MATERIALS

8 (9) skeins Evergreen, Jeans Blue (13)
8 (9) skeins Super Kid Silk, Blue (08)

Crochet hook 6 mm (US J)
Optional 3 wooden buttons, 0,2 or 0,25 inches

YARN QUALITY

 **Evergreen Organic Wool**, Hobbii
100% Wool/ 50 g (1.75 oz) = 230 meter (252 yds)

 **Super Kid Silk**, Mayflower
76% Mohair, 24% Silk
25 g (0,9 oz) = 195 m (213 yards)

GAUGE

10 cm x 10 cm (4" x 4") = 16 sts x 10,5 rows

ABBREVIATIONS

Ch - chain
Sc - single crochet
Sl st - slip stitch
St(s) - stitch (es)
Dc - Double crochet

SIZE

48/50 (52/54)

MEASUREMENTS

Each Section measures approx:
21x35 (23x36,5) Inches/ 54x89 (58x93) cm

Measurements - finished poncho
Length from neck opening to front point
31 (34) inches/ 79 (86) cm

Length from neck opening to end of sleeve
22,5 (24) inches/ 57 (61) cm

ABOUT THE PATTERN

Pattern is worked holding 1 strand of Evergreen and 1 strand of Super Kid Silk together.

Pattern is repeatable with 3+2

INFO AND TIPS

See below the pattern for a picture guide

Crochet along with 1 strand Evergreen and 1 strand Super Kid Silk.

PATTERN

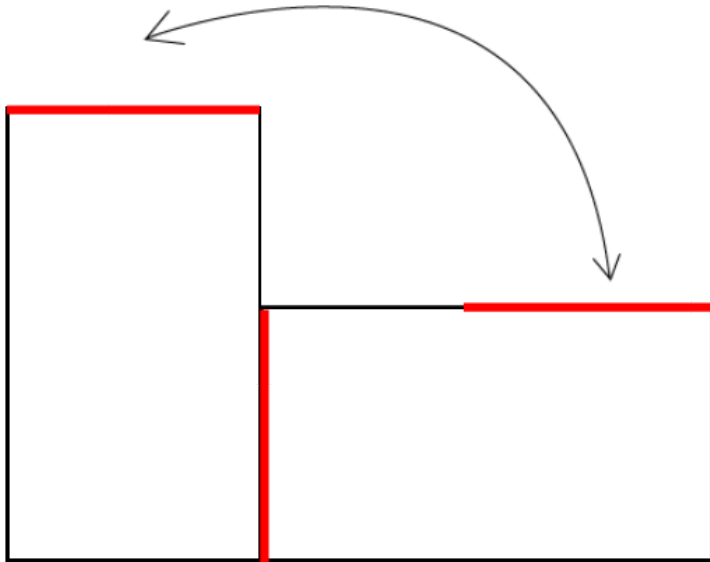
1. Chain 89 (95). In 3rd ch from your hook dc 2, skip 2 ch and "sc 1, dc 2" in next ch. "Skip 2 ch, *sc 1, dc 2* in next ch". Repeat from " to " until you have 2 ch left. Skip 1 ch and sc 1 in last ch. Turn.
2. Ch 2 and dc 2 in first st. "Skip 2 ch, *sc 1, dc 2* in next st". Repeat from " to " until the end of the row and sc 1 in the turning st. Turn.

Repeat row 2 until your work measures 31 (33.5) inches (78 (85) cm.). Fasten off and weave in ends.

Make another section exactly the same.

ASSEMBLY

Sew your work together as illustrated in the picture below. The red lines mark where the sections need to be sewn together.



NECK

Note: Start every round with ch 1 and finish with sl st 1.

Sc 1 round in the neck opening.

Sc another round, but sc 3 in the point st to make the neck opening more rounded.

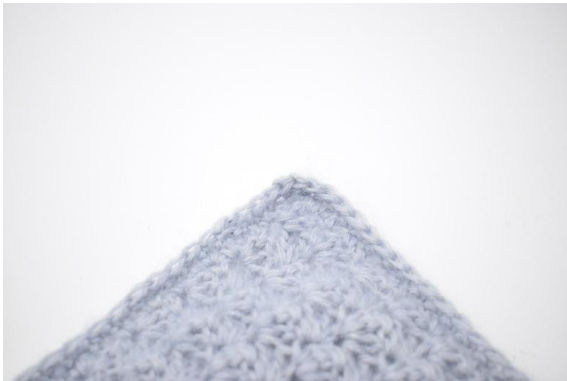
Sc another round. Fasten off and weave in ends.



EDGING

Note: Start every round with ch 1 and finish with sl st 1.

Sc 1 round all round the edge of the poncho. In all the point st, Sc 3.
Sc another round but with only sc 2 in the points. Fasten off and weave in ends.



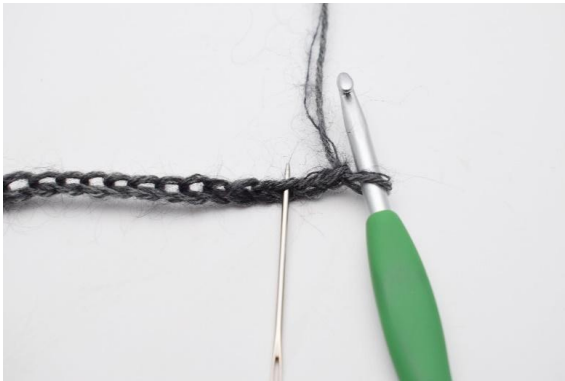
BUTTONS

If you wish, you can sew buttons in the desired size over the seam as decoration.



GUIDE - PATTERN

Row 1



1. Make your chain. The first stitches are made in the 3rd chain from the hook.



2. Dc 2.



3. Skip 2 ch.



4. "Sc 1, dc 2" in next ch.



5. Skip 2 ch.



6. "Sc 1, dc 2" in next ch.



7. Skip 2 ch, "sc1, dc 2" in next ch. Repeat until you have 2 ch left.



8. Skip 1 ch,



9. sc 1 in last ch.

Row 2



1. Turn and ch 2.



2. In first st, (as marked here by the needle)



3. dc 2.



4. Skip 2 st,



5. "sc 1, dc 2" in next st.



6. Skip 2 st,



7. "sc 1, dc 2" in next st.



8. "Skip 2 st, *sc 1, dc 2* in next st". Repeat from " to " until the end of the row.



9. In your turning st,



10. sc 1. Repeat row 2 as described in the pattern.
