MATERIALS


2 (3) 3 (3) 4 skein of Malaga # 01 - Col 1
2 (2) 3 (3) 4 skein of Malaga # 06 - Col 2
3 (3) 3 (4) 4 skein of Malaga # 13 - Col 3
1 skein of Fluffy Day # 01 - Col 4

Straight needles 4 mm (US 6) and 5 mm (US 7)
Circular needle 4 mm (US 6), 40 cm (16")

Tapestry needle

YARN QUALITY

 **Malaga**, World of yarn
100 % Premium HB Acrylic.
100 g (3,5 oz) = 165 m (180 yds)

 **Fluffy Day**, Hobbii
100 % Acrylic.
100 g (3.5 oz) = 285 m (310 yds)

GAUGE

10 cm x 10 cm (4" x 4") = 17 sts x 23 rows

NOTIONS

Edge stitch (edge st) = K first and last st on every row.
Make 1(M1) = Pick up strand between 2 sts, twist and k.

ABBREVIATIONS

BO = bind off
CO = cast on
K = knit
P = Purl
RS = right side
St/sts = stitch /stitches
St st = Stockinette stitch
WS = wrong side

SIZE

S (M) L (XL) XXL

MEASUREMENTS

Chest: 106 (114) 122 (130) 140 cm / 41.7" (44.9") 48" (51.2") 55"

Length: 68 (70) 72 (74) 76 cm / 26.8" (27.5") 28.3" (29") 30"

Length sleeve: 49 (50) 50 (51) 51 cm / 19.3" (19.7") 19.7" (20") 20"

PATTERN INFORMATION

Ho, ho, ho, time for a Christmas sweater. Julius Sweater is worked in separate pieces and sewn together. Nose, ears and horns are embroidered afterwards.

Pattern



BACK

With straight needles 4 mm (US 6) color 1, CO 105 (109) 117 (123) 131 sts. Work k1 p1 rib for 21 rows. First row is WS. Change to straight needles 5 mm (US 7). Work Stockinette sts inside one edge st in each side. On first row dec 10 sts evenly spaced = 95 (99) 107 (113) 121 sts.

Work 12 rows.

Next row RS: Change to color 2, cont. as follows: Edge st, St st 0 (1) 2 (1) 2 , chart 1 to last 1 (2) 3 (2) 3 sts, to color 2, St st 0 (1) 2 (1) 2 sts, edge st. Finish Chart 1.

Next row RS change to color 3. Work 18 (20) 20 (20) 22 rows.

Work chart 2 once.

Change to color 3. Work 7 rows.

Work chart 3 once.

Change to color 3. Work 12 rows.

Work chart 4 once.

Work to end with color 3.

NOTE! NECK: When work measures 65 (67) 69 (71) 73 cm BO 25 (25) 27 (27) 29 sts in center and finish each side separately.

Left side.

WS: Work to end.

RS: BO 2 sts, work to end.

WS: Work to end.

RS: BO 1 st, work to end.

WS: Work to end.

RS: BO remaining sts.

Right side: Work same as left side but mirrored.

BO for neck from WS.

FRONT

Work same as Back.

NOTE! Neck: When work measures 60 (62) 64 (66) 68 cm BO 15 (15) 17 (17) 19 sts in center for neck. Finish each side separately.

Right side: From RS BO every other row 3-2-1-1-1 sts. WS work to end. .

BO shoulder same as Back.

Left side: Work same as right side but mirrored. BO for neck from WS.

SLEEVES

Read through text before you begin.

Work 2 the same.

With straight needles 4 mm (US 6) and color 1, CO 46 (46) 48 (48) 48 sts. Work k1 p1 rib inside edge st in each side. First row is WS. Work 21 rows total. On last row dec 5 (3) 3 (3) 3 sts evenly spaced = 41 (43) 45 (45) 45 sts. Change to straight needles st 5 mm (US 7).

Work St st inside edge st in each side as follows:

Work 6 rows color 1

Chart 1 for 30 rows.

6 rows color 2.

Chart 2 for 8 rows.

Color 3 to end.

NOTE! When work measures 9 cm work inc-row:

Edge st, M1, work to last st, M1, edge st. Work 7 (7) 7 (5) 5 rows.

Rep inc-row another 11 (11) 12 (14) 15 times total = 65 (67) 71 (75) 77 sts. When work measures 49 (50) 50 (51) 51 cm BO ending with a WS row.

NOTE! When you work chart 2 you should have worked 5 (5) 5 (7) 7 inc-rows = 51 (53) 55 (59) 59 sts.

