



KNITTING PATTERN

Pi

Sweater with dots

Design: Sys Fredens | Hobbii Design

MATERIALS

5 (6, 7, 8, 9, 10) skeins of Highland Wool, col 07 (A)

4 (4, 4, 5, 5, 6) skeins of Colorina, col 11 (B)

Circular needle 3.5 mm (US 4) and 4.5 mm (US 7) - 80 cm (32")

Stitch markers

Stitch holder

YARN QUALITIES

 **Highland Wool**, Hobbii

100 % Wool / 50 g (1.75 oz) = 175 m (191 yds)

 **Colorina**, Hobbii

80 % Acrylic, 20 % Wool / 50 g (1.75 oz) = 200 m (219 yds)

GAUGE

24 sts x 28 rnds/rows

with needle 4.5 mm (US 7) in pattern = 10 cm (4")

ABBREVIATIONS

st(s) = stitch(es)

k = knit

p = purl

tbl = through the back loop

rnd(s) = round(s)

RS = right side

WS = wrong side

yo(s) = yarnover(s)

co = cast on

bo = bind off

col = color(s)

SIZE

S (M, L, XL, 2XL, 3XL)

MEASUREMENTS

Width: 47 (51, 55, 59, 63, 67) cm / 18.5" (20.1", 21.7", 23.2", 24.8", 26.4")

Length: 53 (54, 55, 56, 57, 58) cm / 20.9" (21.3", 21.7", 22", 22.4", 22.8")

ABOUT THE PATTERN

The sweater has a pattern on the body and sleeves.

It is worked in the round on a circular needle until the armholes and then in flat from there.

One extra skein of Colorina is included so that the color progress is identical on both sleeves.

The sleeves are worked in the round with the magic loop technique.

PATTERN

Rnd/row 1: Stockinette stitch with col A.

Rnd/row 2: Stockinette stitch with col A.

Rnd/row 3: Repeat *2 sts with col A, 2 sts with col B* to end.

Rnd/row 4: Repeat *2 sts with col A, 2 sts with col B* to end.

Repeat rnds/rows 1-4.

NB! Always keep the thread with col B closest to you on the index finger = dominant color.

BODY

Rib edge

Co 232 (256, 272, 296, 312, 336) sts with col A on circular needle 3.5 mm (US 4) and work in the round.

Work rib (*k1, p1*) until the ribbing measures 5 cm (2")

Body

Change to needle 4.5 mm (US 7) and work pattern.

Work even until the work measures approx 36 cm (14.2"). End with rnd 4 of the pattern.

Place a marker between 2 sts in col B on each side = 116 (128, 136, 148, 156, 168) sts for each part.

Armholes

Work until 2 sts before marker, bo 4 sts, work until 2 sts before marker, bo 4 sts = 112 (124, 132, 144, 152, 164) sts for each part.

Now finish each part separately.

BACK

Work the 112 (124, 132, 144, 152, 164) sts in pattern. Place the remaining sts on a stitch holder.

Work until the armhole measures approx 15 (16, 17, 18, 19, 20) cm / 5.9" (6.3", 6.7", 7.1", 7.5", 7.9"). End with row 1 of the pattern.

Bo all sts.

FRONT PIECE

Work the remaining 112 (124, 132, 144, 152, 164) sts in pattern until the armhole measures approx 8 (9, 10, 11, 12, 13) cm / 3.1" (3.5", 3.9", 4.3", 4.7", 5.1"). End with row 2 of the pattern (= WS row) with col A.

Neckline, left-hand side

RS: Work 39 (45, 49, 55, 59, 65) sts, turn and put the remaining sts on hold.

WS: Bo 3 (3, 3, 4, 4, 4) sts and work to end.

RS: Work pattern to end.

WS: Bo 2 (2, 2, 3, 3, 3) sts and work to end.

RS: Work pattern to end.

WS: Bo 1 (2, 2, 2, 2, 3) st(s) and work to end.

RS: Work pattern to end.

WS: Bo 1 (1, 2, 1, 2, 2) st(s) and work to end.

RS: Work pattern to end.

WS: Bo 1 (1, 1, 1, 1, 1) st and work to end.

RS: Work pattern to end.

31 (36, 39, 44, 47, 52) sts remain for the shoulder. Work even until the armhole measures 17 (18, 19, 20, 21, 22) cm / 6.7" (7.1", 7.5", 7.9", 8.3", 8.7").

Place a marker at the sleeve side = the middle of the shoulder.

Work for another approx 2 cm (0.8"). End with a WS row with col A.

Bo with col A.

NB! The front piece is longer than the back piece which means that when joining the pieces, the back piece will be joined 2 cm (0.8") down.

All sizes: Place 34 sts on a stitch holder.

Neckline, right-hand side

RS: Join the yarn and work the 39 (45, 49, 55, 59, 65) remaining sts in pattern.

WS: Work pattern to end.

RS: Bo 3 (3, 3, 4, 4, 4) sts and work to end.

WS: Work pattern to end.

RS: Bo 2 (2, 2, 3, 3, 3) sts and work to end.

WS: Work pattern to end.

RS: Bo 1 (2, 2, 2, 2, 3) sts and work to end.

WS: Work pattern to end.

RS: Bo 1 (1, 2, 1, 2, 2) st(s) and work to end.

WS: Work pattern to end.

RS: Bo 1 (1, 1, 1, 1, 1) st and work to end.

31 (36, 39, 44, 47, 52) sts remain for the shoulder. Work even until the armhole measures 17 (18, 19, 20, 21, 22) cm / 6.7" (7.1", 7.5", 7.9", 8.3", 8.7").

Place a marker at the sleeve side = the middle of the shoulder.

Work for another approx 2 cm (0.8"). End with a WS row with col A.

Bo with col A.

SLEEVES

One extra skein of Colorina is included so that the color progress is identical on both sleeves.

Begin identically on 2 skeins to make sure that you achieve an identical color run on both sleeves.

Ribbing

Co 62 (64, 64, 68, 68, 70) sts with col A on circular needle 3.5 mm (US 4) and work in the round with the magic loop technique.

Work in rib (*k1, p1*) until the ribbing measures 5 cm (2").

SLEEVE

Change to needle 4.5 mm (US 7) and work pattern.

Place a marker at the beginning of the rnd between 2 sts in col A.

Increase on every 6th rnd like this:

Work until 1 st before marker, yo, k2, yo. On the next rnd, the yos are k tbl = 2 sts increased.

Increase until you have 88 (94, 98, 104, 108, 114) sts.

Work even until the work measures approx 47 cm (18.5"). End with a rnd with col A.
Bo with col A. Place a marker in the middle of the bo.

Same procedure for the other sleeve.

FINISHING

Sew the shoulder seams together. Attach the sleeves by placing the marker midway on the shoulder directly opposite the marker midway on the sleeve.

Neckline

Pick up approx 130-150 sts along the neckline with needle 3.5 mm (US 4) and col A.
Work 3 cm (1.2") in rib (*k1, p1*).

Bo loosely in rib or by means of stretchy bind off.
