## Baby blanket

## MATERIALS

2 skeins of Butterfly, col 01
Circular needle US 6 ( 4 mm ) / 31.5" ( 80 cm )

## YARN QUALITY

(132) Butterfly, Hobbii

100\% Acrylic / 7.1 oz (200 g) $=500 \mathrm{~m}(547$
yds)

## GAUGE

21 sts $\times 36$ rows $=4^{\prime \prime}(10 \mathrm{~cm})$
with needle US $6(4 \mathrm{~mm})$ in pattern

## ABBREVIATIONS

$\mathrm{K}=$ knit
$\mathrm{P}=$ purl
yo = yarn over
sl1k = slip 1 knitwise
k2tog $=$ knit 2 sts together

## SIZE

One size
MEASUREMENTS
Width: $31.5^{\prime \prime}(80 \mathrm{~cm})$
Length: $33.5^{\prime \prime}(85 \mathrm{~cm})$

## ABOUT THE PATTERN

The blanket has an edge worked in garter stitch and a beautiful little pattern in the middle.
The first skein is used from the inside and the second skein from the outside in order to reverse the stripes.

## Tip

Place a marker on each side of the edges.

## PATTERN

Row 1, RS: *K3, yo, sl1k, k2tog, pass over the loose st, yo*, repeat from * to * to end.
Row 2, WS: $P$ all sts.
Row 3, RS: K all sts.
Row 4, WS: P all sts.
Row 5, RS: *Yo, sl1k, k2tog, pass over the loose st, yo, k3*, repeat from * to * to end.
Row 6, WS: P all sts.
Row 7, RS: K all sts.
Row 8, WS: P all sts.

## BLANKET

Co 174 sts and work 6 rows in garter stitch.
Count 6 sts in from each side and place a marker on each side. These sts are $k$ on all rows while the 162 middle sts are worked in pattern.

NB When the first skein is finished, the last stripe is blue (dark). Before moving on to the next skein, the blue (dark) color is removed to ensure that the stripes have the same length and the blanket does not become too long.

Work until the work measures approx approx $32.7^{\prime \prime}(83 \mathrm{~cm})$ and the last stripe before the edge has the same length.
Work 6 rows in garter stitch.
Bo knitwise.
