



CROCHET PATTERN

Artemis

Neck Warmer

MATERIALS

2 (2, 2) skeins of Zafira Christmas Edition, color 17 1 (1, 1) cone of Party deluxe, color Pink

Crochet hook 5 mm (US H/8) Markers

YARN QUALITY

Zafira, Hobbii 50% Cotton, 27% Wool, 18% Acrylic/ 50 g (1.75 oz) = 150 meters (164 yds)

Party Deluxe, Gohandmade 100% Polyester 50 g (1.75 oz) = 250 meters (273 yds)

GAUGE

17 stitches and 19 rounds on 10 cm (4") in pattern working with 1 strand of each quality

SIZES

S (M, L)

MEASUREMENTS

Circumference, collar: approx. 50 (53, 57) cm / 20" (21.2", 22.8")

PATTERN INFORMATION

Work with 1 strand of each quality of yarn.

The neck warmer is worked top-down, in a spiral and in pattern.

When the collar is finished, you continue with the yoke and make increases on every round to create the 6 points.

Pattern instructions







EXPLANATIONS

1 pattern stitch: Chain 1, skip 1 stitch, 1 single crochet around the next chain space.

COLLAR

Chain 85 (91, 97) with 1 strand of each quality. Join into a ring with a slip stitch and chain 1.

Work in a spiral.

Round 1: Work single crochet around.

Round 2: *Chain 1, skip 1 stitch, 1 single crochet*, repeat * - * around.

Round 3: Work pattern stitches around.

Repeat Round 3 until the collar measures approx. 7 cm (2.8").

Mark increases

S: *Count out 7 chain spaces and place a marker in this space*, repeat * - * 6 times = 6 markers.

M: *Count out 7 chain spaces and place a marker in this space, count out 8 chain spaces and place a marker in this space*, repeat * - * 3 times = 6 markers.

L: *Count out 8 chain spaces and place a marker in this space*, repeat * - * 6 times = 6 markers.

YOKE

Continue around in a spiral in pattern with increases:

Round 1: *work until the marker, (chain 1, 1 single crochet) 2 times in the marked space*, repeat * - * around = 6 (6, 6) increases.

Round 2: *work until the space in the increase, (chain 1, 1 single crochet) 2 times in this space*, repeat * - * around = 6 (6, 6) increases.

Repeat Round 2 being careful to have the increases straight above each other and increasing the number of stitches between the increases.

Continue until the yoke measures approx. 20 cm (8") measured from the foundation chain to the point.

Bind off.
