## Rainbow

Children's T-Shirt

## MATERIALS

## Friends Cotton 8/6

Col 40 Tomato
approx 5 (10) 10 (15) 20 (25) g / 0.2 (0.4) 0.4
(0.5) 0.7 (0.9) oz. 1 (1) 1 (1) 1 (1) skein

Col 30 Orange
approx 10 (15) 15 (20) 25 (30) g / 0.4 (0.5)
0.5 (0.7) 0.9 (1.0) oz. 1 (1) 1 (1) 1 (1) skein

Col 23 Lemon
approx 20 (25) 25 (30) 35 (40) g / 0.7 (0.9)
0.9 (1.0) 1.2 (1.4) oz. 1 (1) 1 (1) 1 (1) skein

Col 104 Shamrock
approx 30 (35) 35 (50) 50 (60) g / 1.0 (1.2)
1.2 (1.8) 1.8 (2.1) oz. 1 (1) 1 (2) 2 (2) skein(s)

Col 90 Capri Blue
approx 10 (15) 15 (20) 25 (30) g / 0.4 (0.5)
0.5 (0.7) 0.9 (1.0) oz. 1 (1) 1 (1) 1 (1) skein

Col 86 Navy
approx 10 (15) 15 (20) 25 (30) g / 0.4 (0.5)
0.5 (0.7) 0.9 (1.0) oz. 1 (1) 1 (1) 1 (1) skein

Col 65 Grape
approx 20 (25) 25 (30) 35 (40) g / 0.7 (0.9)
0.9 (1.0) 1.2 (1.4) oz. 1 (1) 1 (1) 1 (1) skein

Circular needle 3.5 mm (US 4) - 40 cm (16")
$+60 \mathrm{~cm}\left(24^{\prime \prime}\right), 80 \mathrm{~cm}\left(32^{\prime \prime}\right)$ or 100 cm (39")
Circular needle 4 mm (US 6) - 40 cm (16") +
$60 \mathrm{~cm}\left(24{ }^{\prime \prime}\right), 80 \mathrm{~cm}$ (32") or 100 cm (39")
Tapestry needle
9 stitch markers
2 stitch holders

## YARN QUALITY

(20) Friends Cotton 8/6, Hobbii

100 \% Cotton
$50 \mathrm{~g}(1.8 \mathrm{oz})=105 \mathrm{~m}(115 \mathrm{yds})$

## GAUGE

21 sts $\times 28$ rows in stockinette stitch with needle $4 \mathrm{~mm}($ US 6$)=10 \mathrm{~cm}\left(4^{\prime \prime}\right)$

## SIZE

2 (4) 6 (8) 10 (12) years

## MEASUREMENTS

Body length (t-shirt) measured at the middle of the back: Approx 32 (36) 40 (42) 46 (49) cm / 12.6" (14.2") 15.7" (16.5") 18.1" (19.3") (including 3 cm (1.2") of ribbing at the neckline and 3 cm (1.2") of ribbing the bottom).

Sleeve length measured from the armhole:
Approx 3 (5) 5 (7) 9 (9) cm / 1.2" (2") 2" (2.8") 3.5" (3.5"), including 3 cm (1.2") of ribbing.

Chest circumference (t-shirt): Approx 58 (62) 64 (69.5) 75 (79) cm / 22.8" (24.4") 25.2" (27.4") 29.5" (31").

## ABOUT THE PATTERN

The t-shirt is worked top down with raglan increases on the yoke. It features a neckline ribbing as well as ribbing at the bottom of the sleeves and body. The t-shirt is worked from the right side in one piece.

st(s) = stitch(es)

M1L: Pick up the bar between 2 stitches from the front and knit it through the back loop.
co = cast on
bo $=$ bind off

## INFORMATION AND TIPS

## Color order:

1: 1 strand of Tomato col 40.
2: 1 strand of Orange col 30.
3: 1 strand of Lemon col 23.
4: 1 strand of Shamrock col 104.
5: 1 strand of Capri Blue col 90.
6: 1 strand of Navy col 86.
7: 1 strand of Grape col 65.
Stripe length (7 stripes in total): 4.5 (5) 5.5 (6) 6.5 (7) cm / 1.8" (2") 2.2" (2.4") 2.6" (2.8").

## NECKLINE

Co 64 (68) 70 (74) 78 (82) sts for the neckline with circular needle 3.5 mm (US 4) - 40 cm (16") or with DPN.

Join in the round and work in the round. Work $3 \mathrm{~cm}\left(2.8^{\prime \prime}\right)$ rib in the round (*k1, p1*). Remember to place a stitch marker to mark the beginning of the round.

