Cassi

Cardigan

MATERIALS


6 (6) 8 (8) 10 skeins of Diablo Multi color 01

Circular needle 8 mm (US 11) 80 cm (31.5")

Circular needle 7 mm (US 10,5) 80 cm (31.5")

4 buttons (23mm)

YARN QUALITY

 **Diablo Multi,**
30 % Mohair, 30 % Nylon, 40 % Acrylic
50 g (1.75 oz) = 90 m (98 yds)

GAUGE

10 cm x 10 cm (4" x 4") = 11 sts x 16 rows
on 8mm (US 11) needles

ABBREVIATIONS

K = knit

P = purl

M1R = make 1 right

M1L = make 1 left

CO = cast on

BO = bind off

K2tog = knit 2 stitches together

SM = stitch marker

SIZE

XS (S) M (L) XL

MEASUREMENTS

Finished bust circumference: 100 (105) 110
(115) 120cm / 40 (42) 44 (46) 48"

PATTERN INFORMATION

This super cozy cardigan is knitted from the top down in one piece. The Cassi Cardigan has big balloon sleeves and you work the button band while you knit the cardigan.

INFO AND TIPS

Choose a size that is approximately 10-25 cm (4-10") bigger than your actual bust circumference, depending on how oversized you want your cardigan to be.

You start with the neck, pick up stitches out of it and knit a classic raglan cardigan.

NECK

Co 7 sts on a 8 mm (US 11) circular needle. Slip the first stitch as if to purl with the yarn in front, work 1x1 ribbing (start with a knit stitch) until there is 1 stitch left on the needle, knit 1.

Turn the work.

-knit 1, work the stitches in pattern and knit the last stitch

-slip 1 as if to knit, work stitches in pattern and knit the last stitch

Repeat these two rows until your work measures 14 (14) 14 (16) 16 cm, 5,5 (5,5) 5,5 (6) 6".

End with a WS-Row. Slip the stitches onto a wire and let them rest. Break the yarn.

With the right side facing you: pick up 7 stitches out of the cast on edge.

Work according to the pattern until your work measures 28 (28) 28 (32) 32 cm, 11 (11) 11 (12) 12". Watch out to work the edge stitches right. Your last row is a WS-Row. Slip the stitches onto a piece of waste yarn and let them rest. Break the yarn.

RAGLAN

With the right side facing you: Pick up 24 (24) 24 (26) 26 stitches out of the edge where you knitted every stitch. Slip all stitches back onto the needle and place markers:

Work 7 stitches in pattern, SM, knit 1, SM, knit 2 (raglan stitches), SM, knit 4, SM, knit 2 (raglan stitches), SM, knit 6 (6) 6 (8) 8, SM, knit 2 (raglan stitches), SM, knit 4, SM, knit 2 (raglan stitches), SM, knit 1, SM, work 7 stitches in pattern

Now you start increasing to form the raglan (every right side row) and the v- neck (every second right side row). Work as follows:

Row 1: Slip the first stitch as if to purl with the yarn in front, work the stitches as they appear until you reach the second SM, M1R, slip SM, knit 2, slip SM, M1L, knit the sleeve stitches, M1R, slip SM, knit 2, slip SM, M1L, knit the back stitches, M1R, slip SM, knit 2, slip SM, M1L, knit the sleeve stitches, M1R, slip SM, knit 2, slip SM, M1L, work the stitches as they appear until the end of the row

Row 2: Work every stitch according to the pattern

Row 3: Slip the first stitch as if to purl with the yarn in front, work the stitches as they appear until you reach the first SM, slip SM, M1L, knit to the next SM, M1R, slip SM, knit 2, slip SM, M1L, knit the sleeve stitches, M1R, slip SM, knit 2, slip SM, M1L, knit the back stitches, M1R, slip SM, knit 2, slip SM, M1L, knit the sleeve stitches, M1R, slip SM, knit 2, slip SM, M1L, knit to the next SM, M1R, slip SM, work the stitches as they appear until the end of the row

Row 4: Work every stitch according to the pattern

Repeat these four rows a total of 9 (9) 10 (10) 11 times.

Size S only: Repeat rows 1+2 one more time

You should have a total of 200 (208) 218 (220) 238 stitches on the needle. Knit to the second SM, remove the SM and knit the 2 raglan stitches, remove SM, slip the 40 (42) 44 (44) 48 sleeve stitches on some waste yarn and let them rest. CO 6 (6) 6 (8) 8 stitches under the arm. Remove the next SM, knit the raglan stitches, remove SM, work across the back stitches, remove the next SM, knit the raglan stitches and remove SM. Slip the sleeve stitches on waste yarn and let them rest, CO 6 (6) 6 (8) 8 stitches under the arm. Remove the next SM, knit the raglan stitches, remove SM, work to the end of the row. Knit 1 wrong side row.

BODY

Now you start knitting the body of the cardigan, the 4 buttonholes are worked every 12 (12) 14 (14) 16 rows. Knit them as follows:

Row 1: knit 3 stitches in pattern, BO 1 stitch, knit to the end of the row

Row 2: purl to 3 stitches before the end of the row, CO 1, purl to the end of the row

Switch to 7mm needles (US 10,5) and start working in 1x1 ribbing when you reach the 3rd buttonhole. Knit in 1x1 ribbing until you have 4 buttonholes, knit 2 more rows, BO all stitches.

SLEEVES (WORKED TOP-DOWN)

Slip the sleeve stitches back on the 8mm (US 11) needle and pick up 6 (6) 6 (8) 8 stitches under the arm. Place a SM in the middle of the stitches you picked up under the arm. The increases for the balloon sleeves are every 10th round.

Increases: knit 1, M1L, knit to 1 stitch before SM, M1R, knit 1

Knit until you worked the increase round a total of 6 times. Work until your sleeve measures 40 (40) 40 (42) 42 cm 16 (16) 16 (16,5) 16,5" from the increase under the arm.

Start with the decreases:

- *Knit 1, K2tog* until the end
- knit 1 round
- *K2tog* for 1 round

Switch to 7mm needles (US 10,5) and work in 1x1 ribbing for 5 cm (2"). BO all stitches.
Repeat for the second sleeve.

Sew on the buttons, weave in the ends and enjoy!