FINISHING

Block all pieces to measurements.

Sew shoulder seams.

Neckband: From RS, using circular needle 4 mm , 40 cm (US 6, 16") and color 3 PU 80 (80) 84 (84) 88 sts along neckline. Work k1 p1 rib. 14 rows. BO all sts. Fold neckband towards WS and sew,

Sew in sleeves. Sew seams on sleeves and sides.

Chart 1

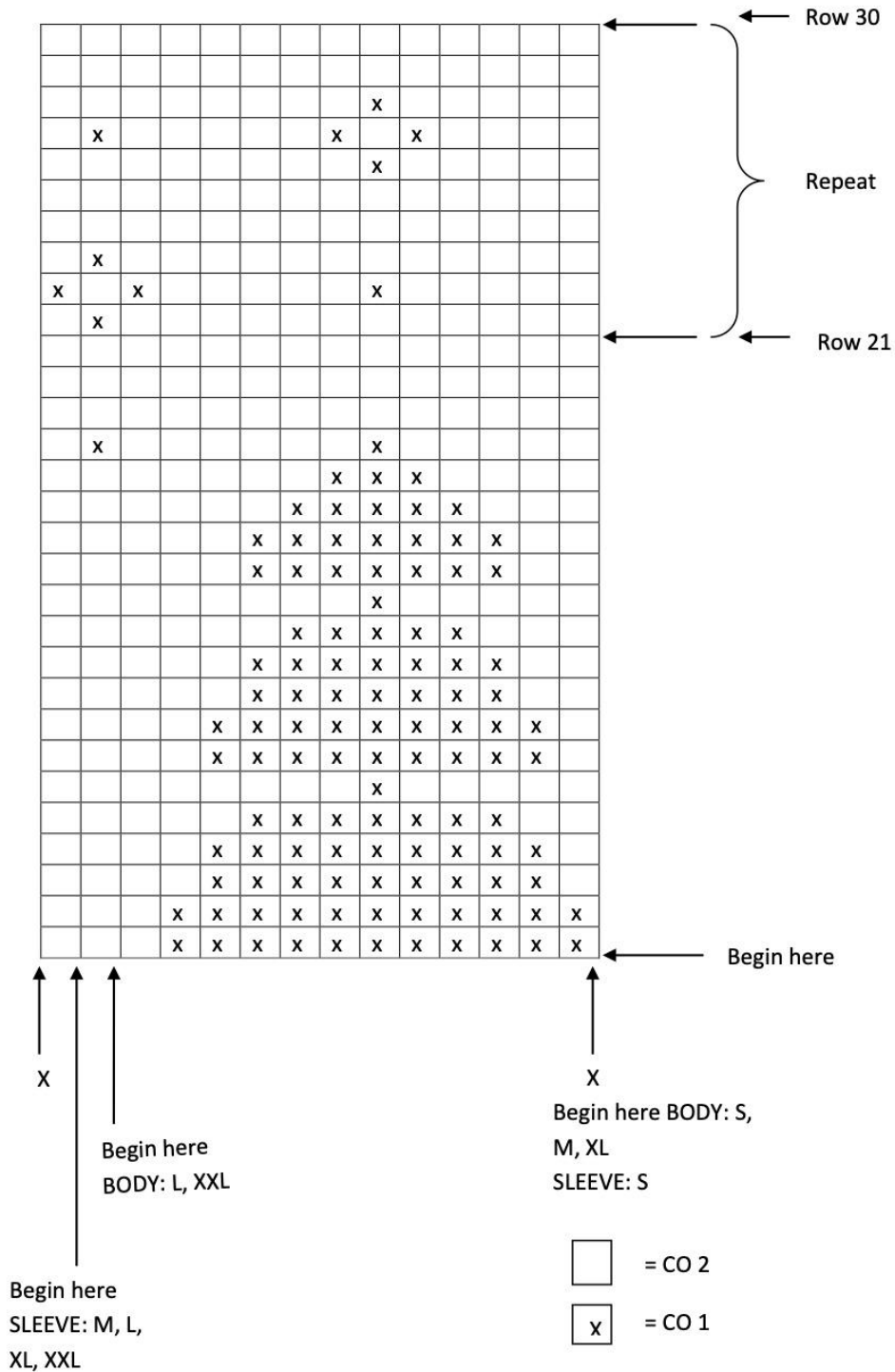
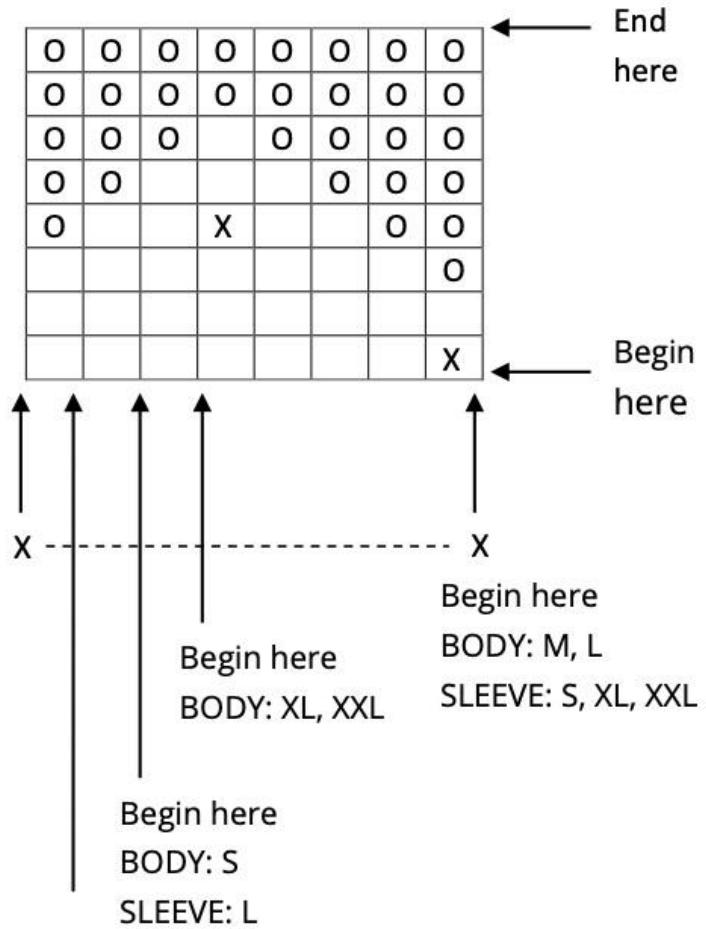


