## **MATERIALS**

1 skein of Judy, color 01, **A** 1 skein of Judy, color 13, **B** 1 skein of Judy, color 05, **C** 

Circular needle US 4 (3.5 mm) and US 7 (4.5 mm), 23.6" (60 cm)

# **YARN QUALITY**

**Judy,** Hobbii 100% Jute / 1.75 oz (50 g) = 77 yds (70 m)

#### **GAUGE**

12 sts x 30 rows in stockinette stitch with needle US 7 (4.5 mm) = 4'' (10 cm)

#### **SIZES**

Onesize

#### **MEASUREMENTS**

Height: approx 5.5" (14 cm) Diameter: approx 7.9" (20 cm)

#### **ABOUT THE PATTERN**

The basket is worked in the flat with a brioche stitch stripe.

# K1b (brioche stitch stripe)

Knit the stitch in the row below.

# **Pattern**







# **Edge**

Co 79 sts with color **C** on circular needle US 4 (3.5 mm). Work 21 rows in the flat. The last row is a WS row. Change to circular needle US 7 (4.5 mm) and work 1 row with color **A**.

#### **Basket**

Pattern repeat WS row: k all sts.

**RS row:** k3, \*k1b, k5\*, repeat from \* to \* a total of 12 times, k1b, k3.

Work **pattern** and stripes like this:

8 rows with color A.

2 rows with color **B**.

8 rows with color A.

2 rows with color **B.** 

8 rows with color A.

2 rows with color B.

8 rows with color A.

Change to color B.

#### **Bottom**

K 1 row while increasing 1 st (= 80 sts).

Row 1: k4, \*k2tog, k8\*, repeat from \* to \* until 6 sts remain, k2tog, k the rest of the row. Row 2: k all sts.

Row 3: k4, k2tog, k7\*, repeat from \* to \* until 5 sts remain, k2tog, k the rest of the row.

Row 4: k all sts.

Row 5: k4, \*k2tog, k6\*, repeat from \* to \* until 4 sts remain, k2tog, k the rest of the row.

Row 6: k all sts.

Row 7: k4, \*k2tog, k5\*, repeat from \* to \* until 3 sts remain, k2tog, k the rest of the row.



Row 8: k all sts.

Row 9: k4, \*k2tog, k4\*, repeat from \* to \* until 2 sts remain, k2tog.

Row 10: k all sts.

Row 11: k3, \*k2tog, k3\*, repeat from \* to \* until 2 sts remain, k2tog.

Row 12: k all sts.

Row 13: k2, \*k2tog, k2\*, repeat from \* to \*, k2tog.

Row 14: k all sts.

Row 15: k1, \*k2tog, k1\*, repeat from \* to \*, k2tog.

Row 16: k all sts.

Row 17: \*k2tog\*, repeat from \* to \*.

Row 18: k all sts.

Cut off the yarn and pull the thread through the remaining sts.

Weave in the ends. Sew the side of the basket together. Fold the edge on the middle so that the WS faces out and sew the edge onto the basket.
