#### MATERIALS

2 skeins of Rainbow Cotton 8/4 color 015 (Grey) 1 skein of Rainbow Cotton 8/4 color 046 (Old Rose)

A long piece of yarn of the same weight in a different grey color.

Crochet hook 2.5 mm

Black embroidery yarn for eyebrows Fiberfill Rouge Safety eyes 6 mm Scissors Pins Needle for assembling

#### YARN QUALITY

**Rainbow Cotton 8/4**, Hobbii 100% Cotton 50 g (1.75 oz) = 170 meters (186 yds)

#### ABBREVIATIONS

Sc = single crochet
Sl st(s) = slip stitch(es)
Ns = next stitch
Ch = chain
Bs = bubble stitch: 4 unfinished dc in one
stitch, yarn over and pull through all the
loops on the hook
Rnd = round
Inc = increase: 2 sc in the same stitch
Dec = decrease: sc2tog
() = the number of stitches after ended
round

**SIZE** One-size

**MEASUREMENTS** Approx. 18 cm (7.2") tall

#### **INFO AND TIPS**

Each of the pieces for Elliot the Elephant is worked separately and assembled at the end. After each crocheted piece you will find a description of how to assemble Elliot.

#### HEAD

Color: 015 Grey Rnd 1: 6 sc in a magic ring (6) Rnd 2: inc x6 (12) Rnd 3: \*3 sc, inc\* x3 (15) Rnds 4-26: 1 sc in each st (15) Rnd 27: \*4 sc, inc\* x3 (18) Rnd 28: \*2 sc, inc\* x6 (24) Rnd 29: 1 sc in each st (24) Rnd 30: \*3 sc, inc\* x6 (30) Rnd 31: \*4 sc, inc\* x6 (36) Rnd 32: 1 sc in each st (36) Rnd 33: \*5 sc, inc\* x6 (42) Rnd 34: 1 sc in each st (42) Rnd 35: \*6 sc, inc\* x6 (48) Rnd 36: 1 sc in each st (48) Rnd 37: \*7 sc, inc\* x6 (54) Rnd 38: 1 sc in each st (54) Rnd 39: \*8 sc, inc\* x6 (60) Rnd 40: 1 sc in each st (60) Rnd 41: \*9 sc, inc\* x6 (66) Rnds 42-45: 1 sc in each st (66)

Attach the eyes between rnds 33 and 34 with approx. 8 stitches in between.



Rnd 46: \*9 sc, dec\* x6 (60) Rnd 47: \*8 sc, dec\* x6 (54) Rnd 48: \*7 sc, dec\* x6 (48) Rnd 49: \*6 sc, dec\* x6 (42) Rnd 50: \*5 sc, dec\* x6 (36) Rnd 51: \*4 sc, dec\* x6 (30) Rnd 52: \*3 sc, dec\* x6 (24) Now, stuff the head. Rnd 53: \*2 sc, dec\* x6 (18) Rnd 54: \*1 sc, dec\* x6 (12) And stuff the head one last time Rnd 55: dec x6 (6)

Now, sew together the last 6 sts. Sew through one of the loops of each of the last 6 sts. Pull the thread to close the hole and weave in the end. With the extra strand of grey cotton yarn you can now embroider the grooves on the trunk. Insert the needle under the trunk and push it all the way up through the trunk to the right (with the head facing towards you). Then insert the needle into the trunk 5 stitches to the left of where the needle came up. DON'T push the needle all the way through the trunk but keep it inside the trunk. And then push it up again through the trunk 4 rounds further down the trunk to the right. Repeat the above steps until you have embroidered 5 grooves on the trunk. Weave in both ends under the trunk.

Now, embroider the eyebrows on Elliot between rnds 36 and 37. The eyebrows should be 2-3 stitches wide. You can use black cotton yarn 8/4 or black embroidery yarn for the eyebrows.

And you can use regular makeup to paint rouge on Elliot's cheeks.





#### BODY

Rnd 1: 6 sc in a magic ring (6)

Rnd 2: inc x6 (12)

Color: 015 Grey

- Rnd 3: \*1 sc, inc\* x6 (18)
- Rnd 4: \*2 sc, inc\* x6 (24)
- Rnd 5: \*3 sc, inc\* x6 (30)
- Rnd 6: \*4 sc, inc\* x6 (36)
- Rnd 7: \*5 sc, inc\* x6 (42)
- Rnd 8: \*6 sc, inc\* x6 (48)
- Rnd 9: \*7 sc, inc\* x6 (54)
- Rnd 10: \*8 sc, inc\* x6 (60)
- Rnd 11: \*9 sc, inc\* x6 (66)
- Rnds 12-19: 1 sc in each st (66)
- Rnd 20: \*9 sc, dec\* x6 (60)
- Rnds 21-23: 1 sc in each st (60)
- Rnd 24: \*8 sc, dec\* x6 (54)
- Rnds 25-27: 1 sc in each st (54)
- Rnd 28: \*7 sc, dec\* x6 (48)
- Rnds 29-31: 1 sc in each st (48)
- Rnd 32: \*6 sc, dec\* x6 (42)
- Rnds 33-35: 1 sc in each st (42)
- Begin stuffing the body.
- Rnd 36: \*5 sc, dec\* x6 (36)
- Rnds 37-39: 1 sc in each st (36)
- Rnd 40: \*4 sc, dec\* x6 (30)
- Rnds 41-42: 1 sc in each st (30)
- Rnd 43: \*3 sc, dec\* x6 (24)
- Rnd 44: 1 sc in each st (24)
- Stuff the body well.
- Cut off the yarn but be careful to leave a long tail for sewing the head onto the body.

