# Nanna

Sweater with relief pattern

## MATERIALS

All sizes:  
2 skeins of Winter Glow, col 03, **A**  
2 skeins of Winter Glow Solid, col 24, **B**

Circular needle 5 mm (US 8) - 80 cm (32")  
Stitch markers  
Stitch holders

## YARN QUALITY

 **Winter Glow**, Hobbii  
51 % Wool, 49 % Acrylic / 200 g (7 oz) = 700 m  
(766 yds)

 **Winter Glow Solid**, Hobbii  
51 % Wool, 49 % Acrylic / 100 g (3.5 oz) = 350 m  
(383 yds)

## GAUGE

17 sts x 28 rnds/rows  
in pattern = 10 cm (4")

## ABBREVIATIONS

st(s) = stitch(es)  
k = knit  
p = purl  
tbl = through the back loop  
rnd(s) = round(s)  
RS = right side  
WS = wrong side  
yo(s) = yarnover(s)  
co = cast on  
bo = bind off  
col = color(s)

## SIZE

S (M, L, XL, 2XL, 3XL)

## MEASUREMENTS

Width: 46 (50, 53, 58, 62, 66) cm / 18.1" (19.7",  
20.1", 22.8", 24.4", 26")  
Length: 53 (54, 55, 56, 57, 58) cm / 20.8"  
(21.3", 21.7", 22", 22.4", 22.8") measured  
at the side seam

## ABOUT THE PATTERN

The sweater is longer on the back and  
shaped with short rows.  
A pattern is worked over 4 rounds/rows  
throughout the work.  
The sleeves are worked separately.

# Pattern



## PATTERN

### In the flat on circular needle

Seed stitch, 2 strands of yarn held together:

Row 1, RS: Repeat \*k1, p1\* to end with col A and B (2 strands).

Row 2, WS: Repeat \*p on k, k on p\* to end with col A and B.

Stockinette stitch, 1 strand:

Row 3, RS: K to end with col A.

Row 4, WS: P to end with col A.

Repeat rows 1-4.

### In the round on circular needle

Seed stitch, 2 strands of yarn held together:

Rnd 1: Repeat \*k1, p1\* to end with col A and B.

Rnd 2: Repeat \*p on k, k on p\* to end with col A and B.

Stockinette stitch, 1 strand:

Rnd 3: K to end with col A.

Rnd 4: K to end with col A.

Repeat rnds 1-4.

## LOWER BACK

### Hem

Co 157 (169, 181, 197, 209, 225) sts with col A and B (2 strands held together) and work in the round.

Work 4 rnds in **pattern - in the round on circular needle**.

Cut off both yarns.

Place a marker **X** at the beginning of the rnd (right side seam) and a marker **Y** midway through the rnd (left side seam) = 2 markers = 78 (84, 90, 98, 104, 112) sts for the back piece and 79 (85, 91, 99, 105, 113) sts for the front piece.

Place another marker **Z** at the middle of the back piece.

Move the sts so that the tips of the needles are placed 16 (18, 20, 16, 18, 16) sts AFTER marker **Z**.

Turn the work.

Shape the lower back with short rows.

Work **pattern - in the flat on circular needle**.

**Row 1, WS:** Work 32 (36, 40, 32, 36, 32) sts in seed stitch with col A and B, turn (the remaining sts are worked later).



**Row 2, RS:** Work 32 (36, 40, 32, 36, 32) sts in seed stitch with col A and B, move 4 (4, 4, 5, 5, 6) sts to the right needle (be careful not to tighten the strands), turn (the remaining sts are worked later).

**Row 3, WS:** P 40 (44, 48, 42, 46, 44) sts with col A, turn.

**Row 4, RS:** K 40 (44, 48, 42, 46, 44) sts with col A, move 4 (4, 4, 5, 5, 6) sts to the right needle, turn.

**Row 5, WS:** Work 48 (52, 56, 52, 56, 56) sts in seed stitch with col A and B, turn.

**Row 6, RS:** Work 48 (52, 56, 52, 56, 56) sts in seed stitch with col A and B, move 4 (4, 4, 5, 5, 6) sts to the right needle, turn.

