L'amour

Vest

MATERIALS

4 (4) 5 skeins of Divina color Classic Grey 04
1 (1) 1 skein of Divina color Dusty Violet 19

Knitting needles 5 mm (US 8)
Stitch markers
Yarn sewing needle

YARN QUALITY

 **Divina**, Hobbii
65% alpaca, 25% polyamide, 10% wool
50 g (1.75 oz) = 150 m (164 yds)

GAUGE

10 cm x 10 cm (4" x 4") = 20 sts x 30 rows

ABBREVIATIONS

k = knit
p = purl
CO = cast on
BO = bind off
st/s = stitch/s
k2tog = knit 2 together

SIZE

S (M) L

MEASUREMENTS

Width: 54 (59) 64 cm / 21.2" (23.2") 25.1"
Length: 45 (50) 55 cm / 17.7" (19.6") 21.6"

PATTERN INFORMATION

Wonderfully soft vest, with heart motifs on the front and back.

Simple, fun and quick to make.

INFO AND TIPS

Stitches used in this pattern:

Stockinette stitch- k on the right side, p on the wrong side.

Seed stitch- knits and purls that alternate horizontally and vertically, i.e.:

row 1: k1, p1 to the end,

row 2: p1, k1 to the end.

BODY

Back Piece

CO 109 (119) 129 sts. Knit 6 rows in seed stitch. Rows in seed stitch are treated as a rib, they do not count.

Rows 1 - 37 (52) 67: knit in stockinette stitch.

Rows 38 (53) 68 - 39 (55) 71: knit the first and the last 8 sts in seed stitch.

Now you will start shaping the armholes.

Row 40 (56) 72: in every 2nd row BO on both sides consecutively 5 sts, 3 sts, 1 st, 1 st, 1 st, at the same time at the beginning and at the end of each row knit in seed stitch as follows: 1 edge st, 4 seed sts.

In the 72nd (87th) 92nd row start to work the heart motif with Dusty Violet color according to the **diagram 1**.

Now you need to work in seed stitch only 23 sts above the heart. So, with stitch markers mark the center line of sts in the heart indentation, then the 11th st to the right and the 11th st to the left.

Work the next 4 rows in stockinette stitch but those marked 23 sts in seed stitch.

Now you will start to create the neckline.

BO the middle 23 sts. Then, on both sides consecutively

S: 5 sts, 3 sts, 3 sts, 1 st.

M: 3 sts, 3 sts, 1 st.

L: 1 st, 1, st

Continue working, in the 132nd (150th) 162nd row BO all of the sts on each shoulder [20 (30) 40 sts].

Front Right

CO 48 (58) 68 sts. Knit 6 rows in seed stitch.

Row 1 and all odd rows, up to armholes work as follows: 1 edge st, 4 sts in seed stitch, continue in stockinette stitch, 1 edge st.

Row 2 and all even rows up to armholes work as follows: 1 edge st, continue in stockinette stitch, last 4 sts in seed stitch, 1 edge st.

Remember, the seed stitches rows do not count.

Row 37 (53) 67: work the last 8 sts in seed stitch.

Row 38 (54) 68: work the first 8 sts in seed stitch.

Row 39 (55) 69: work the last 8 sts in seed stitch.

Now you will start shaping the armholes.

Row 40 (56) 70: in every 2nd row BO consecutively 5 sts, 3 sts, 1 st, 1 st.

Work the edge of the armholes in seed stitch so that there are always 1 edge st and 4 sts in seed stitch.

Now you will start to create the neckline.

Row 47 (65) 77 start to decrease: 1 edge st, 4 sts in seed stitch, k2tog, continue in stockinette stitch, last 4 sts in seed st, 1 edge st. Repeat in every 6th row, 3 times.

Decrease in this way in every 4th row, 4 times.

Then alternately, in the 2nd row and in the 4th row 5 times.

Work 15 more rows, without decreasing, so that there are always 1 edge st and 4 sts in seed stitch on the edge.

In the 132nd (150th) 162nd row BO all of the sts on each shoulder [20 (30) 40 sts].

Front Left

Work symmetrically to the right front.

CO 48 (58) 68 sts. Knit 6 rows in seed stitch.

Row 1 and all odd rows: 1 edge st, continue in stockinette stitch, last 4 sts in seed stitch, 1 edge st.