Work all the sts onto circular needle 4 mm (US 6) - 40 cm (16"). Change to a longer circular needle ( $60 \mathrm{~cm} / 24^{\prime \prime}, 80 \mathrm{~cm} / 32^{\prime \prime}$ or $100 \mathrm{~cm} / 39^{\prime \prime}$ ) eventually to accommodate the growing number of sts following the raglan increases.

Remember to change colors as you go along following the stated measurements of the different sizes (see INFORMATION AND TIPS).

## YOKE

The yoke is worked in stockinette stitch in the round with raglan increases before and after a raglan st on every other rnd.

Divide the sts in preparation for the raglan increases by placing stitch markers on each side of the raglan sts like this: Be aware that the rnd begins between the back piece and the right sleeve.

Place marker to mark the beginning of the rnd, 1 raglan st, (marker), 9 (9) 10 (10) 12 (12) sts for the right sleeve, (marker), 1 raglan st, (marker), 21 (23) 23 (25) 25 (27) sts for the front piece, (marker), 1 raglan st, (marker), 9 (9) 10 (10) 12 (12) sts for the left sleeve, (marker), 1 raglan st, (marker), 21 (23) 23 (25) 25 (27) sts for the back piece.

Work the yoke by repeating the following rnds:
Round 1: M1R, $k 1$ (raglan), M1L, $k$ the sts of the right sleeve, M1R, $k 1$ (raglan), M1L, $k$ the sts of the front piece, M1R, $k 1$ (raglan), M1L, $k$ the sts of the left sleeve, M1R, $k 1$ (raglan), M1L, $k$ the sts of the back piece.

Round 2: K to end.
Continue working the yoke in the round with raglan increases by repeating rnds 1-2 until you have worked a total of 17 (18) 19 (21) 24 (25) raglan increases.

You now have 200 (212) 222 (242) 270 (282) sts on the needle.

## BODY

Now the work is divided into body and sleeves, and sts are cast on for the armholes like this: Be aware that the raglan sts are part of the body.

K1 (raglan st, part of the body), place 43 (45) 48 (52) $60(62)$ sts on a stitch holder or a piece of yarn (right sleeve). Co 4 sts (forwards loop) for the armhole (same number for all sizes), k1 (raglan st), k the sts of the front piece, k1 (raglan st), place 43 (45) 48 (52) 60 (62) sts on a stitch holder or a piece of yarn (left sleeve), k1 (raglan st), co 4 sts (forwards loop) for the armhole (same number for all sizes), k1 (raglan st), $k$ the sts of the back piece, $k 1$ (raglan st).

You now have 122 (130) 134 (146) 158 (166) sts on the needle.

Continue working stockinette stitch in the round with color changes until you have worked the 7 stripes.
(Remember to place a marker to mark the beginning of the rnd and don't forget to change colors.)

Change to circular needle 3.5 mm (US 4) - $60 \mathrm{~cm}\left(24^{\prime \prime}\right), 80 \mathrm{~cm}\left(32^{\prime \prime}\right)$ or $100 \mathrm{~cm}\left(39^{\prime \prime}\right)$ and work rib in the round ( $\mathrm{k} 1, \mathrm{p} 1$ ) until the ribbing measures $3 \mathrm{~cm}\left(1.2^{\prime \prime}\right)$. Bo all sts in rib.

The work now measures 32 (36) 40 (42) 46 (49) cm / 12.6" (14.2") 15.7" (16.5") 18.1" (19.3") measured from the neckline to the bottom ribbing.

## SLEEVES x 2

Place the 43 (45) 48 (52) 60 (62) sts on the stitch holder back on circular needle 4 mm (US 6) $40 \mathrm{~cm}\left(16^{\prime \prime}\right)$ or DPN 4 mm (US 6) and pick up 4 sts in the sts you cast on below the sleeve. Remember to place a marker below the sleeve to mark the beginning of the rnd.

Work the 47 (49) 52 (56) 64 (66) sts in stockinette stitch in the round until the sleeve measures 0 (2) 2 (4) 6 (6) cm / 0 ( $0.8^{\prime \prime}$ ) 0.8" (1.6") 2.4" (2.4").
Change to circular needle 3.5 mm (US 4) - $40 \mathrm{~cm}\left(16^{\prime \prime}\right)$ or DPN 3.5 mm (US 4) and work 3 cm (1.2") rib in the round (k1, p1). When the sleeve measures 3 (5) 5 (7) 9 (9) cm / 1.2" (2") $2^{\prime \prime}$ $\left(2.8^{\prime \prime}\right) 3.5^{\prime \prime}\left(3.5^{\prime \prime}\right)$, bo all sts in rib.

## FINISHING

Weave in all ends.
