MATERIALS

2 skeins of Snowstorm color 15
2 skeins of Tweed Delight color 10

Straight or circular needles 8 mm (US 11)
Crochet hook 6 mm (K/10.5)
Sewing needle

YARN QUALITY

 **Snowstorm**, Hobbii
100 % wool
50 g / 1.8 oz = 50 m / 55 yds

 **Tweed Delight**, Hobbii
85 % wool, 10 % acrylic, 5 % viscose
50 g / 1.75 oz. = 100 m / 109 yds

ABBREVIATIONS

st/s = stitch/es
CO = cast on
BO = bind off
k = knit
p = purl
inc = increase
dec = decrease
dc = double crochet
sl st = slip stitch

SIZE

One size

MEASUREMENTS

Width around neck: approx. 48 cm / 18.89"
Length: 20 cm / 9.84"

PATTERN INFORMATION

If you love super warm cowls and wraps, this Susurrou snood is a perfect fashion accessory for you!

It can be worn pulled down on the shoulders or closer to the neck, over a sweater, over a dress or a jacket, a number of ways!

INFO AND TIPS

The snood is knitted and finished with crochet.

If you are working on straight needles increase the stitches in odd rows, if you are working on circular needles, increase the stitches in every other round.

Crochet ruffle is made from two strands of yarn.

Knitting stitches used:

rib stitch - knit 2, purl 2;

stockinette stitch - knit in odd rows, purl in even rows.

COWL

With knitting needles and Snowstorm color 15 yarn, CO 80 sts.

Rows 1-10: work with rib stitch.

Row 11: work with rib stitch and inc at the end.

Row 12: continue with rib stitch.

Now you will start to work with stockinette stitch.

Row 13: k, inc after every 8 sts.

Row 14 and all even rows: p.

Row 15: k, inc after every 9 sts.

Row 17: k, inc after every 10 sts.

Row 19: k, inc after every 11 sts.

Row 21: k, inc after every 12 sts.

Row 23: k, inc after every 13 sts.

Row 25: k, inc after every 14 sts.

Row 26: p.

BO all the sts. If you are knitting on straight needles, sew the snood with mattress stitch.

FINISHING

The first round you will work only through the small loops at the back of the knitting stitches (also called third loop - see photos below).

With a 6 mm crochet hook join two strands of Tweed Delight color 10 to the third loop at the back of the knitting stitch, and ch 3.

Round 1: 1 dc in the same st, [dc, inc] to the end of the round, join the round with sl st.

Round 2: ch 3, 1 dc to the end of the round, join the round with sl st.

Cast off.

Weave all the ends.
