Sweater in fisherman's rib

MATERIALS

4 (4, 5, 5) skeins of Fluffy Day, color 02

Circular needle 32" (80 cm)/ size 8 (5 mm)

Stitch markers in different colors

Stitch wires

YARN QUALITY

 **Fluffy Day**, Hobbii

100% acrylic/3.8 oz. (100 g) = 312 yds (285 meters)

GAUGE

16 sts and 24 rounds for 4" (10 cm) on a size 8 (5 mm) needle in stockinette st.

13 sts and 36 rounds for 4" (10 cm) on a size 8 (5 mm) needle in fisherman's rib.

SIZES

S (M, L, XL)

MEASUREMENTS

Width: 17.3" (18.9", 20½", 22.1") or 44 (48, 52, 56) cm

Length: 22.4" (23.3", 24.4", 25.2") or 57 (59, 62, 64) cm

PATTERN INFORMATION

The sweater is knitted in fisherman's rib in the round on a circular needle, top down. The yoke has got increases in fisherman's rib. The sleeves and the body are finished separately.

The hems are knitted in stockinette st and is laid double.

EXPLANATIONS

Fisherman's rib stitch

The fisherman's rib stitch is a stitch with a yarn over that are knitted or purled together.

1 fisherman's rib stitch increase (on the knitted fisherman's rib stitch round)

Knit like this in a fisherman's rib st: k1 fisherman's rib st, leave st on left needle, yo, k1 fisherman's rib st.

YOKE

NECKBAND

The neckband and the yoke are knitted similarly in all sizes up to and including the 8th increase.

Cast on 64 sts loosely and knit stockinette st in the round using magic loop until the hem measures approx. 5.1" (13 cm).

Fold the hem wrong side to wrong side, *knit 1 st from the needle and 1 st from the cast on row together kw*, repeat * - * around.

Note Opt. you can sew it together later.

Place a marker at the beginning of the round.

Yoke

Continue in fisherman's rib like this:

1st round: *yo, sl 1 pw, k1*, repeat * - * around.

Note every other stitch is now a stitch with a yo = fisherman's rib st and a regular st.

When you're knitting fisherman's rib in the round, you knit a round where you purl the fisherman's rib st and one where you knit the fisherman's rib st.

2nd round, purled fisherman's rib: *purl the fisherman's rib st, yo, sl 1 pw*, repeat * - * around.

Markings for 1st increase

Place a marker around the 4th st (which is a fisherman's rib st), *skip 7 sts, place a marker around the next fisherman's rib st*, repeat * - * all in all 8 times = 8 marked sts.

1st round, fisherman's rib st kw: knit 3 sts fisherman's rib, 1 fisherman's rib inc in the marked st, *knit 7 fisherman's rib, 1 fisherman's rib st inc in the marked st*, repeat * - * until there are 8 increases, knit fisherman's rib around.

2nd round, purled fisherman's rib: *knit fisherman's rib to the st with the increase, knit like this in the st: yo, sl1 pw, purl the yo, yo, sl 1 pw*, repeat * - * around = 16 sts inc = 80 sts.

Work 8 rounds of fisherman's rib. Finish with a round of purled fisherman's rib.

Markings for 2nd increase

Place a marker around the 6th st (the left fisherman's rib st of the inc), *count 9 sts on and place a marker around the fisherman's rib st*, repeat * - * around = 8 new markers.

1st round: k5, 1 fisherman's rib st inc in the marked st, *9 sts, 1 fisherman's rib inc in the marked st*, repeat * - * around.

2nd round: *knit fisherman's rib to the st with the inc, knit like this in the st: yo, sl 1 pw, purl the yo, yo, sl 1 pw*, repeat * - * around = 16 sts inc = 96 sts.

Work 8 rounds of fisherman's rib. Finish with a round of purled fisherman's rib.

Markings for 3rd increase

Place a marker around the 6th st (the right fisherman's rib st of the inc), *count 11 sts on and place a marker around the fisherman's rib st*, repeat * - * around = 8 new markers.

1st round: k5, 1 fisherman's rib inc in the marked st, *11 sts, inc in the marked st*, repeat * - * around.

2nd round: *knit fisherman's rib to the st with the inc, knit like this in the st: yo, sl 1 pw, purl the yo, yo, sl 1 pw*, repeat * - * around = 16 sts inc = 112 sts.

Work 8 rounds of fisherman's rib. Finish with a round of purled fisherman's rib.

Markings for 4th increase

Place a marker around the 8th st (the left fisherman's rib st of the inc), *count 13 sts on and place a marker around the fisherman's rib st*, repeat * - * around = 8 new markers.

1st round: 1 fisherman's rib st inc in the marked sts = 16 sts inc = 128 sts.

2nd round: knit like 2nd round in the 3rd inc.

Work 8 rounds of fisherman's rib. Finish with a round of purled fisherman's rib.

Markings for 5th increase

Place a marker around the 8th st (the right fisherman's rib st of the inc), *count 15 sts on and place a marker around the fisherman's rib st*, repeat * - * around = 8 new markers.

1st round: Inc 1 fisherman's rib st in the marked sts = 144 sts.

2nd round: knit like 2nd round in the 3rd inc.

Work 8 rounds of fisherman's rib. Finish with a round of purled fisherman's rib.

