hat.



# **FINISHING**

Sew through the cast on stitches, tighten and weave in the end.

# **TASSEL:**

Prepare approx. 25 pieces of yarn with a length of 25 cm / 9.8".

Tie one of the threads around all the pieces on the middle, tighten and tie a knot. Do not cut off the ends

Fold the tassel and tie yarn around all threads 2-3 cm / 0.8-1.2" below the knot.

Attach the tassel to the top of the hat.
