MATERIALS

4 (4) 5 skein(s) of Malaga color 04
1 (1) 1 skein of Alpaca Blaze color 05/Ash
Brown
1 (1) 1 skein of Alpaca Blaze color
42/Boysenberry

Crochet hook 4.5 mm (US H/8)
Crochet hook 5 mm (US I/9)
Stitch markers

YARN QUALITY

 **Malaga**, World of yarn
100% premium acrylic
100 g (3.5 oz) = 165 g (180 yds)

 **Alpaca Blaze**, Hobbii
40 % acrylic, 30% alpaca, 30% polyamide
25g (0.9 oz) = 225m (246 yds)

GAUGE

10 cm x 10 cm (4" x 4") = 14 sts x 12 rows

ABBREVIATIONS

ch = chain
sc = single crochet
hdc = half double crochet
dc = double crochet
BPdc = back post double crochet
sl st = slip stitch
inc = increase
dec = decrease

SIZE

S (M) L

MEASUREMENTS

Width: 45 (50) 55 cm / 17.7" (19.6") 21.6"
Length: 45 (45) 50 cm / 17.7" (17.7") 19.6"

PATTERN INFORMATION

This short sweater with a decorative yoke is worked in the round. The yoke is made of different types of yarn.

INFO AND TIPS

The sweater is worked from top to bottom. In the beginning, making the yoke, you join the rounds, then you work rounds without joining.

Use the invisible color change technique when finishing the round.

First ch 2 does not count as the first hdc, start each round with hdc in ch 2 spot.

As you begin to crochet the rounds without joining, remember to put the stitch marker in the beginning and move it each time you start the new round.

Puff stitch: insert the hook, pull out the loop to about 1 cm, *yo, insert the hook into the ch st, pick up the yarn* repeat from * to * 6 times, yo and pull through all the loops on the hook.

BODY

With Malaga yarn ch 76 (84) 84 with hook 4.5 (US H/8) join the ring with the sl st in the first ch.

Round 1: ch 2, hdc around, join with sl st = 76 (84) 84

Round 2: ch 2, hdc inc in every 9th (10th) 10th st, join with sl st/change yarn to **Alpaca Blaze Boysenberry** = 84 (92) 92

Round 3: ch 2, dc inc in every 10th (11th) 11th st, join with sl st/change yarn to **Alpaca Blaze Ash Brown** = 92 (100) 100

Round 4: ch 2, 1 hdc, *PUFF, 2 hdc* repeat from * to * around, join with sl st/change yarn to **Alpaca Blaze Boysenberry** = 92 (100) 100

Round 5: ch 2, hdc inc in every 11th (12th) 8th st, join with sl st/change yarn to **Malaga** = 100 (108) 112

Round 6: ch 1, sc around, join with sl st/change yarn to **Alpaca Blaze Boysenberry** = 100 (108) 112

Round 7: ch 2, BPdc inc in every 6th (7th) 7th st, join with sl st/change yarn to **Alpaca Blaze Ash Brown** = 116 (124) 128

Round 8: ch 2, BPdc around, join with sl st = 116 (124) 128

Round 9: ch 2, hdc inc in every 7th (8th) 8th st, join with sl st /change yarn to **Alpaca Blaze**

Boysenberry = 132 (140) 144

Round 10: ch 2, 2 dc, PUFF, *3 dc, PUFF* repeat from * to * around, join with sl st/change yarn

to **Alpaca Blaze Ash Brown** = 132 (140) 144

Round 11: ch 2, 3 hdc, hdc inc in every Puff st around, join with sl st/change yarn to **Alpaca**

Blaze Boysenberry = 165 (175) 180

Round 12: ch 2, BPhdc around, join with sl st = 165 (175) 180

Round 13: ch 2, BPdc inc in every 11th (10th) 11th, join with sl st/change yarn to **Alpaca**

Blaze Ash Brown = 180 (192) 196

Round 14: ch 2, dc around, join with sl st/change yarn to **Malaga** = 180 (192) 196

Change to 5 mm (US I/9) hook. Work without joining, remember to put the stitch marker in the beginning of the round.

Round 15-19: hdc around

Round 20: Size S/M hdc around, size L hdc inc in every 12th st = 180 (192) 212

Round 21: Place stitch markers at 4 points to mark the armholes:

Size S front and back piece 40 sts, armholes 50 sts,

Size M front and back piece 43 sts, armholes 53 sts,

Size L front and back piece 50 sts, armholes 56 sts.

Now, attach the yarn with sl st under the armpit where the marker is and make underarm chain stitches 10 (10) 12, join with sl st where the second marker is placed, cut the yarn and repeat at the other side.

Round 22-42 (L 47): work 20 (20) 25 rows in hdc around, without joining.

Round 43: hdc dec every 4 sts. Finish the round with 1 sl st.

SLEEVES

Now you will start to work the sleeves with hook 5 (US I/9)

Attache the yarn under the armpit, work hdc around the armhole without joining (remember to replace the marker) = 40 rounds.

Round 41: hdc dec around.

Make a second sleeve in the same way.

Secure all ends.