Chart 1 shows all rows. First row is RS.

Begin at arrows for your size, repeat X-X over the number of sts mentioned in the text.

ROWS: Begin at arrow, work row 1-20. Repeat row 21-30 for 20 rows total.

Chart 2

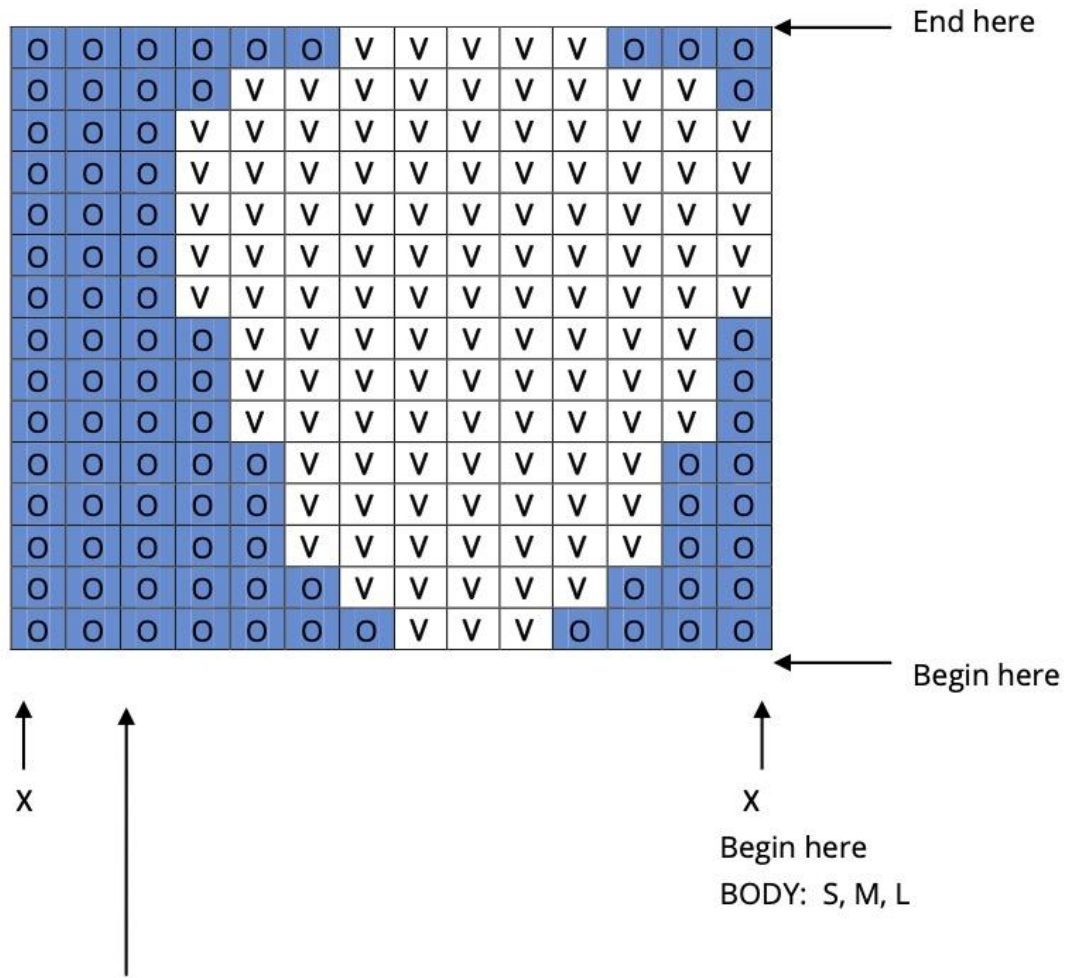


Begin here
SLEEVE: M

- COLOR 2