## LEG X 2

Color: 015 Grey Rnd 1: 6 sc in a magic ring Rnd 2: inc x6 (12) Rnd 3: \*1 sc, inc\* x6 (18)



Rnd 4: \*2 sc, inc\* x6 (24)
Rnd 5: 1 sc in each st (24)
Rnd 6: 5 sc,\*1 bs, 1 sc\* x3,13 sc (24)
Rnds 7-9: 1 sc in each st (24)
Rnd 10: \*2 sc, dec\* x6 (18)
Rnds 11-24: 1 sc in each st (18)
Stuff the foot well and a little less in the actual leg. And finally, crochet the opening
closed with 9 sl sts. Cut off the yarn but be careful to leave a long tail for sewing the leg on.
Sew the legs on right under the body. They should point outward a bit.

#### ARM X 2

Color: 015 Grey Rnd 1: 6 sc in a magic ring Rnd 2: inc x6 (12) Rnd 3: \*1 sc, inc\* x6 (18) Rnd 4: 1 sc in each (18) Rnd 5: 3 sc,\*1 bs, 1 sc\* x3,9 sc (18) Rnd 6: 1 sc in each st (18) Rnd 7: \*7 sc, dec\* x2 (16) Rnds 8-17: 1 sc in each (16) Rnd 18: \*6 sc, dec\* x2 (14) Rnds 19-21: 1 sc in each st (14)

Stuff the hand well and a little less in the actual arm. And finally, crochet the opening closed with sl sts. Cut off the yarn but be careful to leave a long tail for sewing the arm on. Sew the arm onto the top of the body right under the head.

#### **INSIDE EAR x 2**


Color: 046 Old Rose Rnd 1: 6 sc in a magic ring (6) Rnd 2: inc x6 (12) Rnd 3: \*1 sc, inc\* x6 (18) Rnd 4: \*2 sc, inc\* x6 (24) Rnd 5: \*1 sc, inc, 2 sc\* x6 (30) Rnd 6: \*4 sc, inc\* x6 (36) Rnd 7: \*1 sc, inc, 4 sc\* x6 (42) Rnd 8: \*6 sc, inc\* x6 (48) Rnd 9: \*2 sc, inc, 5 sc\* x6 (54) Rnd 10: \*1 sc, inc, 7 sc\* x6 (60) Cut the yarn and weave in end.



#### **OUTSIDE EAR x 2**

Color: 015 Grey Rnd 1: 6 sc in a magic ring (6) Rnd 2: inc x6 (12) Rnd 3: \*1 sc, inc\* x6 (18) Rnd 4: \*2 sc, inc\* x6 (24) Rnd 5: \*1 sc, inc, 2 sc\* x6 (30) Rnd 6: \*4 sc, inc\* x6 (36) Rnd 7: \*1 sc, inc, 4 sc\* x6 (42) Rnd 8: \*6 sc, inc\* x6 (48) Rnd 9: \*2 sc, inc, 5 sc\* x6 (54) Rnd 10: \*1 sc, inc, 7 sc\* x6 (60)

DON'T cut the yarn but continue to crochet the ears together. Take a pink piece and a grey piece and place them with the right sides facing outward and the wrong sides facing each other. Insert your hook into ns on the grey part of the ear and into ns on the pink part of the ear. Yarn over and pull the yarn back through both earpieces. Continue all the way around. When you are back where you began, fold the ear in the middle to have the pink piece turn inward. Then you crochet the ear together with 8 sc followed by 1 sl st. Leave a long tail for sewing the ear onto the elephant. Sew the top of the ears onto the top of the head on rnd 43 with approx. 15 stitches in between.





#### TAIL

Color: 015 Grey

Chain 25. Begin in the 2nd st from the hook and work 24 sc. Cut off the yarn but be careful to leave a long piece of yarn for sewing the tail onto Elliot on rnd 23.

Cut three strands of yarn. Insert your hook into the end of Elliot's tail by pushing the hook straight through the tail. Fold the three strands of yarn in the middle and catch the strands with your hook where the fold is and pull them through the stitch to create a loop. Then pull all the yarn tails through the loop and tighten. Trim the ends to a suitable length and use a small needle to split the yarn.



# TUFT OF HAIR

Color: 015 Grey

Cut three long strands of yarn. Insert your hook in the middle of the head between the ears by pushing the hook into the head and up through the stitch behind. Fold the three strands of yarn in the middle and catch the strands with your hook where the fold is and pull them through the stitch to create a loop. Then pull all the yarn tails through the loop and tighten. Trim the ends to a suitable length and use a small needle to split the yarn.
