



KNITTING PATTERN

MATERIALS

1 skein of Highland Wool, col 13 1 skein of Diablo, col 55

Circular needle 3.0 mm (US 2.5)

YARN QUALITY

Highland Wool, Hobbii 100% Wool/ 50 g (1.8 oz) = 175 m (191 yds)

Diablo, Hobbii 40 % Acrylic, 30 % Mohair, 30 % Polyamide/ 25 g (0.9 oz) = 225 m (246 yds)

GAUGE

22 sts x 35 rows = 10 cm (4") with needle 3.0 mm (US 2.5) and 1 thread of Highland Wool

ABBREVIATIONS

K = knit WS = wrong side RS = right side

SIZE

S/M (M/L)

MEASUREMENTS

Width: 8.5 (10) cm / 3.3" (4") Length: 19 cm / 7.5"

ABOUT THE PATTERN

The wrist warmers are worked in the flat with a brioche stitch stripe running from the wrist to the fingers.

The cuff and the ending are worked with 1 thread of Highland Wool and 1 thread of Diablo. The rest is worked with 1 thread of Highland Wool.

Elaboration

K1B = Knit 1 below = work a knit stitch in the stitch from the previous row, i.e. the stitch directly below the stitch on the needle.

CUFF

Co 37 (43) sts with circular needle 3.0 mm (US 2.5) and 1 thread of Highland Wool and 1 thread of Diablo. K 1 row (WS).

Row 1, RS: K3, 1 K1B, *k5, 1 K1B*, repeat from * to * until 3 sts remain, k3.

Row 2, WS: K all sts.

Repeat rows 1-2 until the work measures 7 cm (2.8").

End with a WS row.

HAND PIECE

In this part, only work with 1 thread of Highland Wool.

Row 1, RS: K3, *1 K1B, k2*, repeat from * to * until 3 sts remain, k3.

Row 2, WS: K all sts.

Repeat rows 1-2 until the work measures 15 cm (5.9").

End with a WS row.

ENDING

The ending is worked with 1 thread of Highland Wool and 1 thread of Diablo.

Row 1, RS: K3, 1 K1B, *k5, 1 K1B*, repeat from * to * until 3 sts remain, k3.

Row 2, WS: K all sts.

Repeat rows 1-2 until the work measures 19 cm / 7.5".

Make another wrist warmer following the same procedure.

FINISHING

Fold each wrist warmer lengthwise. Sew the side seam from the cuff 10 cm / 4" down, skip 5 cm / 2" (thumb hole) and sew the rest (4 cm / 1.6") together.