- X COLOR 1
- O COLOR 3

Chart 2 shows all rows. First row is RS.
Begin at arrows. Repeat X-X.
Work chart 2 once.

Begin here
BODY: XL, XXL

Chart 2 shows all rows. First row is RS.

Begin at arrows. Repeat X-X.
Work chart once.

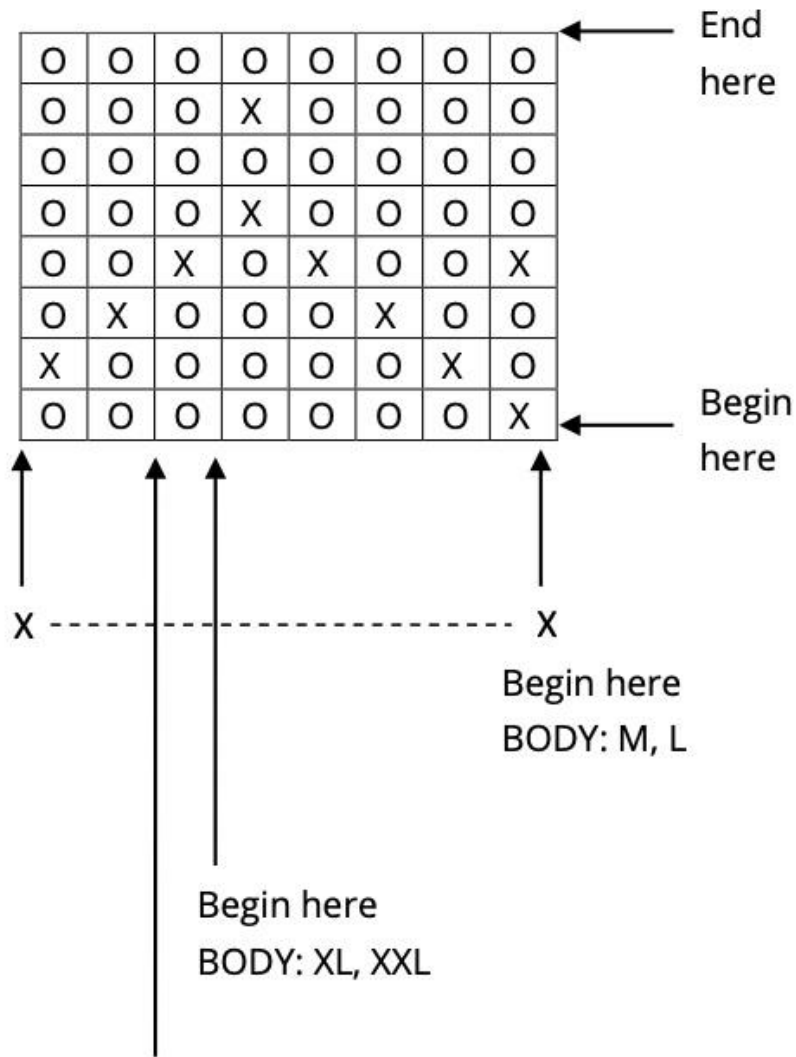


Chart 4 shows all rows.
