# Forst

## Hat

Design: Katharina Müller - My Favourite Stitches | Hobbii Design



## MATERIALS

2 skeins of Tweed Delight, col White Marble (01)

Circular needle 5 mm (US 8) - 60 cm (24")

Pompon with button, white

## YARN QUALITY

 **Tweed Delight**, Hobbii

85 % Superwash Wool, 10 % Acrylic, 5 % Viscose / 50 g (1.8 oz) = 100 m (109 yds)

## GAUGE

23 sts x 26 rows in rib (k1, p1) with needle 5 mm (US 8) = 10 cm (4")

## ABBREVIATIONS

st(s) = stitch(es)

k = knit

p = purl

rnd(s) = round(s)

sl1k = slip 1 stitch knitwise

k2tog = knit 2 stitches together

co = cast on

col = color(s)

## SIZES

Child (Woman) Man

## MEASUREMENTS

Head circumference: 50-53 cm (54-58 cm)  
58-62 cm / 19.7-20.9" (21.3-22.8") 22.8-24.4"

Length: approx 22 (24) 26 cm / 8.7" (9.4")  
10.2"

Width: 19 (20) 22 cm / 7.5" (7.9") 8.3"

## ABOUT THE PATTERN

The hat is worked in rib in the round using the magic loop technique.

If you prefer not to use magic loop, you can use long double pointed needles instead.

# Pattern



- Co 88 (96) 104 sts with circular needle 5 mm (US 8). Work in the round.
- Work in rib (k1, p1) until the work measures 17 (19) 20 cm / 6.7" (7.5") 7.9" measured from the cast on edge.
- Place a marker after:

Child: 22, 44, 66 and 88 sts (i.e. after every 22 sts)

Woman: 24, 48, 72 and 96 sts (i.e. after every 24 sts)

Man: 26, 52, 78 and 104 sts (i.e. after every 26 sts)

Now you begin to decrease. Decrease before and after each marker like this:

- \*Work in rib until 2 sts before marker, s1k, k1, pass over the slipped st, move the marker, k2tog. Continue like this to the end of the rnd.
- Work the next rnd in rib.\*
- Repeat from \* to \* until 32 (40) 40 sts remain on the needle.
- K2tog throughout the rnd until 10 sts remain.
- Pull the thread through the remaining sts and weave in the ends.
- Attach the pompon.
- Put the hat on and keep your ears warm :-)
