All Seasons

Kimono

MATERIALS

3 (3) 4 skeins of Winter Glow Solid color Oat 30

Crochet hook 5 mm (US H/8)
Yarn needle
Stitch Marker

YARN QUALITY

 **Winter Glow Solid**, Hobbii
51 % Wool, 49% Acrylic
100 g / 3.5 oz = 350 m / 382 yds

GAUGE

10 cm x 10 cm (4" x 4") = 12 tr x 5 rows

ABBREVIATIONS

ch = chain
sp = space
sk = skip
sc = single crochet
WS = wrong side
dc = double crochet
tr = treble crochet
Y-st = Y stitch (tr in indicated st, ch 1, dc in
bottom 2 vertical bars of tr st)
() = total number of sts

SIZE

XS/S/M (L/XL/2XL) 3XL/4XL

MEASUREMENTS

Back Width: 56 (71) 84 cm / 22" (28") 33"
Front Length: 145 (155) 165 cm / 57" (61") 65"

PATTERN INFORMATION

This is a simple garment that is a great layering piece. A slightly oversized fit makes this fun and flowy.

INFO AND TIPS

This is worked all in one piece lengthwise from one side to the other.
Beginning ch 4 counts as a tr st.

BODY

Ch 173 (185) 197.

Row 1: Tr in 5th ch from hook, tr in each st across, turn - (170 (182) 194 tr)

Row 2: WS Ch 4 (counts as a st throughout), tr in each st across, turn - (170 (182) 194 tr)

Row 3: Ch 4, sk 1, Y-st in next, *sk 2, Y-st in next; repeat from * across to last 2, sk 1, tr in last, turn - (56 (60) 64 Y-sts)

Row 4: Ch 4, tr in each st and ch sp across, turn - (170 (182) 194 tr)

Row 5: Ch 4, tr in each st across, turn - (170 (182) 194 tr)

Rows 6-14 (17) 20: Repeat Rows 3-5.

Row 15 (18) 21: Ch 4, sk 1, Y-st in next, [sk 2, Y-st in next] 27 (29) 31 times, sk 1, tr in next, ch 87 (93) 99, turn - (28 (30, 32) Y-sts)

Row 16 (19) 22: Tr in 5th ch from hook, tr in each ch and st across, turn - (170 (182) 194 tr)

Row 17 (20) 23: Ch 4, tr in each st across, turn - (170 (182) 194 tr)

Row 18-29 (21-35) 24-41: Repeat Rows 3-5. Do not fasten off, continue to edging.



EDGING

Ch 1, sc evenly along each edge of garment.
Fasten off leaving 102 cm/40" to seam the one side.

ARM HOLES

Lay flat with WS facing you, from the top, fold down each side to meet evenly at the bottom.
Count 51 (57) 63 sts up from bottom, place a st marker to hold front and back sides together on each side.
With a yarn needle and yarn strand of 102 cm/40", use the mattress stitch to seam each side up to the st marker.
Fasten off and weave in ends.