Row 2 all even rows: 1 edge st, 4 sts in seed stitch, continue in stockinette stitch, 1 edge st.

Work a total of 6 rows in this way.

Now you will start to work the small heart motif.

Row 7: 1 edge st, 15 sts in stockinette stitch, first heart st in Dusty Violet color, continue in stockinette stitch, last 4 st in seed stitch, 1 edge st.

Continue like the right front working the heart motif according to the diagram 2.

Sew the shoulders and sides of the vest with mattress stitch.

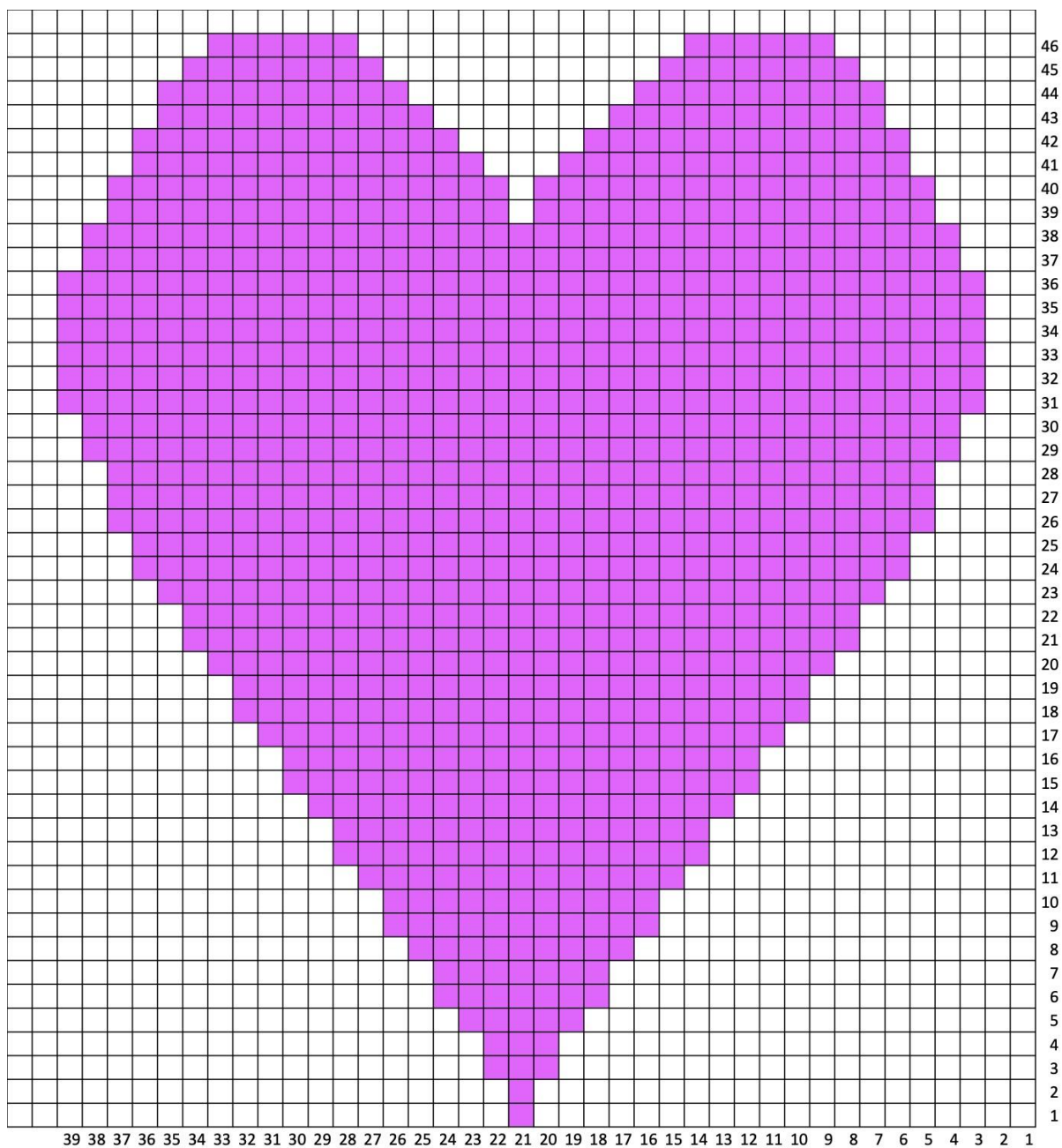