Markings for 6th increase

Place a marker around the 10th st (the left fisherman's rib st of the inc), *count 17 sts on and place a marker around the fisherman's rib st*, repeat * - * around = 8 new markers.

1st round: Inc 1 fisherman's rib st in the marked sts = 160 sts.

2nd round: knit like 2nd round in the 3rd inc.

Work 8 rounds of fisherman's rib. Finish with a round of purled fisherman's rib.

Markings for 7th increase

Place a marker around the 10th st (the right fisherman's rib st of the inc), *count 19 sts on and place a marker around the fisherman's rib st*, repeat * - * around = 8 new markers.

1st round: Inc 1 fisherman's rib st in the marked sts = 176 sts.

2nd round: knit like 2nd round in the 3rd inc.

Work 8 rounds of fisherman's rib. Finish with a round of purled fisherman's rib.

Markings for 8th increase

Place a marker around the 12th st (the left fisherman's rib st of the inc), *count 21 sts on and place a marker around the fisherman's rib st*, repeat * - * around = 8 new markers.

1st round: Inc 1 fisherman's rib st in the marked sts = 192 sts.

2nd round: knit like 2nd round in the 3rd inc.

Work 8 rounds of fisherman's rib. Finish with a round of purled fisherman's rib.

Only sizes M, L and XL

Marking for 9th increase

Place a marker around the 12th st (the right fisherman's rib st of the inc), *count 23 sts on and place a marker around the fisherman's rib st*, repeat * - * around = 8 new markers.

1st round: Inc 1 fisherman's rib st in the marked sts = 208 sts.

2nd round: knit like 2nd round in the 3rd inc.

Work 6 rounds of fisherman's rib. Finish with a round of purled fisherman's rib.

Only sizes L and XL

Markings for 10th increase

Place a marker around the 14th st (the left fisherman's rib st of the inc), *count 25 sts on and place a marker around the fisherman's rib st*, repeat * - * around = 8 new markers.

1st round: Inc 1 fisherman's rib st in the marked sts = 224 sts.

2nd round: knit like 2nd round in the 3rd inc.

Work 6 rounds of fisherman's rib. Finish with a round of purled fisherman's rib.

Only size XL

Markings for 11th increase

Place a marker around the 14th st (the right fisherman's rib st of the inc), *count 27 sts on and place a marker around the fisherman's rib st*, repeat * - * around = 8 new markers.

1st round: Inc 1 fisherman's rib st in the marked sts = 240 sts.

2nd round: knit like 2nd round in the 3rd inc.

Work 6 rounds of fisherman's rib. Finish with a round of purled fisherman's rib.

All sizes

Here the work is separated into sleeves and body.

Note please take care that the stitch counts are the same from the increases for sleeves.

BODY

Knit 52 (56, 62, 68) sts for front, place 44 (48, 50, 52) sts aside on a wire, cast on 6 sts using a knitted cast on in the armhole, knit 52 (56, 62, 68) sts for back, place 44 (48, 50, 52) sts aside

on a wire, cast on 6 sts using a knitted cast on in the armhole = 116 (124, 136, 148) sts for body.

Knit fisherman's rib over the sts of the body until the work measures approx. 10" (25 cm) from the armhole (the hem measures approx. 2.4" (6 cm))

Sweater hem

Continue in the round in stockinette st as the fisherman's rib st is knitted as a st, until the hem measures 5.1" (13 cm). Bind off loosely.

Fold the hem to the wrong side and sew the bind off edge to the transition from fisherman's rib to stockinette st.

SLEEVES

Place the sleeve sts on the circular needle, knit up 6 sts in the armhole and knit in the round using magic loop in fisherman's rib = 50 (54, 56, 58) sts.

Place a marker in the center of the armhole around a fisherman's rib st.

Knit 2.4" (2.4", 1.6", 1.6") or 6 (6, 4, 4) cm. Finish with a round of purled fisherman's rib sts.

Decreases

***Decrease to the left**

Knit to 2 sts before the marked fisherman's rib st, slip the fisherman's rib st kw, k1 and take the st to the left needle, draw the marked fisherman's rib st over, move the st back to the right needle and draw the slipped fisherman's rib st over, tighten the yarn and knit around = 2 sts dec.

Work 2.4" (2", 1.6", 1.6") or 6 (5, 4, 4) cm. Finish with a round of purled fisherman's rib.

Decrease to the right

Knit to the marked fisherman's rib st, slip the fisherman's rib st kw, k1 and draw the slipped fisherman's rib st over, move the st to the left needle and draw the following fisherman's rib st over, move the st back to the right needle, tighten the yarn and knit around = 2 sts dec.

Move the marker to the decreased fisherman's rib st.

Work 2.4" (2", 1.6", 1.6") or 6 (5, 4, 4) cm. Finish with a round of purled fisherman's rib*.

Repeat from * - * until there's been decreased all in all 6 (7, 8, 8) times = 38 (40, 40, 42) sts.

Knit until the sleeve measures approx. 14.2" (36 cm) from the armhole.

Sleeve hem

Continue around in stockinette st as the fisherman's rib st is knitted as a st = 38 (40, 40, 42) sts.

On the next round, decrease approx. 10 sts evenly. Knit until the hem measures approx. 5.1" (13 cm).

Bind off loosely.

Fold the hem to the wrong side and sew the bind off edge to the transition from fisherman's rib to stockinette st.

Knit the other sleeve similarly.

Sew up the armholes.