**Row 7, WS:** P 56 (60, 64, 62, 66, 68) sts with col A, turn.

**Row 8, RS:** K 56 (60, 64, 62, 66, 68) sts with col A, move 4 (4, 4, 5, 5, 6) sts to the right needle, turn.

Continue working 4 (4, 4, 5, 5, 6) more sts on each side in pattern (in the flat on circular needle) until you have worked a total of 28 rows after the hem. End with 2 rows of stockinette stitch.

Cut off both yarns.

## BODY

Move the sts so that the tips of the needles are placed at marker **X** = beginning of the rnd (remove the other markers).

Work all sts in **pattern - in the round on circular needle** = 157 (169, 181, 197, 209, 225) sts.

Work in pattern until the work measures 36 cm (14.2") from the cast on edge at the side seam. End with 2 rnds of seed stitch.

Now the work is divided for the armholes. From here, the back piece and front piece are worked separately.

## BACK PIECE

Work the 78 (84, 90, 98, 104, 112) sts of the back piece in **pattern - in the flat on circular needle** until the armhole measures 15 (16, 17, 18, 19, 20) cm / 5.9" (6.3", 6.7", 7.1", 7.5", 7.9") and the work measures 53 (54, 55, 56, 57, 58) cm / 20.8" (21.3", 21.7", 22", 22.4", 22.8") from the cast on edge at the side seam.

End with k 1 row with col A.

Bo all sts purlwise from the WS.

## FRONT PIECE

Work the 79 (85, 91, 99, 105, 113) sts of the front piece in **pattern - in the flat on circular needle** until the work measures 45 (46, 47, 48, 49, 50) cm / 17.7" (18.1", 18.5", 18.9", 19.3", 19.7") from the cast on edge at the side seam.

End with k 1 row with col A.

## Neckline, right-hand side

Slip the first st before each bind off.

**WS:** Work 31 (33, 36, 40, 43, 46) sts, turn and put the remaining sts on hold.

**RS:** Bo 2 (2, 2, 3, 3, 3) sts and work to end.

**WS:** Work pattern to end.

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**WS:** Work pattern to end.

From here, bo 1 st at the beginning of each RS row until 24 (26, 28, 32, 34, 36) sts remain for the shoulder.

Work even until the work measures 53 (54, 55, 56, 57, 58) cm / 20.9" (21.3", 21.7", 22", 22.4", 22.8") measured at the side seam.

Place a marker at the sleeve side = the middle of the shoulder.

Work for 2 cm (0.8"). End with k 1 row with col A.

Bo purlwise from the WS.

### Neck opening

Place 17 (19, 19, 19, 19, 21) sts on a stitch holder.

### Neckline, left-hand side

Slip the first st before each bind off.

**WS:** Bo 2 (2, 2, 3, 3, 3) sts and work to end.

**RS:** Work pattern to end.

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**RS:** Work pattern to end.

From here, bo 1 st at the beginning of each WS row until 24 (26, 28, 32, 34, 36) sts remain for the shoulder.

Work even until the work measures 53 (54, 55, 56, 57, 58) cm / 20.9" (21.3", 21.7", 22", 22.4", 22.8") measured at the side seam.

Place a marker at the sleeve side = the middle of the shoulder.

Work for 2 cm (0.8"). End with k 1 row with col A.

Bo purlwise from the WS.

## SLEEVES

### Hem

Co 42 (44, 44, 46, 46, 48) sts with col A and B (2 strands held together) and work in the round with the magic loop technique.

Work **pattern - in the round on circular needle**. Place a marker at the beginning of the rnd.

Work 10 rnds. End with 2 rnds with color A and B.

**Increase sts like this:** K1, yo, k until 1 st remains on the rnd, yo, k1 = 2 yos.

**Next rnd:** K yos tbl.

Increase on every 8th rnd until you have 62 (64, 68, 70, 72, 74) sts.

Work until the work measures approx 40 cm (15.7"). End with k 1 row with col A.

Bo purlwise from the WS.

Same procedure for the other sleeve.

## FINISHING

Sew the shoulder seams together.

Sew the sleeves onto the armholes.

### Neckline

Pick up approx 69 (73, 75, 79, 81, 83) sts along the neckline with col A and B (2 strands held together).

Work 2 rnds in seed stitch. Bo in seed stitch.
