Children's coat

MATERIALS

6 (7) skeins of Divina color 22

Knitting needles 7 mm
Tapestry needle
3 small buttons

YARN QUALITY

 **Divina**, Hobbii
65% alpaca, 25% polyamide, 10% wool
50g / 1.75 oz = 150 m / 164 yds

GAUGE

10 cm x 10 cm (4" x 4") = 14 sts x 22 rows

ABBREVIATIONS

St/s = stitch/es
k = knit
p = purl
k2tog = knit 2 sts together
p2tog = purl 2 sts together
dec = decrease
inc = increase
CO = Cast On
BO = Bind Off

SIZE

18 mths /86 cm, 33.8" (24 mths/92 cm, 36.2")
30 mths /98 cm, 38.5"

MEASUREMENTS

Waist width: 35 (36) 37 cm / 13.7" (14.17")
14.56"
Chest circumference: 55 (56) 57 cm / 21.6"
(22") 22.4"
Length: 42 (46) 48 cm / 16.5" (18.1") 18.89"
Sleeve length: 28 (31) 32 cm / 11" (12.2")
12.59"

This chic coat is knitted on straight needles, and consists of separate pieces that are sewn together at the end.

INFO AND TIPS

NOTE: The coat is made with double thread!

Stockinette stitch: purl in odd rows, knit in even rows.

Garner stitch: knit every row.

For all sizes, after CO sts work 4 rows in garner stitch. Then continue in stockinette stitch, keeping in mind that the first 3 sts of the front parts (after the edge st), are still worked in garner st.

Row counts apply only to rows in stockinette stitch.

BODY

Right front

Co 34 (36) 38 sts on 7 mm needle. Work 4 rows in garner stitch. After that, work in stockinette stitch as follows:

odd rows: 1 edge st, k 3, p, 1 edge st;

even rows: 1 edge st, k, 1 edge st;

in every 8th row: 1 edge st, k2tog, k, 1 edge st.

Work this way 22 (26) 30 rows.

In the next row start to work the leaf motif as follows:

18 mths: 1 edge st, k 3, p 13, leaf pattern, p 13, 1 edge st.

24 mths: 1 edge st, k 3, p 13, leaf pattern, p 14, 1 edge st.

30 mths: 1 edge st, k 3, p 14, leaf pattern, p 15, 1 edge st.

After finishing the leaf pattern, work 10 (14) 14 rows more.

Now start to decreasing the sts as follows:

18 mths: 1 edge st, k 3, (p 2, p2tog) x 7, p 2, 1 edge st.

24 mths: 1 edge st, k 3, (p 2, p2tog) x 8, 1 edge st.

30 mths: 1 edge st, k 3, (p 2, p2tog) x 8, p 2, 1 edge st.

Work further 18 (20) 20 rows.

Now start to work the neckline.

in every 2nd row BO as follows: 4 sts, 4 sts, 3 sts, 2 sts, 1 st.

BO the remaining sts on the shoulders.

Left front

Work symmetrically to the right front.

BACK PIECE

CO 60 (64) 68 sts. Work 4 rows in garter stitch. Then work in stockinette stitch by decreasing in each 8th row 1 st on both sides of the back for 52 (60) 64 rows.

In the next row decrease as follows:

18 mths: 1 edge st, (p 2, p2tog) x 11, 1 p, 1 edge st;

24 mths: 1 edge st, (p 2, p2tog) x 12, 1 edge st;

30 mths: 1 edge st, (p 2, p2tog) x 12, 2 p, 1 edge st.

Work further 20 (22) rows.

BO the central 10 sts for the neckline, then in every 2nd row on both sides of the closed central sts, BO 2 sts, 2 sts, 1 st.

BO the remaining sts on the shoulders.

SLEEVES

CO 22 (24) 26 sts.

Work 4 rows in garter stitch. Then work 62 (64) 66 rows in stockinette stitch increasing in every 6th row 1 st on both sides of the sleeve.

Finishing

Sew the pieces of the coat together. Pick up sts at the neckline. Work 8 rows in stockinette stitch so that the k sts are on the inside of the coat.

Sew 3 buttons to the left side of the front at the height between the armpit and the neck, equal distance apart.

The buttons must be small enough to go through any garter stitch hole.

Leaf pattern

NOTE: In even rows work all sts and YOs purlwise.
